LAST GAME

The Baysox dropped their first of six with the Richmond Flying Squirrels on Tuesday night by an 11-5 final. Two home runs from Tim Susnara and five strong frames from Peter Van Loon, with the right-hander allowing only two hits and striking out six, powered the Baysox to a 3-3 tie entering the sixth. Richmond took the lead on a sacrifice fly, but a two-run double from Billy Cook gave Bowie a slender 5-4 lead. The Baysox had chances in both the seventh and eighth to tack on, but left 13 runners on base, including the bases loaded in the seventh, and also had two runners thrown out at the plate. They would regret those missed chances in the bottom of the eighth, when right-hander Connor Gillispie surrendered three home runs, including a go-ahead, two-run shot from Wade Meckler. An eventual seven-run eighth inning did Bowie in as the Baysox have now lost six of their last eight contests.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Richmond Flying Squirrels enter the series with an overall record of 39-37. The Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants, Richmond leads the way in the Southwest division second half standings after winning six of their first seven contests. The Flying Squirrels hold the second-lowest ERA in the Eastern League as a staff (3.74) and have made the third-fewest errors defensively (52). Richmond's roster includes nine of the Giants' top 30 prospects (via MLB Pipeline) - INF Marco Luciano (No. 2 SF/No. 18 overall), OF Vaun Brown (No. 5 SF), LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 8 SF), RHP Mason Black (No. 10 SF), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 13 SF), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 17 SF), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 26 SF), RHP Jose Cruz (No. 29 SF), and OF Wade Meckler (No. 30 SF).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

In an anticipated bullpen game for Richmond, right-hander Parker Dunshee is set to open things up on the mound. Acquired by the Giants as a minor league free agent in late April, Dunshee was added to the Richmond roster in mid-May. Since then, he has gone 21.2 innings across his 12, strictly relief, appearances, walking just 12 and striking out 31, in addition to surrendering four home runs. Dunshee faced the Baysox twice in Bowie during the series in mid-June. On 6/15, he allowed a pair of earned runs on four hits, including a solo home run to TT Bowens, across two frames. Three days later, he allowed four runs in just one inning, including a three-run home run to Ramon Rodriguez, but all four runs were unearned due to a throwing error earlier in the frame. Dunshee has only pitched into a third inning three times this season and has only completed three innings once. The right-hander is originally a seventh round pick of the Oakland A's in 2017 out of Wake Forest who started 86 of his 106 appearances in the Oakland system.

THE A-MAYO-ZING COBY

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. Mayo's 49 extra-base hits on the season are the most in Minor League Baseball. The No. 8 Orioles' No. 78 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, also leads the Double-A level in doubles (30), OPS (1.068) and slugging (.632) on the campaign. Mayo has demolished Richmond pitching this season, posting an average of .385 with six doubles, a triple, and three home runs against the Flying Squirrels. Tuesday night was the fourth time this season where Mayo has reached base four times in a game.

STAY HOT, SERVIDEO

Anthony Servideo is coming off one of his best stretches at the Double-A level thus far. Servideo went 6-for-18 this past week with two doubles and his first career Double-A home run. Dating back to the previous series in Altoona, Servideo is 12 for his last 28, including a career-high seven-game hitting streak within that stretch. Servideo has collected seven multi-hit games since the start of June, after having just six career multi-hit games prior. His batting average has climbed 55 points since the start of June, while his on-base percentage has jumped by 60 points.

AVOIDING THE TRAFFIC

In Tuesday night's defeat, the Baysox went 2-for-13 with runners in scoring position and left 13 on-base. That marks the fifth time in the past two weeks Bowie has left double-digit runners on base in a game. In total, the Baysox have struggled with runners in scoring position as of late. Despite hitting .233 as a team this season in such scenarios, a relatively middle-of-the-pack average in the Eastern League, Bowie is hitting just .203 as a team with runners in scoring position across its last 14 games.

LEADING THE WAY, AWAY FROM HOME

After starting 4-10 away from home this season, the Baysox have gone 13-7 in their past 20 road contests - including taking each of the past three road series. The Baysox have had strong pitching outside of Prince George's Stadium more often than not this season, with their 3.56 road ERA as a staff sitting second in the Eastern League. The bats have also come to life over the past three road trips, averaging 5.75 runs per game in that span, after averaging just 3.09 runs per game prior.

- Started the 12th No-Hitter in franchise history (5th Nine-Inning) on 5/19 when firing five innings against Altoona
- Opened the season with 13 consecutive scoreless innings, currently the longest scoreless streak for a Baysox pitcher this season.
- Ranked as the 19th overall prospect in the Orioles' system, per MLB Pipeline, entering the 2023 season.
- Acquired by the Orioles this past July as a part of the Trey Mancini trade. Final start as an Astros farmhand was against Aberdeen, the team he would join four days later.
- Older brother Sean played in the NBA for the Memphis Grizzlies during the 2020-21 season

CAREER NOTES

- 2022: Pitched to a 6.08 ERA in Bowie across 6 starts and 26.2 innings last season. Held opponents to a .179 average but struggled with 20 walks and 7 home runs given up in a Baysox uniform.
- Made his Double-A debut for Bowie on 8/17 after making two brief appearances with High-A - his first two in the Orioles system. Surrendered 14 earned runs in his first two starts (8 IP) for Bowie, before finishing the season by allowing 4 ER in his final 4 starts (18.2 IP).
- Played two-plus seasons at Ball State. Originally drafted by the Houston Astros in the 4th round of the 2021 draft. Struck out 199 batters for Ball State in two seasons, across 139 innings. Redshirted his first season at Ball State in 2018 while recovering from Tommy John Surgery.
- Comes from a long legacy of Indiana basketball. Older brother Sean, played in the NBA for the Memphis Grizzlies during the 2020-21 season, and collegiately at Butler. Mother, Kim, played at Indiana State. Grandfather, Alan Darner, was a high school basketball coach who won two Indiana state titles, also in the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame. Uncles, Linc and Tige, played at Purdue and Appalachian State, respectively. Uncle Linc was head men's basketball coach at D2 Florida Southern and won a national championship in 2015 - also coached Wisconsin-Green Bay and reached the March Madness tournament in 2016. Linc was Associate Head Coach at Ball State in 2022.

NOTES BY OUTING*

- Allowed a leadoff single in the first inning, but worked a double play. Allowed two doubles, but did not allow any runners to third base. After an efficient opening, 25 pitches in the fifth inning kept him from going further.
- Labored over 21 pitches and two baserunners in the first inning, but retired eight consecutive batters into the fourth. Struck out five over four innings, but an error helped cut his first inning short, and a reliever allowed two inherited runners to score.
- Relieved Houston Roth in tandem, allowed a triple to the first batter he faced, and a double to the same batter later (Tyler Fitzgerald) Both runs came from the same batter.
- Walked first batter and allowed a home run to the second. Allowed a second home run later in the inning. 28 pitch first inning followed by six strikeouts over the next three scoreless innings.
- Struck out the first four batters, then allowed a single and two-run home run. Did not allow any more hits while Bowie used two three-run home runs to win.
- Worked around two two-out singles in the first inning. Allowed a two-run home run in the second, and had to escaped bases loaded in the fourth.
- 12th No-Hitter in Franchise History (Fifth Nine-Inning) Walked two of the first three batters faced, and then the first two batters of the fourth inning. Did not allow a hit. Nolan Hoffman and Easton Lucas each added two perfect innings of relief. Personally believed it was his worst outing of the season to that point in terms of how effective his pitches were to the strike zone. Because of the four walks allowed, did not realize the possibility of the no-hitter until the ninth inning.
- For the second-consecutive start, fired five hitless innings, but walked six more batters. Collected two outs to start the sixth, but allowed a single and two-run home run. Bowie only scored one run.
- Once again started with three hitless innings, but walked three batters. Walked a fourth batter in the fourth before allowing a single and sacrifice fly.
- Allowed an early run through two early hits and a ground out. Only allowed one more hit over the next four innings.
- Allowed runs in the second and third innings, both with two outs. Retired the side in the fourth.
- Struck out seven batters over his first three innings. Allowed only run in the third inning, but stranded two runners in scoring position in the frame.
- Used 22 pitches against the first four batters for two walks and two strikeouts. Needed 11 more pitches while allowing back-to-back singles, and had to be lifted in the first inning.
- Retired first seven batters, and struck out six in a row. Worked scoreless into the fifth inning before allowing a home run. Lifted in the sixth after walking three batters.
