Today's Game

The Fightin Phils remain home and continue a six-game series against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. It is the third-of-18 games between the teams this season and third-of-12 at FirstEnergy Stadium. New Hampshire returns to Reading from June 10-15 and the Fightin Phils head to New Hampshire from Aug. 5-10. Reading won the 2024 season-series over the Fisher Cats 11-6, and leads the season-series 2-0.

Game 32 Recap

It was a wild back-and-forth game on Thursday night as Reading prevailed in walk-off fashion 11-10. The Fightin Phils raced out to a 5-0 lead in the bottom of the first inning, chasing Rafael Sanchez from the game after two-thirds of an inning. New Hampshire chipped back with a run in the third and fifth, but Reading also added runs in the fourth and fifth to keep it 7-2, heading into the sixth. Jean Cabrera exited in the top of the sixth and Andrew Bechtold allowed both inherited runners to score to make it 7-4. John McMillon struggled in the seventh, as he allowed four runs to give New Hampshire an 8-7 lead. Reading tied the game in the bottom of the frame, thanks to a home run from Hendry Mendez, then scored two more runs to make it 10-8. Nelson Alvarez suffered a blown save in the top of the ninth, as he allowed two runs to score to tie the game at 10. Paul McIntosh led off the bottom of the ninth with a double and Leandro Pineda followed with a walk-off double to score pinch runner Robert Moore and give Reading its third-straight win and second walk-off victory of the season.

More on Last Night

It was a dominant night offensively for the Fightin Phils on Thursday night. Everyone in the lineup reached base and eight of the nine players in the starting lineup had hits and scored runs as well. Additionally, the Fightin Phils set a season-high in hits in a game with 15 and time of game at 3:22. Reading also tied season highs in hits in an inning with five in the bottom of the first and earned runs off an opposing starting pitcher with five on Rafael Sanchez. With Thursday night's win, Reading matched a season-high with three-straight wins.

Go Keaton Go

Keaton Anthony stayed hot with another strong game on Thursday night. He had two hits, a run scored, double and RBI. Since the beginning of the Binghamton series last week, Keaton Anthony is slashing .429/.455/.762 (1.217 OPS) over five games. He's added three runs, four doubles, one home run and seven RBI. Entering play today, Anthony holds the following Eastern League ranks: 4th AVG (.310), 6th SLG (.510), 7th OPS (.876), T-1st 2B (12) and 3rd XBH (15).

Mashing Mendez

Hendry Mendez turned in another excellent night on Thursday. He had two hits, two runs, a game-tying home run and RBI. Over his last eight games, Mendez is slashing .310/.371/.552 (.923 OPS), along with three runs, one double, two home runs and six RBI. Entering play today, Mendez is eighth in the Eastern League in average at .298.

Mashing McIntosh

Paul McIntosh turned in one of his best games of the season on Thursday night. He had three hits, two runs, a double and two RBI. His three hits, two runs and double were season highs for McIntosh. McIntosh has been limited to just seven games this season as he missed about a month with a knee injury. The Phillies acquired McIntosh over the winter in the trade that also brought Jesus Luzardo to Philadelphia.

Welcome to Baseballtown

On Tuesday, the Philadelphia Phillies announced a variety of roster changes to the R-Phils roster. Elio Prado and Wesley Moore were assigned to High-A Jersey Shore and Jack Dallas was placed on the Temporarily Inactive List. Josh Hedjka was assigned to Reading from Jersey Shore and John McMillon joined the team from Triple-A Lehigh Valley. The Phillies also inked free agent Seth Beer to a contract from the Long Island Ducks in the independent Atlantic League. Beer and McMillon both have big-league service time, as Beer played for Arizona in 2021 and '22, while McMillon appeared in games for Kansas City and Miami the last two seasons. Hejka was acquired from the Mets in a trade over the winter and has played for Binghamton in prior years. On Thursday night, Luke Russo joined the Fightin Phils from Jersey Shore to fill Moises Chace's spot on the roster, who went on the IL.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 16, 2007: At Reading, Kyle Kendrick goes 8.0 innings, giving up 8 hits and one run and Javon Moran is 3-for-5 with a homer, two runs and two RBI as the Phils beat New Hampshire, 7-4. Mike Zagurski enters in the 9th inning only to throw three pitches (two balls and one strike) before rain causes a delay.

Here Come the Cats

New Hampshire enters today with a 14-20 record, sitting in fifth place in the Northeast Division. 2024 was a down season for New Hampshire, as they finished with an Eastern League-worse 52-84 record. The Fisher Cats went 3-2 last week against Hartford at home and after this week return back home and welcome Somerset. The Fisher Cats' roster features six of the Blue Jays' top-30 prospects: Charles McAdoo (13), RJ Schreck (20), Ryan Jennings (21), Jace Bohrofen (24), Dasan Brown (27) and Peyton Williams (28).

On the Mound for the Cats

Righty Michael Dominguez makes the start tonight for New Hampshire. This season he is 0-0, with a 0.56 ERA over six games/four starts (16.0 IP, 6 H, 7 BB, 23 SO). Dominguez last pitched on May 10 vs Hartford, and allowed one run (none-earned) over three innings, with four strikeouts. Dominguez spent all of 2024 with New Hampshire, going 2-8, with a 4.56 ERA over 22 starts. Dominguez went 0-1, with a 5.87 ERA (5 ER, 7.2 IP) over two starts vs Reading last season. The 24-year old was drafted by the Blue Jays in the 15th round of the 2019 draft out of Jefferson High School in Tampa, Florida.

Through four innings last week, Mosser was excellent, as the only base runner he had allowed came via a walk. But, he allowed his first hit in the fifth and Binghamton rallied against him from there. He walked three more batters in the bottom of the fifth inning and surrendered six runs in the frame. Reading's offense struggled to provide run support, as they didn't have a base runner reach in the entire game. Mosser was relieved by Wesley Moore in the bottom of the fifth inning.
