LAST GAME

The Baysox dropped their second consecutive game to Akron last night by a 7-5 final. Heston Kjerstad hit his fourth home run of the season to open the scoring, and John Rhodes had three RBI, including a first inning double to make it 2-0 Bowie. Akron mashed three home runs of their own on the evening, including two from Aaron Bracho - the first of which was a go-ahead three-run blast in the fourth. Bracho also had a two-run homer in the sixth to make it 6-2 Akron. Michael Berglund added a solo shot in the seventh, stretching the RubberDucks' lead to 7-2. Bowie would charge back, with a Zach Watson solo home run and a two-run triple from Rhodes in the eighth, but ultimately, Cesar Prieto flew out to the warning track in left as the tying run in the ninth to end the game. Right-hander Kyle Bradish made a major league rehab start for Bowie, going five innings and allowing four runs (three earned) with five strikeouts.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Akron Rubberducks return fifteen players from a squad that missed the Eastern League playoffs via a tiebreaker in the first half, and finished just two games off the pace in the second half. In its inaugural series of 2023, Akron dropped two of three games at home against the Erie Seawolves, falling in the rubber match 3-2 in 11 innings on Saturday night. Seven of the Guardians' top 30 prospects begin the 2023 campaign with Akron, including a debut Double-A stint for OF Petey Halpin (No. 17 CLE). Halpin hit .262 with six home runs, four triples, and 16 stolen bases for High-A Lake County last season and is off to a 3-for-12 start with a stolen base in 2023 as a tone-setter atop the Akron lineup. INF Angel Martinez (No. 10 CLE) hit .244 in 24 games for Akron last season and has continued to develop in the offseason, putting successful shifts together in both the Arizona Fall League and Guardians Spring Training. INF Jose Tena (No. 24 CLE) hit .264 in 127 games with 13 home runs for Akron in 2022 but did not feature in either of the two last games against Erie. The RubberDucks have four arms inside of the Guardians' top 30, including right-hander Gavin Williams (No. 2 CLE) and southpaw Joey Cantillo (No. 19 CLE), the latter of whom was a 2022 Eastern League All-Star with a 1.93 ERA in 60.2 innings.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Hunter Stanley is set to start on the bump for Akron. The 11th round pick out of Southern Mississippi does not have much professional experience. He appeared in four games for High-A Lake County allowing three earned runs across 14.2 innings in his debut season last year. However, he was placed on the injured list on May 3, and would not pitch the remainder of the season, due to a right elbow strain. He did, however, pitch for Peoria in the 2022 Arizona Fall League, posting a 4.43 ERA in 20.1 innings and being honored with a Fall-Star selection. So far in 2023, Stanley has had one relief outing with the RubberDucks, where he threw five scoreless innings, giving up three hits, walking one, and striking out five against Erie. Today is set to be the 25-year-old's first professional start. The right-hander features a fastball, slider, changeup, and curveball.

MOUND REBOUND

The Baysox have gotten a nice boost from the pitching staff so far in 2023. After having a bottom-half team ERA in the Eastern League last season at 4.42 and the fourth-highest average allowed at .245, the Bowie arms have turned it around to the tune of a 3.11 ERA - good for fourth in the Eastern League and sixth in all of Double-A. Opponents are also only hitting .175 (11-for-63) with runners in scoring position against Bowie this season.

HESTON IS BESTON

Last night's first inning home run is the fourth for Heston Kjerstad in his first seven Double-A contests, and also his third in the past four games. His four home runs are most in the Eastern League, while he also ranks in the top-5 in the league with five extra-base hits (3rd), 21 total bases (2nd), and eight runs scored (1st).

GETTING STARTED ON THE RIGHT FOOT

With their first inning run last night, the Baysox have struck first in all seven games so far this season. Bowie is the only side in the Eastern League to have scored first in every game this season, and one of two Double-A teams to have done so.

<p>2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles system. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (.540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Baltimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madilyn and Cameron.</p>	<p>Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023.
