COLUMBUS, OHIO – The Omaha Storm Chasers led briefly but dropped game four of a six game series against the Clippers, 8-5 at Huntington Park Friday night.

- On a chilling and crisp night, both teams struggled early offensively to put runs on the board for the third consecutive day, as both starting pitchers were in control across the first three innings without allowing a run.
- In the top of the 4th inning, Omaha put on a hitting clinic and **Nate Eaton** started the scoring with a single up the middle to bring **Tyler Tolbert** and **Drew Waters** home and make the score 2-0 in favor of the Chasers.
- Two batters later, **Devin Mann** followed with a double to left field and brought Eaton and **Nick Pratto** home to increase the lead 4-0 ... **Brian O'Keefe** added to the hit parade as he doubled to center field and scored Mann to make it 5-0.
- The Clippers promptly cut into the Storm Chaser lead in the bottom of the 4th inning, opening the home half of the frame with six straight hits ... with the bases loaded, **Daniel Schneemann** doubled and **Micah Pries** added a double to cut Omaha's lead to 5-4, then **Dom Nuñez** added a two-run homer to right field to help Columbus take its first lead of the night, 6-5.
- In the 6th inning, the Clippers added more damage to the scoreboard with another pair of doubles to extended their lead to 8-5.
- The Storm Chasers had one last breath in the top of the ninth inning that started with O'Keefe's second double of the game, but after **Mike Brosseau** drew a pinch-hit walk, the two runners were stranded on base to end the game, with the tying run left at the plate.
- Storm Chasers starter **Andrew Hoffmann** struck out four batters in 3.0 innings before his night was over and replaced by **Tyler Duffey**, who allowed just one run over 2.0 innings but was charged with the loss ... Eaton had two hits on the night, his second consecutive multi-hit game.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

ALL QUIET ON THE OMAHA FRONT

- The Storm Chasers have struggled to offer their starting pitchers run support this season, but things are headed in the right direction after the last two games.
- Through the first five games of the season, the Storm Chasers did not offer the starters any run support ... across 20.0 innings of work, the offense failed to score when the starting pitchers were in the game.
- In the second game of Thursday's doubleheader, the Chasers scored a pair of runs while starter **Luis Cessa** was in the game ... yesterday, Omaha scored five runs behind starter **Andrew Hoffmann**, but Columbus promptly scored six runs to counter Omaha's biggest inning of the year.
- In 2023, Storm Chasers starters got an average of 2.7 runs of support per game, 392 runs in total over the 392 games of the season.

DID YOU GET A WHIFF OF THAT?

- Omaha's hitters have 83 strikeouts (33.2% strikeout rate), the most strikeouts of any Triple-A team and the highest strikeout rate.
- The next-closest team in strikeout is the Toledo Mud Hens, with 80 strikeouts as a team (20.1% strikeout rate) ... the closet strikeout rate of any Triple-A club to Omaha is Las Vegas, with a 30.5% strikeout rate (68 K in 223 PA).
- Omaha has 10+ strikeouts at the plate in 5 of 7 games thus far, with two games of 15+ strikeouts ... last year, the team had 10 or more strikeouts in 59 games (40%), but 15+ strikeouts in just 5 games (4 times in August).

COMEBACK KINGS

- All three of Omaha's wins this season have been nail-biters, all are one-run wins and all have been comeback victories as well.
- Both walk-off wins Omaha had last weekend were dramatic games where they trailed for the first half of the game ... on Opening Day, Iowa led 1-0, then 4-0 and Omaha did not take a lead until walking off in the 11th ... on March 30, Iowa led 2-0 in the middle of the 5th, but the Chasers scored 3 in the bottom half to take a lead.
- In the second game on Thursday Omaha led much of the game, but Columbus scored 3 runs in the bottom of the 6th, so the Chasers entered the top of the 7th down by one run and did not jump back ahead until they were down to the last out of the game.

RELIEF AID

- The Storm Chasers bullpen is still of the best in the International League as Omaha's relievers have combined for a 3.71 ERA through the team's first 7 games.
- A 3.71 ERA (14 ER in 34.0 IP) ranks 5th out of the 20-team International League and 7th among the 30 Triple-A teams.
- The Storm Chasers bullpen has combined to hold opposing hitters to a .157 average (18-for-115), which is the second-best mark among Triple-A teams, trailing only Columbus (.149 average).
- Of the 29 individual appearances by Omaha relief pitchers, 22 have been scoreless ... of the five outings where Chasers relievers allowed a run, three were multi-run outings, including 2 of less than an inning.
