NEWS & NOTES

FUHGEDDABOUDIT: The Hudson Valley Renegades and Brooklyn Cyclones finish a six-game series on Sunday at Heritage Financial Park. It will be the first of four series meetings between the two New York Major League affiliates this year. The 'Gades are one of the Cyclones' oldest rivals, dating back to the club's founding in 2001. Sunday marks the 262nd and 263rd all-time game between HV and BK, the most games the Gades have played any opponent.

YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Hudson Valley Renegades were postponed yesterday due to wet grounds. It is the first postponement at Heritage Financial Park since April 26, 2022 vs Wilmington.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Renegades split their first doubleheader of the season on 4/28 at Greenville. Hudson Valley went just 3-9 in doubleheader games last year, and were swept in four straight doubleheaders to end the season (8/6 at Jersey Shore, 6/18 at Greensboro, 6/8 vs Jersey Shore, 5/22 at Brooklyn) after sweeping their first one of the year and splitting the second.

STOP HITTING ME: On Friday the Renegades set a new franchise record (since 2005) by hitting six batters in a single game. It broke the previous record of five hit batsmen in a game, set on Sept. 5, 2015 vs Aberdeen.

- Six hit batsmen are t-9th-most in all full-season MiLB games since '05.
- Since 2005, only 27 teams have hit 6-or-more batters in a game in full-season minor league games.
- This is only the 2nd occurrence of 6 HBP in a game in the South Atlantic League since 2005, last happening on Aug. 5, 2022 by Greenville at Rome.
- The Rancho Cucamonga Quakes (LAD, A) hit 8 batters on Aug. 19, 2022 vs Modesto to set the record.

BIG WINS AND LOSSES: The Renegades have already played in an extraordinary number of lopsided games this season, with 19 of the team's 37 games (51.3%) being decided by 5-or-more runs.

- Hudson Valley sports a 11-8 (.578) record in game decided by 5+ runs.
- The club has already played six games decided by 11-or-more runs (18.1% of games), and has a 3-3 (.500) record in those games.
- The 'Gades have also played seven one-run games, and are 2-5 (.286).

RAFA RAKES: Renegades INF **Rafael Flores** extended his hitting streak to nine games on Friday night after collecting a pair of hits. It's the fourth longest active streak in the South Atlantic League and the second longest for Flores this season. He tallied a team-long 11-game hitting streak from 4/12-4/30. Over the course of this current streak, the Anaheim, CA native his hitting .400/.447/.514 with a double, a home run and four multi-games.

TEXAS SIZED: Kilgore, TX native **Chase Hampton** has been dominant over his last three starts for the Renegades. The right-handed pitcher has punched out 28 batters in 14.2 IP in that span, while sporting a 0.90 ERA

in his last two starts.

DON'T RUN ON ME: Renegades catcher **Antonio Gómez** nabbed a season-high three base stealers on Friday night to bring his total to 15 in 20 games behind home plate this year.

- He owns the highest mark in the South Atlantic League and High-A, and good for t-4th in MiLB.
- Gómez has thrown out 27.8% of would-be basestealers this year. The SAL average is 20.8%.
- Nick Clarno (AUG, ATL) leads all of MiLB with 24 while Gómez is tied with three others for fourth place.
- In the month of May, Gómez has caught 33% of attempted runners (11-for-33).
- After catching just four opponents in April, the 'Gades backstop has improved his CS% by nearly 15% month over month.

GAS STATION: Through 36 games this season the Renegades pitching staff has registered 428 strikeouts, the most in the SAL and among all High-A teams, and the third-most among all non-Triple-A teams in the minor leagues. Hudson Valley pitchers are striking out 11.80 batters per nine innings, and 30.0% of all batters faced this season.

THE K-ZONE: Over the last eight games, the Renegades pitching staff owns a 3.46 ERA in 80.2 innings, good for second in the South Atlantic League and sixth in High-A. The Rome Braves (ATL) lead the way for High-A clubs with a 2.51 ERA. Hudson Valley pitching has struck out 106 batters, the fourth-most in this span trailing Spokane (COL - 115).

ARSON PALENSKY: Over his past nineteen games, **Aaron Palensky** is batting .321/.398/.705 (25-for-78) with 3 2B, 9 HR, 19 RBIs, 4 SB and 15 runs.

- He is currently first in HR (10), third in SLG (.660), fourth in OPS (1.046), tied for fifth in TB (66), and tied for seventh in RBI (26) in the SAL.
- His 10 HR are the second most among NYY minor leaguers only trailing Andrés Chaparro (11).

CLIMBING THE LADDER: With a hit on Friday night, **Eduardo Torrealba** has tallied 105 career hits with the Renegades. He currently sits tied for eighth with Leonardo Reginatto. Angel Perez holds the franchise record with 125. **Aaron Palensky** is also starting to near the century mark as well with 85 career hits in a Renegades uniform.

WATTS-OUT: Renegades reliever **Danny Watson** tossed two scoreless innings on Thursday against Brooklyn to push his scoreless streak to 10.0 innings. The last run to score against Watson was a Blaze Jordan solo-home run in Greenville on April 30th. The former VCU Ram scoreless streaks spans across all five appearances in the month of May which has lowered his season-ERA to 1.83.

RASCAL'S RUBBISH

CABRERA: Season-high three hits 5/14 @ Aberdeen... batting .264/.316/.358 since 4/21, raising batting average from .161 to .220.

CRISP: Was hitting .400/.625/.400 in three games (2-for-5) with Double-A Somerset to start the season.

COWLES: Back-to-back multi-hit games on 4/30 & 5/3 for first time since 6/25/22 (2) & 6/26/22 with Tampa... Hitting .323 in last 10 games

FLORES: Held hitless in back-to-back games for the first time in his career on 5/2 & 5/3 vs Wilmington.

GARCÍA: Has played in only one game (2 AB) since 5/3.

GÓMEZ: Had 10-game hitting streak dating back to 4/9 snapped on 4/28 (2) @ GVL: batted .293/.370/.366 during the streak.

HENSON: Appeared in 71 games for the Renegades last year, hit a career-high 10 home runs. Hit 2 HR, drove in five runs on 4/11 vs ABD.

JONES: Yankees 2022 first-round draft pick out of Vanderbilt University... Ranked as the Yankees' No. 4 prospect by MLB Pipeline.

PALENSKY: Batting .291/.401/.582 with 19 HR across 317 plate appearances since May 18, 2022.

RICHARDSON: Began season on 7-day I.L., activated on April 18... hit 10 HR in 130 ABs with Hudson Valley in 2022.

SÁNCHEZ: Finished 2nd on the team, 5th in the SAL in SB (32) last year...tied franchise record with two triples vs WIL (5/3).

TORREALBA: Picked up his 100th and 101st hits as a Renegade on 5/10 @ Aberdeen.

VARGAS: For the 2018 international signing period, was ranked by MLB.com as the No. 8 prospect.

LAST TIME OUT: For the second straight start, Hampton was dominant last Saturday at Aberdeen, striking out nine across 5.0 innings and not allowing an earned run to pick up his first professional win. The right-hander allowed two unearned runs in the first inning after a fielding error by Alexander Vargas, but settled down to lock the IronBirds down after that. His nine strikeouts were the third straight start in which the right-hander struck out nine-or-more batters.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season on the Renegades Break Camp roster.
- Struck out the first batter he faced in his professional career, Aberdeen's Jud Fabian.
- Struck out 10 batters on 4/25 vs Greenville, combining with RHP **Drew Thorpe** to become the first Renegades pitchers to whiff 10-or-more batters in back-to-back games since Tobias Myers and Jhonleider Salinas each fanned 10 on Aug. 12 and 13, 2017 against Brooklyn.
- During a three-start stretch from 4/25-Present, struck out 28 batters in 14.2 IP, and posted a 43.8% K%.

2022 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Did not pitch after the draft.

PERSONAL:

- Full name is Aubrey Chase Hampton.
- In two seasons with Texas Tech, went 9-5 with a 4.10 ERA (101.0 IP, 46 ER) and 106 K in 33 games (18 starts).
- Graduated from Kilgore HS (TX)... Finished his high school career with a 1.94 ERA and 284 K. Was First Team All-State and District MVP.
- Tied a Texas Tech NCAA tournament record with 12 strikeouts in his final career appearance on June 3, 2022 against Notre Dame in the Statesboro Regional.

LAST TIME OUT: Thorpe bounced back after a rough start his previous time out to twirl his second career quality start and pick up the win last Sunday at Aberdeen. The right-hander struck out three and walked two while efficiently needing only 75 pitches to get through the outing. Following the home run he settled in nicely, facing just two over the minimum across the remainder of his 6.0 innings of work.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season on the Renegades Break Camp Roster.
- Allowed a leadoff home run to Grensboro's Mike Jarvis on his first professional pitch on April 9, then struck out four of the next five batters.
- Struck out 10 batters in 4.2 innings on April 23 at Rome, becoming the first Renegades pitcher to strike out 10+ batters in a single game since T.J. Sikkema on July 16, 2022 against the Greenville Drive. HV tied a franchise record (for 9-inning game) in that game by striking out 19 Rome batters.

2022 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Did not pitch after the draft.
- Selected in the 2nd round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft

PERSONAL:

- Full name is Andrew Robert Thorpe.
- Over parts of the three seasons with Cal Poly, he went 17-8 with a 3.03 ERA (223.0 IP, 170 H, 82 R/75 ER, 70 BB, 284 K, 9 HR) in 35 games (34 starts).
- As a redshirt sophomore in 2022, went 10-1 with a 2.32 ERA (104.2 IP, 65 H, 31 R/27 ER, 25 BB, 149 K, 5 HR) in 15 starts... His 149 strikeouts ranked second in the nation, trailing only Oregon State's Cooper Hjerpe (161 K), who was selected by St. Louis with the 22nd overall selection in 2022 First-Year Player Draft.
- Ranked third in the country in H/9.0IP (5.59), sixth in WHIP (0.86), 10th in wins (10), 13th in K/9.0 IP (12.81) and 17th in ERA... Was named to six All-America First Teams, including Collegiate Baseball, American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA), Perfect Game, Baseball America, D1Baseball.com and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association, becoming the first six-time All-American in program history.
- Was named one of five finalists for National Pitcher of the Year, as well as a semifinalist for both the Dick Howser Trophy and Golden Spikes Award.
- Was also named the Big West Conference Pitcher of the Year, becoming the first pitcher in school history to earn the accolade... Prior to the 2022 First-Year Player Draft, was ranked as the No. 61 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline and the No. 62 prospect by Baseball America.
- Attended Desert Hills HS in St. George, Utah.
