Today: It's the series opener of a six-game set between the Lansing Lugnuts and the Great Lakes Loons. These are the Lugnuts' final road games of the year; Lansing enters coming off a 5-1 homestand against the Peoria Chiefs, though the Nuts have lost eight of their last ten road games.

Sunday: Lugnuts 5, Chiefs 0. Tucker Novotny turned in his second excellent start against Peoria in a six-day span, striking out six in five scoreless innings, and Gunner Gouldsmith smashed his fifth home run of the season to lift the Lugnuts to victory in the series finale.

On the Air: Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and the Voice of Central Michigan University, Adam Jaksa, deliver the call on milb.streamguys1.com/lansing, while John Vicari and Brad Tunney call the game on Bally Live and MiLB TV.

On Deck: The Nuts play the Loons through Sunday, wrapping up the road schedule, before returning home on Tuesday, September 1, to welcome in the Fort Wayne TinCaps in a season-ending seven-game, six-day homestand.

LUG-NOTES

Go Nuts for Donuts: The Nuts have not allowed a run since the eighth inning last Friday, blanking the Chiefs in 5 2/3 innings in a 1-0 win on Saturday and over nine innings in a 5-0 win on Sunday; that's 15 2/3 consecutive scoreless innings.

Organizational Showdown: The A's and Dodgers are meeting up for the next six days in... the California League (Stockton Ports vs. Ontario Tower Buzzers)... the Midwest League (Lansing Lugnuts vs. Great Lakes Loons)... and Texas League (Midland RockHounds vs. Tulsa Drillers).

No Place Like Home: The Nuts are 12-2 in their last 14 home games, 7-2-2 in home series overall, and 33-24 at home this year, trailing only South Bend (35-21) for the best home record in the league. On the road, the Nuts are 19-40, better than only Cedar Rapids (18-41) and are just 1-8-1 in road series.

Who's Streaking:

- **Jake Reinisch** went 1-for-4 with a walk on Sunday to extend his team-high on-base streak to 34 games. Reinisch is batting .292 with a .432 OBP and a .554 slugging pct. during the streak, with 33 base hits and 29 walks.
- **Daniel Bucciero** went 0-for-4 with a walk Sunday to extend his own on-base streak to 20 games. Bucciero is batting .281 with a .414 OBP and a .437 slugging pct. during the streak, with 20 base hits and 15 walks.

Debut Day: Liberty product **Tanner Marsh** made his professional debut Saturday, going 0-for-2 as the Lugnuts' starting shortstop. Marsh, the A's ninth-round selection in July, was added to the roster on Thursday. He finished 5th in the nation this past season in defensive runs saved, all the while leading Conference USA in base hits, runs and assists... and his 70 runs scored (achieved in 64 games) set a new Liberty single season school record. He is the first Liberty Flame to play for the Lugnuts since 2014 outfielder **Ian Parnley** as well as the 1,011th all-time Lugnut and the 51st different Lugnut to suit up this season.

Major League Lugnuts: Ten former Nuts have made their MLB debuts this season: **Daniel Susac** for the Giants, **Junior Perez** for the White Sox, **Eduardo Rivera** for the Red Sox, and **Henry Bolte**, **Gage Jump**, **Kade Morris**, **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**, **Tommy White** and **Yunior Tur** for the Athletics, and – on August 9 with two scoreless innings in relief – 2021 Lugnut **Jack Weisenburger** with the NY Mets. In all 48 Lugnuts have appeared in a Major League game this season.

Cooperstownian Nut: A member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** was inducted on July 26 into Cooperstown alongside Jeff Kent and Andruw Jones. In his 11th game with the Lugnuts (batting .143, 6-for-42, with one walk and 11 strikeouts), Beltrán suffered a right knee in an outfield collision. He flew back to the Royals' complex in Florida and never returned to Lansing, making his MLB

AUGUST 25 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2007: The Lugnuts welcomed in Oldsmobile Park's 5,000,000th fan with a 6-2 victory over the Great Lakes Loons.

2010: The Lugnuts entered their series at West Michigan teetering on elimination, but a 4-for-4 performance from Kevin Ahrens staked the Luggies out to a comfortable lead. It didn't last – the Caps came all the way back to within a run at 7-6, thanks to back-to-back doubles to open the ninth. Closer Steve Turnbull seized the moment, striking out the 2-3-4 hitters in the Whitecaps order, Jeff Rowland, Corey Jones, and Wade Gaynor, to preserve the victory.

2018: Brandon Grudzielanek hit an inside-the-park home run in the fourth inning, but the Lugnuts dropped a 4-3 decision at Dayton.

In a Nutshell: Hometown of Las Vegas is located in Aragua, directly south of Maracay (which produced Miguel Cabrera, Carlos Guillen and Bobby Abreu), to the east of Lago de Valencia... makes his Midwest League debut tonight after joining the Lugnuts on Thursday... becomes the 16th different Lugnuts starting pitcher this year, the 28th different pitcher, the 52nd different player in 2026, and the 1,012th Lugnut all-time... skips directly over Single-A Stockton.

Signing Class: Part of a group of 16 international signees announced by the A's in January 2024, joining top prospects Edgar Montero (Dominican Republic) and Jose Ramos (Venezuela) alongside Nathan Arends (Aruba), Yohandri Contreras (VZ), Braya Cota (Mexico), Samuel Gonzalez (VZ), Celso Lopez (VZ), Erick Matos (Cuba), Hugo Meraz Trejo (MX), Azzael Pacheco (VZ), Alejandro Pereira (VZ), Luis Plicet (Panama), Sebastian Rojas (VZ), Oliver Sirotti (DR), Franco Zabaleta (Colombia)... while Montero has spent the season in Single-A Stockton, Parra becomes the first to reach High-A.

2024: Made his professional debut in the Dominican Summer League, making four appearances in June and three appearances in August.

2025: Achieved much greater success... of 14 runs allowed during the whole season, nine were scored in two appearances... if we take those out, posted a 0.95 ERA in 9 G/6 GS spanning 38 IP (5 R/4 ER)... tossed remarkable eight-inning gem on July 28, giving up only one hit (a one-out double in the 6th inning) while walking six and striking out seven on 132 pitches, 77 strikes. (This feels unlikely, doesn't it? Like there was a missed pitching change?)

2026: Began the season in Arizona Complex League pitching in piggyback relief of top prospect Shotaro Morii in the third game of the season... in worst start of the season, gave up 10 runs to Brewers on three hits, eight walks and two HBPs in two innings on June 18... two starts later, tossed five hitless innings at D-Backs on July 4... in most recent start, the final game of the Arizona Complex League season, took the loss on July 23, giving up two runs on three hits and two walks in four innings at Rockies... pitched to 11.96 ERA at home, 5.51 ERA on the road... limited lefties to .192 avg. (14 BB/18 K), righties to .237 (28 BB/22 K)... limited opposition to .145 avg. with bases empty, .288 with runners on base.
