### Looking to Get Back on Track

Today, Reading plays the second of six games against Hartford at home. Last season, the R-Phils were strong at home, finishing with a 36-33 record. Which compared to 25-44 away from FirstEnergy Stadium. Hartford won the 2022 season series 10-8, but Reading took the lone series at home four games to two.

### Put it in the Rearview Mirror

The R-Phils continued to struggle to open the season after falling to Hartford 8-6 in the R-Phils home opener. Reading scored first for the third time in four games, but crooked numbers late from Hartford put the Yard Goats ahead for good. Dating back to 1992, Reading has not started a season 0-4. In 2006, the R-Phils lost their first three games and went on to drop six of their first seven games.

### Runnin' Rojas

Johan Rojas snapped a three-game hitless spell last night with two hits against Hartford. Rojas also added two stolen bases to lift his season total to three. Rojas is someone who can elicit lots of damage on the base paths. In 2022, Rojas swiped 62 bags between high-A Jersey Shore and double-A Reading.

### Seeking His First

New R-Phils Manager Al Pedrique remains in search of his first Reading managerial win. Pedrique was hired this past offseason after Shawn Williams relocated to the Phillies complex in Clearwater. Most recently, Pedrique served as the third-base coach for the Miami Marlins. Prior to that, Pedrique managed Miami's triple-A affiliate, Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp. He also has experience coaching within the Diamondbacks, Astros, Yankees and many more organizations.

### Looking Up

The big club, Philadelphia Phillies, struggled against the Miami Marlins, falling 8-4. Kyle Schwarber lifted a home run and a couple of former R-Phils had strong games. Alec Bohm went 1-4 and is hitting .341 on the season. Bryson Stott also added a couple of hits to raise his average to .422, which leads all Phillies.

### Loaded with Prospects

Reading's Opening Day roster features five of the Phillies top-30 prospects. Mick Abel ranks second, Johan Rojas sixth, Carlos De La Cruz ninth, Ethan Wilson 14th and Andrew Baker 17th. All those players spent time in Reading last season.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

**April 12, 2013:** At Reading, the rebranded Fightin Phils make their home debut with a 3-1 win over Erie. In a rare Friday night opener, the club draws 8,621 fans curious to see the team's new uniforms in action. Seth Rosin tosses 6.0 shutout innings, allowing 3 hits and striking out 5 for the victory and Sebastian Valle hits a solo homer.

### The Goats

Hartford enters tonight's matchup 2-2 on the season after last night's win. The Yard Goats dropped two of three games at home to the Bowie Baysox this past weekend. The Yard Goats were shut out in game one, 8-0, and fell 5-3 on Friday. Hartford broke through on Saturday with a 6-5 win that came in ten innings. The Yard Goats were off Sunday and entered last night with two-straight off days.

### On the Mound for Hartford

Tonight's Hartford starter is righty Nick Garcia. Garcia spent all of 2022 with the Greensboro Grasshoppers, where he went 4-4 with a 3.66 ERA over 25 games/23 starts. He was traded from Pittsburgh to Colorado last winter in exchange for 3B Connor Joe.
