NEWS & NOTES

GOING TO GREENVILLE: For the first and only time this season, the Hudson Valley Renegades are taking on the Greenville Drive. The Renegades last faced the Drive in 2025 for a six-game series at home in which the teams split the series 3-3. Overall, the 'Gades are 14-10 against Greenville and 8-5 at Fluor Field at the West End.

SPEED DEMONS: The Renegades stole seven bases on Wednesday against the Greenville Drive, tying their season high (4/26 vs Brooklyn) and marking the 11th time since the start of the 2005 season that the team has swiped seven-or-more in a game. They then stole a season-high nine bases on Saturday which tied for the second-most steals in a single game by the Renegades since 2005. The Renegades are up to 206 stolen bases as a team this year, the second-highest total in club history, trailing the 230 steals from the 2022 team.

CORE GOES FOR 30: With his steal of third in the top of the fourth inning on Wednesday at Greenville, **Core Jackson** is up to 30 stolen bases on the season, becoming the first Renegades player with 30 in a year since Spencer Jones in 2023. Jackson is just the sixth Renegade all-time with a 30-steal season, joining Michael Ross (30, 2008), Aldenis Sanchez (32, 2022), Jake Fraley (33, 2016), Cooper Bowman (35, 2022) and Jones.

CHASING .500: The Renegades have not been at the .500 mark overall this season since 5/21. Further, the Renegades have not been above .500 since 5/14. Early in the second half, the 'Gades were on the prowl, closing in on the .500 mark overall this season. However, the 'Gades got swept by Jersey Shore in back-to-back doubleheaders to fall under .500 in the second half for the first time since it began on 6/10 at Rome.

JERSEY SHORE BLUES: Hudson Valley lost five of six games at home to the Jersey Shore BlueClaws last week and were swept in two doubleheaders. It was the third time this season that the Renegades have lost five-or-more games in a six-game series this year. It's only the second time becoming a New York Yankees affiliate that the Renegades have lost five-or-more games in a six-game series three times in one season (2024).

REINFORCEMENTS: The Renegades got three position players from the Single-A Tampa Tarpons last week. **INF Jackson Lovich**, **OF Gabriel Lara**, and **OF Willy Montero** all made their High-A debuts. Lovich made his impact known immediately by getting a hit in all six games of the series against Jersey Shore. He slashed .381/.458/.381 with a .956 OPS, 3 R, 2 RBI, 3 BB, 9 K in the series.

BRAND NEW DAY: The Hudson Valley Renegades look much different for this series at Greenville than they did last week against Jersey Shore. In addition to the reinforcements sent to the Hudson Valley last week, the Renegades now have four new position players: **IF Bryce Martin-Grudzielanek**, **OF Maika Niu**, **OF Dean Toigo**, and **C David McCann**. Niu and Toigo were signed in July by the Yankees as free agents whereas Martin-Grudzielanek and McCann are coming from Single-A Tampa. Additionally, **RHP Jose M. Rodriguez** got promoted from Single-A Tampa.

100 HOMERS: Hudson Valley reached the 100 home run mark on 7/26 at Wilmington. The 'Gades have reached that mark in five of their last six seasons, with 2025 being the only outlier. The Renegades surpassed their 2024 home run total of 101 with a Camden Troyer blast on 7/31, but the 'Gades need 22 more to surpass their 2022 total. The most home runs they've had in a season in that six-year stretch his 156 in 2021.

WORKING DEEP: For the first time as a New York Yankees affiliate (and for the first time since 1995), Renegades pitching has thrown four complete games in a single season. The four pitchers to achieve the feat are **Rory Fox** (5/21 at Brooklyn and 7/23 at Wilmington), **Franyer Herrera** (6/28 at Bowling Green), and **Bryce Cunningham** (8/1 vs Jersey Shore). Additionally, 10 Renegades starters have record starts of 7.0-or-more innings pitched. **Fox**, **Jack Cebert** and **Luis Serna** have done it multiple times. The Renegades are one of three teams in MiLB with three pitchers who have multiple starts of 7.0-or-more innings pitched, joining the Columbia Fireflies (KC, A) and the Augusta GreenJackets (ATL, A).

THE 10/20 CLUB: Infielders **Roderick Arias** and **Core Jackson** have both hit at least 10 HR and stolen 20 bases this season, making them two of six

players in franchise history in the 10/20 club, with all members joining since 2022. Trey Sweeney (14 HR, 29 SB) was the charter member in 2022, while Ben Cowles (10 HR, 23 SB) and Spencer Jones (13 HR, 35 SB) joined in 2023. Roc Riggio (11 HR, 27 SB in 2024) was the most-recent member to join the group before this year.

WAPPINGERS BOMBERS: The Renegades have five players with double-digit home runs this season (**Kyle West**, 18; **Josh Moylan**, 13; **Core Jackson**, 12; **Roderick Arias**, 12; and **Eric Genther**, 11). In 2025 only Dillon Lewis (13) reached double-digit homers. Five players reach double figures in 2024. **Camden Troyer** is one homer away from joining the club.

20+ TEAM: Four Renegades have worked on-base streaks of at least 20 games. C Eric Genther was the first to do so when he reached base in the first 21 games that he played this season. Then, Roderick Arias, Kaeden Kent, and Wilson Rodriguez all crested the 20-game on-base streak mark in the month of July. Arias currently has the longest on-base streak of the four at 23, and Eric Genther is the only Renegade to achieve the feat twice this season.

RUNNING WILD: Renegades opponents have stolen 274 bases this season, and are 274-for-325 (84.3%) on stolen base attempts this season. That is already the most steals allowed by the Renegades in a season in franchise history, surpassing the mark of 226 from 2025. Hudson Valley is allowing an average of 2.61 steals per game.

NO DOUBLES DEFENSE: The Renegades have turned the fewest double plays in Minor League Baseball this season (44). The teams with the second fewest turned this year, the Columbus Clingstones (ATL, AA) and the Cedar Rapids Royals (MIN, A+), have turned 55 and 57. Hudson Valley is on pace to turn only 56 double plays this season, which would be the fewest of any full-season team in a non-shortened season since 2005 (excludes 120 game 2021 season).

GO WEST, YOUNG MAN: Renegades 1B **Kyle West** has clubbed a team-leading 19 home runs this season, the most by a Hudson Valley player since Tyler Hardman tied the franchise record with 22 in 2022. West's 19 long balls this year are the third-most in a single season by a Renegades player. West trails only Hardman and Dan Grummitt (22, 1999) in the category.

HOMER HAPPY: The Renegades have been tearing the cover off of the baseball since June. In their first series of June at Frederick, the Renegades clubbed 12 home runs in the series, about 27.3% of their season total at the time (12-of-44). The last time the Renegades hit at least 12 home runs in a single series was 7/25-7/30/2023 at Hickory when Hudson Valley hit 19 HR. It is the first time hitting at least a dozen home runs in a series at Heritage Financial Park since 9/7-9/11/2021 vs Brooklyn, when they hit 14 HR in a seven-game series. The Renegades have hit 74 homers in their last 58 games which is 70.5% of their season total of 106 home runs. They have hit a homer in 37 of their last 53 games.

ER-YAY: The Renegades boast the third-best ERA in High-A (4.29). With offense exploding across the minors, the 'Gades were one of just a handful of teams to have a sub-4.00 ERA for the first eight weeks of the season. However, their ERA jumped above 4.00 on 5/29 after Bowling Green scored 13 runs. The Renegades have led the SAL in ERA in four straight seasons (2022-25), including a 2.82 mark in 2025 which was the lowest team ERA in MiLB since 2019. Additionally, the Renegades have the lowest WHIP in High-A (1.33), and they have struck out a league-high 1067 batters this season.

TAKING MANY FOR THE TEAM: Renegades **C Eric Genther** was hit by a pitch on 7/31 to become the MiLB leader in HBP with 25. He became the Renegades all-time career HBP leader on 7/4, surpassing the previous high of 18 set by Cole Gabrielson. Through only 57 games played, Genther broke the Renegades single-season record for HBP, which belonged to Robby Price (2010) and Ryder Mathias (2005).

ROSTER OVERHAUL: After making only 16 total roster moves in the month of July, the Renegades have made 16 roster moves in the first week of August, re-shaping the team. The 'Gades have welcomed in five new players, had four released from their contracts, activated two off the Injured List, placed two on the Development List and had two traded at the deadline.

LAST TIME OUT: Facundo had a rough start last Sunday against the Jersey Shore BlueClaws, allowing eight runs on eight hits while walking four across 4.2 innings with seven strikeouts. Facundo allowed three runs in the second and served up a grand slam to Nick Biddison in the third before allowing an RBI single to Griffin Burkholder in the fourth. However he did have five strikeouts through two innings. This was the fourth straight start in which Facundo failed to complete five innings, and he has walked 14 batters across 13.1 innings in his last three starts.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season on the Single-A Tampa Tarpons Break Camp roster... was transferred to the Renegades on 4/27.
- Struck out eight-or-more batters in all three starts with Tampa, and was t-5th in the Florida State League in strikeouts (25) at the time of his promotion. Facundo also allowed 1 R-or-fewer in each of his first three starts with the Tarpons.
- In his final start with the Tarpons on 4/22 at Lakeland: 5.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 8 K.
- Had his first High-A quality start on 5/14 vs Frederick: L, 6.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 3 BB, 6 K.
- Tied the Renegades single-game franchise record with 13 strikeouts on 5/21 (G1) at Brooklyn (with Drew Thorpe, 7/22/2023). Struck out the first eight batters he faced in the game, and his first 10 outs recorded were all on strikeouts.
- Was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week after throwing 6.0 hitless innings on 6/4 at Frederick with 12 strikeouts, just the fifth start of 6.0-or-more IP and 0 H allowed by a Renegades pitcher in the Yankees Era (2021-Present). It was just the 10th such start by a Hudson Valley pitcher since Minor League game logs are available online (2005-Present).
- Is one of two pitchers in Renegades history with multiple starts of 12-or-more strikeouts, joining Drew Thorpe (2023).
- Has a 4.67 ERA (9 ER/17.1 IP) against SAL South opponents, and a 3.86 ERA (13 ER/30.1 IP) against SAL North opponents.
- On 6/25 became one of three pitchers in MiLB in 2026 to record three games of 10-or-more strikeouts in the season, joining Blue Jays prospects Nolan Perry and Daniel Guerra.
- Is one of five Hudson Valley pitchers since 2005 with three 10+ strikeout games in a single season, joining Ken Waldichuk (2021), Chase Hampton (2023), Juan Carela (2023) and Drew Thorpe (2023).
- Leads Yankees Minor League pitchers in strikeouts this season (118).

2025 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Split the season between the FCL Yankees and the Single-A Tampa Tarpons, combining to go 1-1 with a 1.85 ERA (39.0 IP, 24 H, 10 R, 8 ER, 17 BB, 45 K, .183 BAA, 1.05 WHIP) in 10 games (nine starts)... Began the season on the Tampa 60-day Injured List... Began rehab assignment with the FCL Yankees on 6/24... Reinstated from the Injured List on 7/9... Did not allow an earned run in his first four appearances of the season from 6/24-7/18 (12.1 IP)... Finished the season with 9.0 combined scoreless innings in his last two starts from 8/27-9/3 (2), combining to allow two hits and six walks while recording eight strikeouts... Struck out a season-high eight batters two times (7/9 vs Lakeland and 8/17 vs Dunedin)... In his final start of the season on 9/3 (2) picked up the win vs. Clearwater (5.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 5 K).

PERSONAL:

- Full name is Allen Haybertson Alberto Facundo... Missed the entire 2022 season with a shoulder injury and had Tommy John surgery in May 2024... Added velocity coming back from Tommy John surgery, touching 100 mph with his fastball... Signed for a \$20,000 bonus in 2021... Had only allowed one home run in his career across 148.0 innings entering 2026, on 5/3/24 at Dunedin to Blue Jays prospect Arjun Nimmala... Led the FCL in wins (5) in 2023 and paced the DSL in strikeouts (84) in 2021.
