ABOUT LAST NIGHT...It was a party in Portland as the Sea Dogs won 14-6 over the Rumble Ponies on a night that saw Will Middlebrooks, Sally McNamara and Bill Burke inducted into the Sea Dogs Hall of Fame. The Sea Dogs blasted four home runs, one of each kind, as every batter in the order collected at least one hit. **Ahbram Liendo** hit his second grand slam of the season over the Maine Monster. **Caden Rose** hit a three-run shot and **Ronald Rosario** plated two with another pair of homers over the Monster. **Mason White** was three-for-three with a solo home run and two walks. He finished the night a triple shy of the cycle.

CHASING HISTORY With 12 strikeouts last night, Sea Dogs pitching has dealt 1,403 strikeouts and counting this season, far surpassing the previous franchise record of 1,329 strikeouts, set in 2024. The Sea Dogs' 185 home runs is good for the second best single-season mark in franchise history, trailing the 1997 franchise record of 191 homers. They sit in fourth place on the franchise leaderboard for extra-base hits with 445, trailing 1997 (484), 2011 (450), and 2004 (447).

EASTERN LEAGUE SWEEP The Sea Dogs swept Eastern League Player and Pitcher of the week awards following last week's series split in Chesapeake. Shortstop **Henry Godbout** earned player of the week and LHP **Hayden Mullins** earned pitcher of the week. Godbout hit .455 (10-for-22) with five runs scored, four home runs and six RBI. He collected three hits in each of the last three games of the series, including his first career two-homer game on September 3. Mullins started on September 2, allowing just one hit in 6.0 scoreless innings with 10 strikeouts.

CONTRERAS TIME Willson Contreras will start at designated hitter today for the Sea Dogs on a MLB rehab assignment from the Boston Red Sox. Contreras went on the injured list on Aug. 31 with a hamstring strain. Among qualified players, Contreras is the Red Sox' leader in OPS (.900), home runs (26) and RBIs (79). Boston acquired Contreras last December from St. Louis in exchange for multiple pitching prospects.

BRANNON BLASTS Brooks Brannon leads active, qualified Eastern League hitters in SLG% (.558) and OPS (.915). His 21 home runs is the most by a Sea Dog since Bobby Dalbec in 2019. As it stands, Brannon's .558 SLG% is the fourth best single-season mark in franchise history.

ALL FOR EXTRA BASES Last night, Portland hit three doubles and four home runs. They are averaging four doubles per game in this series. Portland has the second most doubles (241) and the second most home runs (185) in the Eastern League. The Sea Dogs' 445 total extra-base hits leads the Eastern League and is second best out of 30 Double-A teams, trailing only Frisco (450).

PLAYOFF PICTURE With a win last night, the Reading Fightin Phils have officially clinched the Northeast division and earned their spot in the playoffs. The Erie Seawolves won the Southwest division. They will join the Hartford Yard Goats and the Richmond Flying Squirrels in the postseason.

THIS DAY IN SEA DOGS HISTORY September 11, 2005 - The Sea Dogs clinched their third Northern Division Title with a 9-2 victory over the Trenton Thunder at Hadlock Field. Portland received multi-hit games from the first seven hitters in the lineup and smacked four home runs and 15 hits off five Thunder pitchers.

ON THE MOUND RHP Yordanny Monegro (NR) will make his 2026 Sea Dogs debut today. Monegro spent the vast majority of the season on the 60-day injured list after undergoing Tommy John surgery last season. He made two rehab starts in Greenville on August 28 and September 4, allowing two runs on one homer in 3.2 total innings pitched with seven strikeouts and four walks. Monegro started 2025 in Portland and earned a 2.67 ERA through nine appearances before his injury. He dealt 49 strikeouts with just eight walks in 33.2 innings pitched. Monegro signed with Boston out of the Dominican Republic in 2020.

Leading the Sea Dogs

Acting Manager - Kyle Sasala

Kyle Sasala enters his third season on the Portland staff after a highly successful tenure at Grove City College, where he served as Associate Head Coach from 2016 to 2023. During his time with the Wolverines, Sasala played a key role in the program's rise, highlighted by a school-record 30-win season in 2023 and a 16-4 conference mark. He also helped guide Grove City to a then-record 28 victories in 2019 alongside head coach Matt Royer. Sasala later stepped in as interim head coach for the Eastern College Athletic Conference Division III Championship Tournament, leading the Wolverines to a runner-up finish.

Pitching Coach - Juan Rivera

Juan Rivera also returns to the Sea Dogs coaching staff as a pitching coach for his second season. In 2025, Rivera helped guide a Portland pitching staff that recorded 1,435 strikeouts, the second-most in the Eastern League, while posting a 3.65 team ERA, the fourth-best mark in the league. Rivera spent the previous three seasons as the Salem Red Sox' pitching coach, where he led the staff to a 3.61 ERA, the fourth-best in Single-A. A graduate of Eastern Nazarene College, Rivera has been part of the Boston Red Sox organization since 2022, serving as a Development Coach with Salem before joining the Sea Dogs coaching staff.

Hitting Coach - Trevor Burmeister

Trevor Burmeister joins the Sea Dogs coaching staff as hitting coach after spending the previous five seasons in the Colorado Rockies organization. Burmeister began his coaching career immediately following his collegiate playing career at the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse, where he spent two seasons on the coaching staff. He then served one season at the University of Minnesota Duluth, where the offense ranked third nationally in NCAA Division II with a .352 team batting average and second in the nation with 102 home runs. Burmeister later returned to his alma mater, Madison College (NJCAA), spending three seasons under head coach Mike Davenport. During his time there, he was named the 2019 NJCAA Assistant Coach of the Year by the American Baseball Coaches Association and Baseball America.

Defensive Coach - Kyle Schmidt

Kyle Schmidt joins the Sea Dogs as defensive coach after spending two years with the Red Sox' Single-A affiliate, the Salem Ridge Yaks. Originally from Smithville, TX, Kyle attended the University of Richmond and became a starting catcher for the Spider Baseball Team. Following his 2019 season, Kyle was drafted in the 33rd Round of the 1st Year Player Draft by the Minnesota Twins. Kyle voluntarily retired after the 2023 season. During his playing career, Kyle played at every Minor League level while also being involved in multiple Major League Spring Trainings.

Athletic Trainer - Kelsey Branstetter

Kelsey Branstetter joins the staff as Portland's Athletic Trainer, her first year with the Sea Dogs and second season in the Red Sox organization. She spent last season as the Athletic Trainer for the Greenville Drive (High-A) and served in the same role for Triple-A Louisville (Cincinnati Reds) from 2023-2024. Branstetter graduated from Middle Tennessee State University, where she played four years of soccer. Following her undergraduate studies, Branstetter obtained a master's degree from Wichita State University.

Strength and Conditioning Coach - Jonah Mondloch

Strength and Conditioning Coach Jonah Mondloch returns to the staff for his second season in Portland and his third year in the Red Sox organization. He previously served as an Assistant Rehab Strength and Conditioning Coach, where he supported the strength and conditioning programs for players returning to the field. In that role, he collaborated closely with Major League sports performance and on-field staff to ensure the highest level of care for injured athletes.
