SPRINGDALE, AR —After trading runs early, the Naturals stormed past the Sod Poodles with a seven-run 4th inning, for a 12-6 win to even the series, tying season highs with both 12 runs and 15 hits.

- Both teams scored single runs in the 2nd and 3rd innings, with Seuly Matias tying the game at 1-1 in the 2nd on his third homer of the year, then **Tucker Bradley** scored on an errant pickoff throw in the 3rd.
- Northwest Arkansas screamed past Amarillo with seven run in the 4th. Sebastian Rivero led off the inning with his first homer of the season and first of two on the day, as the first six Naturals hitters of the inning reached. Logan Porter singled home Nate Eaton, Nick Loftin singled home Tucker Bradley, then Michael Massey brought around Maikel Garcia with a sacrifice fly. Then, Eaton doubled home Loftin and Matias to cap the seven-run inning and put the Naturals up 9-3.
- After Amarillo struck for two in the sixth, Northwest Arkansas countered with three in the bottom half, as Loftin doubled and scored on a John Rave sacrifice fly, while Matias singled and came around on a two-run shot from Rivero's second home run of the night, putting the score at 12-5 at the time.
- Naturals starting pitcher **Anthony Veneziano** recorded his first win of the year, allowing three runs across 5.0 innings with two strikeouts. Zack Phillips followed Veneziano with 2.2 innings, including a 1-2-3 seventh inning ... Jonah Dipoto followed Phillips and got the final four outs, retiring all four batters he faced to stretch his scoreless streak to 7.1 scoreless innings, having now retired the last 10 hitters he's faced.

This Day in Naturals History

The Naturals are 8-4 all-time when playing on April 28

On <u>April 27, 2008</u>, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals walked off on the Springfield Cardinals, 6-5 in nine innings at Arvest Ballpark, the third win of a franchise-best 11-game winning streak. Starter **Jonathan Dziedzic** did not strike out a batter across 5.2 innings, aide by three double play turns by the infield. Designated hitter Balbino Fuenmayor went 3-for-4 at the plate, driving in two runs, while second baseman Angel Franco hit a two-run homer as part of a four-run fourth inning. Springfield scored two in the 9th off of **Aroni Nina** to tie the game at 5-5, but Mike Bianucci singled home Bubba Starling with one out in the bottom half to win.

THE CHAMPS ARE HERE!

Of the 28-man roster the Naturals rolled out for the Double-A Central Championship Series in 2021, six players are on the Naturals' 2022 active roster, with a total of 9 returning players with the Naturals this season.

- Pitchers Holden Capps, Yefri Del Rosario, Drew Parrish, Stephen Woods Jr. and Ángel Zerpa were all a part of the championship celebration last year, as was outfielder Seuly Matias.
- Additionally, catcher/infielder Gavin Stupienski and pitcher Alec Marsh both played for the Naturals in 2021, as did catcher Tyler Cropley, who is currently on the Injured List.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 20 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities
 River Bandits last season.
- 10 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas:
 Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave and Ángel Zerpa.

STAR-STUDDED ROTATION

All five of the Naturals starting pitchers to open the season are consensus top prospects in the Royals' organization, with all five listed in MLB Pipeline's Top-30 rankings for Kansas City.

- LHP Drew Parrish started yesterday and will go again Sunday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 29 in the system, while Baseball America had him at No. 38 in their preseason rankings.
- LHP Anthony Veneziano starts today for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 17 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 21.
- LHP Ángel Zerpa starts tomorrow for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 13 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 20.
- RHP Alec Marsh stars Friday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 12 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 11.
- LHP Asa Lacy has made two starts for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him No. 72 overall in baseball, No. 4 in the system and the No. 5 lefthanded pitching prospect, while Baseball America has him at No. 4 in the Royals' minor league system, the No. 4 left-handed pitching prospect.

TOOLSY TEAM

Six active Naturals players were listed in *Baseball America*'s 2022 Best Tools Survey of the Kansas City Royals' organization.

- CF Nick Loftin is rated as having the "Best Strike-Zone Discipline" in the system.
- C Sebastian Rivero is rated as being the <u>"Best Defensive Catcher"</u> in the
- SS **Maikel Garcia** is rated as having the <u>"Best Infield Arm"</u> in the system.
- RF Seuly Matias is rated as having the <u>"Best Outfield Arm"</u> in the system.
- LHP **Asa Lacy** is rated as having the <u>"Best Slider"</u> in the system.
- LHP **Ángel Zerpa** is rated as having the <u>"Best Control"</u> in the system.

YO, YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?

Through 15 games, the Naturals have stolen <u>26 bases in 29 attempts</u> (average 1.53 steals/game) and *pulled off a double steal 5 times*.

- 26 steals ranks tied 2nd in the Texas League, while a 89.66% success rate
 on steals is 15th out of 120 Minor League teams and 10th among teams
 with at least 20 successful steals.
- Maikel Garcia's seven steals (in as many attempts) ranks tied for third in the league.

Gar-see ya on Base

Shortstop **Maikel Garcia** drew 10 walks through the season's first five games, and now has 15 on the season, which ranks second in the Texas League and tied for seventh in Double-A.

- In 77 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 31 times, for a .403 on-base percentage (16 hits + 15 walks).
- Garcia ranks among the Texas League leaders, ranking tied for second in walks (15) and tied for 3rd in steals (7).
- Despite his on-base prowess, Garcia endured a five-game hitless streak, where he went 0-for-23 between April 19 and 27, five four walks, a span in which his batting average has dropped over 100 points, entering 4/19 batting .406, but currently hitting .258.
- Garcia drew at least one walk in each of the first five games he played, while walking twice or more on four occasions. He collected his first threewalk game on 4/13 in the Naturals' 8-5 win over Wichita.

G'DAY ROBBIE!

Australian infielder **Robbie Glendinning** was a February free agent signing by the Kansas City Royals and has proven himself to be one of the best players on the 2022 Naturals.

- The native of Perth, Western Australia has reached base in all <u>13 games</u> he's played started the season, hitting .286 (12-for-42) with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs and 12 walks, giving him a .455 on-base percentage.
- Glendinning is the ONLY Natural that has reached base in every game played this season, his 13-game on-base streak is tied with Maikel Garcia for the longest on the team this year and is tied for fifth in the Texas League.
- Among nine qualified Naturals hitter, Glendinning is the Naturals' team leader in batting average (.286), on-base percentage (.455), slugging percentage (.548) and OPS (1.003), while ranking tied for the team lead with 11 runs batted in, is second in runs scored (12) and third in walks (12)... his .471 OBP ranks tied sixth in the Texas League.

My Name is Del Ro

Right-hander **Yefri Del Rosario** has pitched 11.1 scoreless innings across four appearances to begin the season, the last Naturals pitcher that is yet to allow a run this year.

- Across four relief appearances, Del Rosario has thrown 11.1 scoreless innings, on 9 hits and 5 walks, with eight strikeouts.
- 11.1 innings is far and away the longest scoreless streak among all Double-A pitchers so far this season, the next closest being two players with 9.2 scoreless innings ... with that, it is also the longest in the Texas League this season, the next closest being three players tied with 8.2 innings.
- Only one Naturals pitcher has gotten through the end of April having not surrendered a run, Blaine Hardy in 2010, when the lefty pitched in 6 April games and threw 15.0 scoreless innings on 7 hits allowed with 8 strikeouts.
- The last pitcher to go through all of April and not allow an earned run in more than 10.0 innings is Blake Johnson in 2011, when the righty threw 16.2 innings across 7 April games and surrendered one unearned run on 11 hits with 14 strikeouts.

- Abraham Núñez enters his fourth season as Northwest Arkansas' hitting coach after serving in the same capacity with High-A Wilmington (2015-2018), Class-A Lexington (2014), Rookie Advanced Burlington (2013) and the Dominican Royals (2012).

- Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.
- · Christian lives in Cave Springs, Ark. (15 minutes North of Arvest Ballpark) with his wife, Kayla, and three daughters, Marley, Mia and Lucy.



#23 MIKE JIRSCHLE • BENCH COACH

- Mike Jirschele enters his first season as the Bench Coach for Northwest Arkansas after spending last season in the same role for Manager Chris Widger in Quad Cities.
- He served as a Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020 and was on the Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015.
- Jirschele previously managed the Triple-A Omaha franchise for 11 seasons (2003-13), leading the team to four division titles, three-straight trips to the Pacific Coast League championship round (2011-13), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and a Triple-A Championship in 2013.

- Prior to his 11-year stint with Omaha, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years (1998-2002), while he held managerial positions with Omaha (1995-97), Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- Jirschele was originally selected by the Texas Rangers in the fifth round of the 1977 MLB Draft and played in 999 minor league games over 13-plus seasons in the Rangers and Royals systems.

- Danny Accola is entering his seventh season with the Royals organization and first as the certified athletic trainer with the Naturals, after serving in the same role with the Quad Cities in 2021.






