### LAST NIGHT WE LET THE HITTERS TALK

Round Rock defeated Sugar Land 8-6 on Saturday. After a first inning Sugar Land homer by CF Joey Loperfido made it 2-0, Round Rock added a home run of its own in the second inning, from 3B Davis Wendzel to make the score 2-1. In the fifth inning, Express SS Jonathan Ornelas hit a two-run home run to even the game at three, 2B Justin Foscue and 1B Blaine Crim, each added an RBI to make it 5-3. Loperfido added a two-run home run in the eighth, driving in 1B Will Wagner. The center fielder's second blast of the game, and third in two games, tied it at five. Round Rock RF Trevor Hauver knocked in LF Dustin Harris to take a 6-5 lead in the bottom of the eighth, C Andrew Knapp traded places with Hauver on an RBI double to increase the Round Rock lead to 7-5. Ornelas scored on a wild pitch to make it 8-5. Space Cowboys 2B Shay Whitcomb would score a sixth run, but it wouldn't be enough. CF Elier Hernandez made a game-saving catch in center field, robbing Space Cowboys SS Jesus Bastidas of a two-out gametying two-run homer in the top of the ninth.

#### YO ADRIAN

Express RHP Adrian Sampson gets the ball on Sunday afternoon. The 32-year old owns a lifetime 11-19 record, 4.43 ERA (144 ER/292.2 IP), and 219 strikeouts across 72 games/44 starts in the Majors with Seattle (2016), Texas (2018-19), and Chicago-NL (2021-22)...he also pitched one season for the Lotte Giants of the Korea Baseball Organization in 2020.

### **NEW FACES IN NEW PLACES**

Texas Rangers RHP Michael Lorenzen made his Round Rock debut on a Major League rehab assignment. He earned a no-decision after going 2.2 innings, where he allowed three runs on three hits and two walks, while striking out three. In addition to Lorenzen, RF Trevor Hauver and C Andrew Knapp each saw their first action in a Round Rock uniform. Hauver went 2-for-4 with an RBI double and a run scored, while Knapp's night saw him go 2-for-3 with an RBI double, a walk and a run scored. Hauver recorded his first Triple-A hit, RBI and double in the game.

### LEIT IT UP

Round Rock RHP Jack Leiter took home the victory last night, when he struck out nine batters over 5.0 innings, allowing just two runs in relief. The 2021 second overall pick threw 4.1 innings before allowing a hit, and struck out five consecutive Space Cowboys.

### HOME(RUN) COOKING

3B Davis Wendzel smacked the first home run for Round Rock this season in the second inning of Saturday night's game. Its only fitting, as he was the team's reigning home run leader in 2023 with 30. SS Jonathan Ornelas also homered last night, driving in two runs in the fifth inning. The 23-year old Arizona native only hit eight home runs a season ago, so he is marching towards last season's total early on in 2024.

For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

### **EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS**

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win

campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.


