ALLEN HOMERS IN JACKSONVILLE'S 5-3 LOSS

Despite a home run from **Austin Allen**, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp fell to the Memphis Redbirds, 5-3, on Saturday night in front of 6,716 fans. Memphis (36-32) tallied a pair of runs in the opening frame against Jacksonville (30-37) starter **George Soriano** (1-2). **Mason Winn** doubled and **Matt Koperniak** singled and swiped second. A fielder's choice plated Wynn from third. Then, **Moises Gomez** singled in Koperniak. Allen launched a solo homer off McGreevy in the second but Memphis plated two in the third and never looked back.

BIRD HUNTING SEASON

Since 2021, Jacksonville's first year back in Triple-A, they are an extraordinary 28-12 (.700) against the Memphis Redbirds. Perhaps most dominantly, in 2022, the clubs matched up 18 times, with Jacksonville winning 14 of those contests (.778). Since 2021, Jacksonville has outscored Memphis 205 to 148 or an average of 5.1 to 3.7 runs per game. In close contests, the Jumbo Shrimp own a record of 15-10, including an incredible come-from-behind 9-8 win on Saturday, May 6, a six-run comeback that marked Jacksonville's biggest come-from-behind victory in 10 years.

THE BRIAN KING

Heading into play on May 12, **Brian Miller** had posted just a .217/.318/.315/.633 line for the season. However, over the last 30 games, the Durham, N.C., native is 31-for-101 (.307/.393/.416/.809) with seven doubles, two triples, eight RBIs and 14 runs scored. After posting an 8.2 percent walk rate in 2022, Miller is walking in 10.7 percent of his plate appearances this season. He has chopped his ground ball rate from 46.3 percent to 37.8 percent.

CHICKS ARE DIGGING IT

In the 11 games from May 14-26, the Jumbo Shrimp launched just nine home runs, tied for the fifth-fewest in Triple-A. However, over the last 20 contests, Jacksonville has blasted 27 long balls, including a season-high six on May 27 against Charlotte, their most at notoriously pitcher-friendly 121 Financial Ballpark since hitting seven against the Carolina Mudcats on June 4, 2010. Those 27 home runs are tied for the 13th-most in Triple-A over the last 27 games. **Dane Myers** has four homers in eight games with Jax.

YOU CAN ONLY PLAY WHO'S IN FRONT OF YOU

Jacksonville's 30-37 record is tied for 16th in the International League, but the Jumbo Shrimp have played arguably the most difficult schedule in the circuit. Fifty-two of the club's 67 games, or 77.6 percent, have come against teams with a record of at least .500. That figure is by far the most in the league with Gwinnett sitting second with 47 games against teams with a winning record. Jacksonville is 23-29 (.442) against teams who have posted a record of at least .500.

IT'S *STARTING* TO TURN AROUND

Over the 27 games from May 5-June 4, Jacksonville starting pitchers combined to surrender 103 runs, 100 earned, on 142 hits (12.4 H/9) in 103.1 innings for an 8.71 ERA. During this stretch, Jacksonville starters walked 64 (5.8 BB/9) against only 75 strikeouts (6.5 K/9). However, over the last 11 contests, the club's starting pitching has improved considerably. Over this recent 11-game stretch, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have totaled 23 runs, 23 earned, on 39 hits (7.5 H/9) in 47.0 innings for a 4.40 ERA with 33 strikeouts (6.3 K/9) against 15 walks (2.9 BB/9). Jacksonville starters have yielded one run or fewer in five of these last 11 contests.

FOUR SCORE AND ONE MONTH AGO

The Jumbo Shrimp have scored at least four runs in nine of their last 11 games, going 6-5 in that span. The Jumbo Shrimp are outscoring opponents 57 to 49 during this run. After going 0-6 to close out May and open the month of June, Jacksonville has won four of their last six. The Jumbo Shrimp's longest stretch of scoring at least four runs stands at 10 (April 27-May 7). During that run, Jacksonville went 7-3 and outscored their opponents 65 to 49.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville snapped a four-series losing streak by splitting their series last week with Nashville. One more win in this current set will be the Jumbo Shrimp's first series victory since May 2-7 at AutoZone Park... **Collin Lowe** will make his first start with Jacksonville after throwing five pitches back on 5/14. Lowe becomes the 15th pitcher to start for the Jumbo Shrimp in 2023... In 2022, 25 different starters took the mound for Jacksonville, which was a franchise record.
