WSH AFFILIATE NOTES

Single-A Fredericksburg twirled their second-straight shutout against Delmarva (BAL) last night, 9-0...2B **RAFAEL RAMIREZ JR.** went 3-for-3 and scored five runs in the win, adding a triple and a pair of doubles.

WALKOFF WIN(G)ERS: Playing as the Plates, Rochester walked off the Buffalo Bisons, 7-6, in a back-and-forth affair at ESL Ballpark on Thursday night...3B **TREY LIPSCOMB** hit his 29th round-tripper of the season in a 2-for-3 effort at the plate, while LF **PHILLIP GLASSER** iced the game with a walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the ninth, marking Rochester's seventh walk-off of the campaign...the Red Wings will look to make it three-straight wins and guarantee at least a series split tonight, sending RHP **ISAAC LYON** to the mound for his Triple-A debut...Buffalo will counter with MLB veteran RHP Jameson Taillon...

The Red Wings now have 78 wins, their most in a season since 2017 (80) and the most in Minor League Baseball in 2026...they are also a season-high 29 games over .500 for the first time since 1997, and are on pace for their first season with a .600+ winning percentage since 1990.

WELCOME TO THE LYON'S DEN: RHP **ISAAC LYON** is scheduled to make his Triple-A debut tonight, reaching Rochester just 13 months after Seattle selected him in the 10th round of the 2025 MLB Draft...he was acquired by Washington alongside C Harry Ford in exchange for LHP Jose A. Ferrer on 12/6/2025...the 22-year-old has gone 8-5 with a 3.26 ERA (37 ER/102.0 IP), 1.17 WHIP and 92 strikeouts across Single-A Fredericksburg, High-A Wilmington and Double-A Harrisburg, with his ERA ranking 10th among 152 pitchers across the four full-season Minor League levels with at least 100.0 innings...over his final eight Double-A starts from 6/18-8/4, Lyon went 5-1 with a 1.90 ERA and 0.97 WHIP, ranking third and fourth, respectively, among Eastern League pitchers with at least 30.0 innings during that span...he owns a 2.28 ERA, 0.95 WHIP and .205 opponent average in nine home appearances this season and enters tonight eight strikeouts shy of his first 100-strikeout professional campaign...Lyon will be the 73rd Red Wing to suit up for the club in 2026...

RHP **JACK CEBERT** last night, and Lyon tonight will become the first Red Wings starting pitchers to make their Triple-A debuts in consecutive games since Seth Romero and Cade Cavalli five years ago to the date, on 8/27 & 8/28 in 2021.

TREYWAY: A night after his 20-game hitting streak was snapped, 3B **TREY LIPSCOMB** turned in a multi-hit performance that included his 29th home run of the season, a double, and three RBI in a 3-for-3 effort that extended his on-base streak to 28 games...29 homers are the most by a Red Wing since Terry Crowley hit 30 in 1977, and ties Mike Epstein's 1968 campaign for 11th-most in a single season in franchise history...a 28-game on-base streak is the longest by a Red Wing since James Wood reached in 34-straight in 2024 (4/20-6/25)...Lipscomb has now hit safely in 27 of his last 29 games dating back to 7/26 at Buffalo and 42 of 47 since the start of July...over those 47 games, the Tennessee product leads the International League and ranks second in Minor League baseball with 69 hits and 124 total bases...he also leads the IL with 25 XBH and 45 RBI over that stretch, ranks second with 15 homers, and third with a .356 batting average, .639 SLG, and 1.030 OPS...

Since the Red Wings became a Nationals affiliate in 2021, Lipscomb leads all hitters with 513 total bases since his Triple-A debut in 2024...his 68 doubles are one shy of Jake Noll in first place, and 44 homers are five shy of Travis Blankenhorn's team-leading mark.

RAISE A GLASS(ER): LF **PHILLIP GLASSER** reached base three times Thursday night, going 1-for-3 with a walk before shooting an 0-1 sinker back through the middle at 98.7 MPH for a walk-off single in the ninth to finish 2-for-4...it marked the third walk-off of his professional career, all coming in 2026, (5/29 vs. SYR, 6/17 vs. TOL)...his three walk-offs are tied for the International League lead and make him the first Red Wing to record three in a season since Ray Chang in 2011, matching the most by a Rochester player since at least 2004...Glasser's 0.96 BB/K ratio this season ranks fifth in the IL, while his 13.2% strikeout rate is fifth-lowest among 123 hitters with at least 300 plate appearances...

The Canton, OH native is now two RBI shy of 150 in his professional career.

EXTRA, EXTRA: Rochester has homered in 20 consecutive games dating back to 8/5, their longest streak since at least 2004 and longest by an International League team since Louisville homered in 24-straight in 2024...over that span, the Red Wings lead all 120 full-season Minor League teams in home runs (50), total bases (382), SLG (.542) and OPS (.912), are tied for first in extra-base hits (84) and rank third in runs (149)...the Wings have also recorded an extra-base hit in 74 straight games since 5/29, their longest run since an 85-game streak from 5/19-8/16/2008 and the second-longest since at least 2004...Rochester's 50 home runs this August are already their most in a calendar month since at least 2004, surpassing 49 in July 2019, while its 172 homers this season are two shy of matching the franchise record set in 2019.

- Slated to make his Triple-A debut tonight against Buffalo in his 19th start and 25th appearance of the season...will become the second Red Wings starting pitcher in as many games to make his Triple-A debut, following RHP Jack Cebert on 8/27.
- Lyon and Cebert will become the first Rochester starting pitchers to make their Triple-A debuts in consecutive games since LHP Seth Romero and RHP Cade Cavalli on 8/27 and 8/28/2021.
- Across Single-A Fredericksburg, High-A Wilmington and Double-A Harrisburg this season, has gone 8-5 with a 3.26 ERA (37 ER/102.0 IP), 1.17 WHIP and 92 strikeouts in 24 appearances (18 starts)...his ERA ranks 10th among 152 pitchers across the four full-season Minor League levels with at least 100.0 innings.
- Over his final eight Double-A starts from 6/18-8/4, went 5-1 with a 1.90 ERA (10 ER/47.1 IP), 0.97 WHIP and .209 BAA...among 36 Eastern League pitchers with at least 30.0 innings during that span, his ERA ranked third and his WHIP fourth.
- Has pitched to a 2.28 ERA (11 ER/43.1 IP), 0.95 WHIP and .205 BAA in nine home appearances across three levels this season.
- Promoted from Fredericksburg to Wilmington on 4/20, to Harrisburg on 5/26 and to Rochester on 8/25.
- Enters tonight eight strikeouts shy of his first 100-strikeout professional season.
- Is the son of former Major League pitcher Brandon Lyon.

Entering his sixth professional season, first with the Nationals organization after signing as a Minor League free agent on 3/31/2026...originally selected by New York-AL in the ninth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Southern California...named Texas League Pitcher of the Week with Northwest Arkansas on 5/19/2024 and 7/30/2023...named Midwest League Pitcher of the Week with Quad City on May 7, 2023.

- Ranks second among qualified International League pitchers in ERA (3.82) and WHIP (1.07), third in opponent batting average (.238), and fifth in innings pitched (110.2) and winning percentage (.583).
- Over his last two starts, has posted a 1.64 ERA (2 ER/11.0 IP), 0.82 WHIP and seven hits allowed, with six strikeouts and two walks.
- Picked up his sixth win of the season and 30th of his professional career on 7/11 at Worcester, carrying a no-hitter into the sixth before finishing with 6.0 innings, one hit and one earned run while striking out three and walking two.
- Across four Saturday games this season (3 GS), the 27-year-old is 2-0 with a 2.75 ERA (6 ER/19.2 IP), a 0.56 WHIP, .138 BAA, and a BB/9 of 0.92.
- Recorded his 500th career strikeout on 6/9 vs. Worcester.
- Made his 100th career start in game two of a doubleheader on 4/17 vs. Buffalo.
- Began the 2026 season with Double-A Harrisburg...transferred to Triple-A Rochester on 4/4 before appearing in a game.
- Made 29 appearances (25 GS) with Triple-A Omaha in 2025...went 4-9 with a 7.84 ERA (104 ER/119.1 IP), while compiling 100 strikeouts against 51 walks...ranked second among all Royals Minor League pitchers in games started, fourth in innings pitched, and T-9th in strikeouts.
- Finished the season with three consecutive scoreless appearances in relief, combining to allow four hits with six strikeouts and no walks across 6.0 innings.

Entering his fourth professional season, all with the Nationals organization after he was selected in the seventh round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Texas Christian University.

- Leads the Red Wings with 101 strikeouts this season.
- Optioned to Rochester on 8/4 after his second Major League stint of the season...allowed just one hit in his final four appearances with Washington.
- Since returning to Rochester on 8/4, has allowed one earned run across 13.2 innings in seven appearances, good for a 0.66 ERA and 0.80 WHIP, with 25 strikeouts and four walks.
- Recalled by Washington on 4/24 for his MLB debut the same day at Chicago-AL...allowed two earned on two hits across 2.0 innings of relief, striking out one and walking four.
- Has recorded 101 strikeouts in 65.0 innings with Rochester, an average of 13.98 per nine innings.
- Named Nationals Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2025 with a 6-7 record, 3.28 ERA (49 ER/134.1 IP), 135 strikeouts, and 55 walks across 27 games (26 GS) between High-A Wilmington, Double-A Harrisburg and Triple-A Rochester, setting career marks in nearly every category.
- Began the 2025 season with High-A Wilmington...transferred to Double-A Harrisburg on 5/23 and Triple-A Rochester on 8/6.
- Matched his career-high three times with 7.0 innings pitched (4/23, 5/17, 6/19)...set a career-high with 10 strikeouts in game one of a doubleheader on 4/12 against Hub City (TEX).
- Across seven appearances (6 GS) from 6/8-7/27 with Double-A Harrisburg, allowed just five earned across 39.2 innings (1.13 ERA) while holding batters to a .163 BAA.
- Made his Triple-A debut on 8/7/2025 at Norfolk, striking out seven across 5.0 innings.
