YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels came from behind to beat the Portland Sea Dogs, 4-3, capped with a walk-off sac fly by **Brady Whalen**. Richmond took a 1-0 lead in the fourth with an RBI double by Whalen. The Sea Dogs took a 3-1 lead in the fifth with an RBI single by Tyler McDonough, with two runs scoring after a fielding error. **Andy Thomas** closed the score to 3-2 with a solo homer in the bottom of the fifth, his 10th this year. In the bottom of the ninth, **Ismael Munguia** entered as a pinch-hitter and tied the score with an RBI single. With the bases loaded, Whalen brought in Munguia with a sac fly to end the game. Richmond relievers **Parker Dunshee** and **Tyler Myrick** each threw two scoreless innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. This series is the first match-up between the two teams this season. The Flying Squirrels will travel to Portland for a six-game series from August 22-27. Last year, the two teams split a six-game series at The Diamond, with Richmond's series finale win clinching the Southwest Division First-Half title. The Sea Dogs won five-of-six against the Flying Squirrels at Hadlock Field last year.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 22-11 in their last 33 games since June 18. On the last road trip, they went 1-2 in a series at Harrisburg and split a six-game set in Akron. Over the last 38 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined for a 3.08 ERA (49 ER/143.0 IP) and have allowed nine home runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.81 ERA is second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 344.1 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 472.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.51 ERA, which is the fourth-lowest in Double-A and the ninth-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors.

THE SEA DOGS have the second-best overall record in the Eastern League this season and are leading the second-half standings in the Northeast Division. The Sea Dogs were 12-5 in their 17 games prior to this series, including taking four-of-six in last week's series against the Fisher Cats, closing it with a no-hitter last Sunday. They have lost four-of-five this week. Portland's roster includes six of Baseball America's top-30 Red Sox prospects, including SS Marcelo Mayer (No. 1), 2B Nick Yorke (No. 4), RHP Wikelman Gonzalez (No. 7), C Nathan Hickey (No. 10), 2B Chase Meidroth (No. 11) and 1B Blaze Jordan (No. 20). MLB.com's top-30 Red Sox prospects list includes Mayer (No. 1), Yorke (No. 3), Jordan (No. 10), Gonzalez (No. 11), INF Matthew Lugo (No. 13), Hickey (No. 15), Meidroth (No. 19), RHP Jacob Webb (No. 24) and OF Phillip Sikes (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Ryan Murphy** makes his 19th start of the season. He started the series-opener on Tuesday against the Sea Dogs and threw four scoreless innings, allowing one hit. It was the second straight start he worked four frames and allowed one hit. Over his last 10 starts since June 4, Murphy has gone 0-5 with a 3.28 ERA (13 ER/35.2 IP). Last year, Murphy began the season with High-A Eugene and went 1-0 with a 2.90 ERA in seven starts. He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in late-June and made two starts before being placed on the injured list for most of the rest of the season. Murphy was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Le Moyne College near Syracuse, N.Y., and was the highest-drafted Division II player that year. Murphy is currently rated by Baseball America as the No. 27 Giants prospect and No. 25 by MLB.com. **For more on Murphy, see page two.**

FOR PORTLAND: Right-hander Chih-Jung Liu makes his 18th start of the year. On Tuesday, he worked 5.2 innings and allowed five runs, all over the fifth and sixth innings. In his previous start on July 18, he struck out a season-high 11 batters over 5.2 innings and allowed three runs in a no-decision against the Fisher Cats. Liu was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on May 7 after throwing a seven-inning no-hitter at Akron on May 5. Liu was signed by the Red Sox as an international free agent from Taiwan in 2019. He spent most of last season with High-A Greenville, going 4-11 with a 6.10 ERA in 25 games (21 starts) and joined the Sea Dogs for his last start of the season on Sept. 18.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels are leading the Double-A level in total attendance (307,195) and average attendance (6,400) this year. They are also 13th in the minors in average attendance. Last year, Richmond led all 30 Double-A teams in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history.

WALK-OFF WHALEN: On Saturday, **Brady Whalen** gave the Flying Squirrels their fourth walk-off win of the season with a sac fly in the bottom of the ninth inning. It was his first walk-off winner since May 14, 2021, when he hit a two-run single in the bottom of the ninth to give the Peoria Chiefs a 7-6 win over the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers, a team that included current Richmond teammate **Hayden Cantrelle**. In his second game with Richmond back on May 25, Whalen hit a game-tying, solo homer in the top of the ninth at Binghamton, breaking a shutout. The next day on May 26, he hit a two-run homer in the top of the ninth inning to give the Flying Squirrels an 8-7 lead.

FULL MUNGUIA: In his eight games since returning from the IL, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .400 (12-for-30) with two doubles, two walks and six RBIs, adding a .419 on-base percentage. He picked up four hits in his three games of last week's series at Akron and has eight hits in the first five games of this week's series. On Thursday, he had three hits and scored three runs. He entered as a pinch-hitter in the ninth on Saturday night and tied the game with an RBI single, later scoring the winning run. Munguia was placed on the injured list on May 20 and reinstated on July 20, missing 49 games.

GLOW SHOW: Over his last 14 games since July 6, **Jimmy Glownke** is batting .319 (15-for-47) with two homers, four doubles, 10 RBIs and five walks. In last week's series in Akron, he hit .450 (9-for-20) with two homers, three doubles and 10 RBIs. Last Tuesday, he closed the game a triple shy of the cycle and went 3-for-6 with a three-run homer, a two-run double and an RBI single, picking up a career-high six RBIs. Last Saturday night, Glownke clubbed a two-run homer in the top of the 11th in a 6-5 win. On Saturday against the Sea Dogs, he hit a lead-off double to start the bottom of the ninth in Richmond's comeback win.

ALL ABOARD THE SHANE TRAIN: **Shane Matheny** has picked up four hits and eight walks in this week's series against the Sea Dogs, including a pair of RBI singles on Tuesday. He walked three times on Thursday and Saturday. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 116 walks, moving ahead of **Ricky Oropesa** (2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails **Jacob Heyward** (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career. His .360 career on-base percentage is third-highest in Flying Squirrels franchise history (min. 700 PA).

RETURN OF THE MECK: **Wade Meckler** went on a 24-game on-base streak from May 17-July 6, which was the longest on-base streak to begin a Double-A career in Flying Squirrels history, passing the previous record set by **Luis Matos** (17 games) earlier this season. It was also tied for the ninth-longest on-base streak in franchise history. Meckler also had an 11-game run scored streak from June 23-July 6, which was a Flying Squirrels franchise record, passing the previous mark of nine straight games by Tyler LaTorre in 2014. In Game 1 of a doubleheader on June 23, Meckler tied the single-game franchise record for hits, going 5-for-5 and capping the night with a two-run, walk-off single for a 9-8 win over the Senators. For the season, Meckler leads all MLB hitters (min. 250 PA) in batting average (.377), ranks ninth in OBP (.452) and is eighth in wRC+ (164). He ranks second in the Eastern League (min. 150 PA) in batting average (.336), fourth in OBP (.431) and is first in BABIP (.405) while posting the 13th-lowest strikeout percentage (16.6) and the third-lowest swing-and-miss percentage (5.8).

TAKE A WALK: **Hayden Cantrelle** has walked 58 times this season, which is second-most in the Giants organization and is the fifth-most in the Eastern League. His 18.5% walk rate is tied for the second-highest in the league this season. He also has the fourth-best on-base percentage (.396) in the league this year. His 58 walks this season are tied for the fourth-most in a single year in Flying Squirrels franchise history, even with **Skylar Stromsmore** (2014), **Joe Panik** (2013) and **Shane Matheny** (2022) for the fourth-most walks in a season. He is four walks shy of tying the second on the list, which is currently held by **Jarrett Parker** (2013) and **Mark Miniccozzi** (2013). The single-season record of 80 was set by **Jacob Heyward** in 2019. Cantrelle is on pace for 84 walks this season.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP **Carson Whisenhunt** (No. 6), OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 8), RHP **Mason Black** (No. 9), RHP **Carson Seymour** (No. 14), RHP **Landen Roupp** (No. 15), OF **Wade Meckler** (No. 16), RHP **Ryan Murphy** (No. 27) and RHP **José Cruz** (No. 30). Brown is rated by Baseball America as the best hitter for average and the best athlete, Meckler as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best change-up. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes eight Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 4), Brown (No. 6), Black (No. 9), Roupp (No. 12), Seymour (No. 16), Murphy (No. 25), Cruz (No. 28) and Meckler (No. 29).

IN OTHER WORDS...

Brady Whalen on his walk-off winner Saturday:

"Bases juiced, a lot of adrenaline going. I was just trying to keep a simple plan and get something out over the plate and just put it in play. Not try to do too much. ... I started doing the math when I saw Jimmy and Munguia get those knocks. I started gearing up that it was going to be me, trying not to get caught off guard. Once they walked Matheny, I put the batting gloves on and said, 'You're the guy. This is what you play for. This is what you live for.' ... That's the situation you grow up dreaming about. While I was in rehab trying to get healthy to get back here, that's the stuff I was visualizing every night."
