### PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.

- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
- This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### IN GOOD STANDINGS

While the standings re-set for the start of the 2nd half on June 25, Omaha's enters today's game 25 games over .500 with a 56-31 record (.644 winning percentage).

- 56 wins are tied for the most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, tied with the Sugar Land Space Cowboys (Astros Triple-A).
- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .644 winning percentage overall this year is also tied for the best in the Minors with the Sugar Land Space Cowboys (56-31 / .644 Houston's Triple-A affiliate).
- The Chasers have still been 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day since May 25 ... Omaha previously held the best winning percentage in full-season Minor League Baseball for 30 days, June 5 to July 5.

#### TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

57 of Omaha's 87 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 22 of 31 losses in 2024, with 12 of 31 losses by just one run (39%).

- Close games have been a struggle for Omaha in recent weeks, with the bullpen converting just 7 of its last 15 save opportunities, since June 5 (47%).
- Omaha is 18-12 in 1-run games this season, which ranks as the 3rd-most 1-run wins of any Minor League team.
- As a team, Omaha's 27 saves are tied for the 5th-most of any Minor League team and 2nd-most in Triple-A ... **Will Klein's** 9 saves individually rank 4th in the International League, this season, while seven different Storm Chasers pitchers have 2 or more saves in 2024.

#### I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 493 to 400 this season, a +93 run differential.

- A +93 run differential this year ranks as the best mark both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.
- Omaha ranks 7th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Greensboro Grasshoppers lead the Minors at +148 (522 to 374).

#### DAZZLING DEFENSE

Omaha's defense has had its ups and downs this season, but the team is on one of its best stretches in the field this season.

- Over Omaha's last 27 games (since June 9), a .989 fielding percentage (10 errors in 928 total chances) is the 2nd- best in Minor League Baseball over that span.
- Overall this year, a .981 fielding percentage is tied 7th in the league, tied 9th in Triple-A and tied 12th of the 120 full-season Minor League teams.
- The Storm Chasers have not made an error in 10 of the team's last 14 games, with a streak of 6 errorless games snapped last Friday ... early in the season, Omaha went 7 straight games without making an error, March 31 to April 7.

#### COMEBACK KIDS

Omaha has 32 come-from-behind wins this season, meaning over half (57%) of this year's wins have been games where the Chasers trailed at some point.

- The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as 5 runs to win and have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win on 10 occasions.
- Omaha has trailed for three innings or more in 11 of the 31 comeback wins, with five victories where the club had to overcome multiple deficits ... the team has 8 wins in games where they trailed after the 6th inning.

#### RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen has been one of the best across the entire Triple-A level in 2024.

- The Storm Chasers relievers lead all Triple-A bullpens with a 1.36 WHIP and an opposing slash line of .213/.325/.357 ... the .213 opponents' average is tied for the 9th-best in the Minors ... a 3.89 ERA is 2nd at the Triple-A level.
- Omaha's bullpen has combined to not allow a run in 19 games this year, roughly one in every 4.58 games ... however, 16 consecutive games entering today without a scoreless bullpen effort is the longest stretch for the team this season.
- The longest active scoreless streak for a Chasers pitcher belongs to **Austin Cox**, who has compiled 5 straight scoreless outings since June 19, with 13 strikeouts in 10.0 innings, and just 4 walks and 9 hits.

TODAY'S START

- Bowlan is making his 16th start with Omaha and 17th overall start this season after making his first/only Major League appearance of the year in late April with the Royals in Toronto... was recalled to start on April 29, optioned back to Omaha April 30.

LAST OUTING: WEDNESDAY, JULY 3 vs. IOWA

Fired his 4th quality start of the year and his first in over a month, holding the Cubs to 2 runs over 6 innings... only allowed a 2-run homer to Jake Hager in the top of the 2nd inning... worked around a leadoff single in the 1st... fired a 1-2-3 inning in the 3rd... stranded a single on in the 4th, worked around a double and walk in the 5th and stranded a two-out single on in the 6th, did not come out for the 7th.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Appeared in 2 Cactus League games (0 starts) and went 2-0 with a 5.40 ERA (2 ER in 3.1 IP), with 2 strikeouts.
- Threw 2 quality starts vs. Gwinnett, on April 9 and 14... combined to allow 3 ER on 10 H and 0 BB over 12.0 IP with 13 K.

CAREER NOTES

- After opening the year at NW Arkansas (AA), Bowlan earned a promotion to Omaha on June 20 and made 14 appearances (12 starts) for the Storm Chasers, before earning his first big league call-up on September 19.
- Having not pitched into the 6th inning in over two years, did so in five of his final seven outings with Omaha... three of his last four starts with the Chasers were quality starts - 8/30 vs. LOU (6.0 IP, 1 ER), 9/5 @ IOW (6.0 IP, 2 ER) & 9/16 vs. IND (6.0 IP, 2 ER).

- After undergoing Tommy John Surgery in 2021, returned to the mound June 17 in the Arizona Complex League and made seven starts with the ACL Royals (R), one start with Quad Cities (A+) and finished the year with NW Arkansas (AA) for his final nine starts... 10 of 33 runs (30%) allowed with NWA came on home runs.

- Began the season with NW Arkansas (AA) and started four games for the Naturals, going 2-0 with a 1.59 ERA (3 ER in 17.0 IP).

- Split the year between Lexington (A) and Wilmington (A+), combined to go 11-5 with a 3.14 ERA (51 ER in 146.0 IP) with 150 strikeouts (92.4 K/9) to just 23 walks (1.42 BB/9)... among Royals farmhands, tied 2nd in wins, 3rd in strikeouts, 5th in innings.

- Made nine starts for Idaho Falls (R) during his first pro season... pitched to a 2.25 ERA (4 ER in 16.0 IP) in his first 4 starts, culminating in his first victory on July 7 @ Orem (LAA), allowing 1 run on 2 hits over 5.0 innings, with a season-high 6 strikeouts.

COLLEGE (2016-2018): Pitched at the University of Memphis for three seasons... posted a 3.71 ERA (35 ER in 85.0 IP) with 104 strikeouts in 2018 as a junior for the Tigers and fanned a school record (and 2018 Division I-best) 18 hitters in a complete game win over South Florida on April 28.

MISCELLANEOUS: 2015: Graduated from Bartlett High School (Tennessee) where he was named Male Athlete of the Year as a senior... played the first three years of high school baseball at Arlington High School, helped them to a state championship in 2012 as a freshman. His father, Mark, threw the lone perfect game in the history of the University of Memphis program (1987 - 1989) and pitched two seasons (44 games) in the St. Louis Cardinals' organization (1989 & 1991).
