### FROM THE DOG HOUSE

DOM'S TURN: Left hander Dominic Fritton is slated to toe the slab tonight for game two of the series versus the Woodpeckers. Last Wednesday at Kannapolis, the southpaw tossed four innings and fanned five (4 runs). Tonight marks his second start versus Fayetteville of the season, after delivering his best outing of the season against them on 4/9 (4 IP, 1 R, 6K). Against lefties this year, he has generated a 26.3 percent strikeout rate.

FLAIR FOR THE DRAMATIC: The RiverDogs earned an exhilarating 4-3 win in ten innings last night after Cooper Fleming delivered a walk-off sacrifice fly to center. Each of the last four home wins for Charleston have come after the club has delivered at least the sixth inning trailing. In the process, they've earned three walk off victories. Last night's win marked their first extra-innings victory of the season.

FIRE THE CANNONS: The RiverDogs earned their second series win of the season last week after taking four of six from the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers. After dropping game one, the club responded with wins on Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday, three of which in comeback fashion. Caden Bodine has another strong series, finishing 7-for-17 with a home run and six runs batted in. Brailer Guerrero also shined, blasted two homers with six hits. Across the entire week, Charleston slashed .303/.393/.455 with six homers while averaging six runs per game. After Tuesday's difficult loss, Charleston's bullpen really settled in, pitching to a 2.35 ERA and .130 opposing average over 23 frames across the final five games of the week.

WELCOME WOODPECKERS: The RiverDogs matchup with Fayetteville for the second time this season, after taking five of six on the road in early April. Fayetteville enters the week scorching hot after sweeping Myrtle Beach in six games, including taking both in their Sunday doubleheader. During their last meeting, Charleston's offense surged, posting a .257/.358/.439 slash line with 11 home runs and 46 runs scored (7.6 per game). On the mound, Charleston's rotation was equally dominant. Five of six starters worked at least four innings, four reached the fifth, and collectively the group totaled 37 strikeouts over 26.1 innings while holding Fayetteville to a .223 average. As a staff, Charleston racked up 73 strikeouts across 53 innings.

ROAD WARRIORS: Overall, The RiverDogs are off to a red-hot start at the plate, entering the series leading the Carolina League in hits (188 - fourth in Single-A), are fourth in runs scored (122), third in home runs (21 - 6th in Single-A) and third in slugging (.402). On the road, they've been one of the most dominant teams in Single-A, ranking second among all teams across the level in hitting (.282), OPS (.820) and runs scored (88). They are also tied for first in longballs (18) in games away from The Joe this season, they're 9-3.

A BODACIOUS START: Rays No. 12 prospect Caden Bodine is off to a torrid start to 2026 after being acquired in the Shane Baz trade from Baltimore last December. He has driven in a run in seven of his last nine games. He also enters the series leading the Carolina League with 31 hits (also leads Single-A) and a .408 batting clip. Across 18 games, he has collected eleven multi-hit performances, as well as at least one knock in 15 of them. Moreover, his 2.3 percent strikeout rate (2 K/88 PA), is the lowest of any qualified hitter in Minor League Baseball (Vimael Machin, 4.7% - Triple-A Albuquerque). In 60 games for the Chanticleers in 2025, the switch hitter slashed .318/.454/.461 with five home runs, anchoring one of the nation's most dominant teams.

- Became first Wolfpack pitcher to strikeout 100+ batters since Carlos Rodon in 2014
- Third-team All-ACC selection
- Moved into full-time starting role in 2024 and helped team surge to the College World Series...struggled on the mound and decided to return to NC State for 2025 despite being draft eligible
- Dominated as freshman in 2023: 62.2 IP, 3.59 ERA, .211 BAA, 75 K
- Earned First-Team All-American honors from D1Baseball, Baseball America and Perfect game as well as ACC All-Freshman nod.
- Out of high school, was ranked North Carolina's fifth-ranked left-handed arm (2022 class)
- Threw 10-strikeout no-hitter during 2021 start against P27 Academy
