Jersey Shore BlueClaws (16-26) vs Brooklyn Cyclones (29-14)

ShoreTown Ballpark - Lakewood, NJ (opened 2001) RHP Casey Steward (2-5, 5.75) vs RHP Matt Allan (0-0, 0.00) Series: Games 6/7 of 7 (Brooklyn leads season series 6-3 of 30)

Last Game Recap...Eduardo Lopez hit a two run home run to break a 6-6 tie in the bottom of the sixth inning and the BlueClaws went on to a 10-8 win over Brooklyn at ShoreTown Ballpark on Saturday...Carson DeMartini had a two run triple and drove three runs in the win...Ethan Chenault threw two scoreless innings in relief to earn the win and despite allowing two runs in the inning, Jaydenn Estanista picked up his third save.

The Battle of the Boardwalks...The BlueClaws and Cyclones meet this week (Brooklyn leads 3-2) for the second time this season...Brooklyn won the first series 3-2 (one game was rained out which will be made up today)...The teams will meet 30 times this year, the next time being the first seek of the second half in Brooklyn...The Cyclones last visit to ShoreTown will be the final series of the regular season.

Double-Dipping Today...The BlueClaws are 2-4 in double-header games this season, most recently losing both to Brooklyn on Thursday...The BlueClaws need to sweep the pair for their first series win of the season, which would in turn hand Brooklyn their

State of the Teams...The BlueClaws win on Saturday snapped a three game losing streak (they have five three game skids but have won the fourth game each time)...The BlueClaws lost four of six at Wilmington last week...Brooklyn swept six from Winton-Salem last week and is 11-3 in their last 14 games, entering today 1.5 games back of Greensboro in the SAL Northern Division.

Against Brooklyn...The BlueClaws have allowed 65 runs in 10 games against the Cyclones this year...Brooklyn has scored at least six runs in six of the games, at least eight runs in five of the games, and at least 10 runs twice...The BlueClaws team WHIP against Brooklyn is 1.58 and their ERA is 6.07

Lopez Back With a Blast...Eduardo Lopez hit a tie-breaking two run home run in the sixth inning of Saturday's win, his third of the year and second against the Cyclones...He was reinstated from the Injured List on Thursday and went 1-3...Lopez had been out since May 1" with a back injury...Lopez has 3 home runs and 13 RBIs so far this year, incluiding a home run and 5 RBIs in one game against Brooklyn on 4/27...Lopez was acquired from the Red Sox in the 2024 Minor League Rule-5 Draft after he spent the last two years with Greenville in the South Atlantic League...He turned 23 years old on May 8th

C-Bombs from Carson...Carson DeMartini homered on Friday night after homering on Thursday night as well, his second and third home runs of the season (his first was a three-run shot in the seventh inning of the home opener on April 8th against Aberdeen)...DeMartini added an RBI triple on Saturday and is 7-17 with six RBIs in the series...He now has five professional home runs after hitting two with Clearwater last year... A 4th round pick last year from Virginia Tech, DeMartini hit 46 home runs in three years in Blacksburg, including 21 in 2024 as a junior

The Welcome Matt...OF Matt Higgins had his first three hit game in the organization on Saturday and is now 10-32 with a home run and four RBIs since joining the BlueClaws...He homered on 5/9 in his second game in the organization...He signed a minor league contract on 5/8 before the game...Higgins had been with the Giants since 2022 and spent the beginning of thi season with Richmond (AA), where he was 11-49 with an RBI, before being released on April 29th...He split last year between Eugene (.272, 4 HRs) and Richmond (.262, 1 HR)...Higgins originally signed in 2022 as a non-drafted free agent from Bellarmine (KY) where he was the Atlantic Sun Player of the Year

of the season and second in May...Prior to the current stretch, Ware had been 0-20 in May and 2 for his previous 35

Just Grand...Bryan Rincon was 0-20 from May 2rd through Sunday but on Tuesday exploded for three hits and five RBIs including a grand slam and an RBI triple (and had two more hits in the second game on Friday)...The grand slam was the first by a BlueClaw since Jordan Dissin (6/11/24 at GBO) last year and Rincon's fourth home run of the season after the three previous had come in Greensboro in April...A 14th round pick in 2022, Rincon is the #14 prospect in the system per MLB Pipeline.

1's Back...Jordan Dissin returns to the BlueClaws to start a minor league rehab assignment (2-6, walk)...Dissin hit .214 with nine HRS with the BlueClaws last year while throwing out 28% of opposing base-stealers...He went 4-18 at the start of the season with Jersey Shore before going to Reading, where he was 8-34 and placed on the IL on May 5th

At the Plate...The BlueClaws have scored three runs or less in seven of their last 12 games (they are hitting .194 in that stretch with 40 total runs (10 on Saturday), 23 extra base hits including 10 home runs), and lost three games last week in which they allowed three runs or less...They have lost five so far this year when allowing three runs or less after they lost six such games all

Benny Barrels... Pierce Bennett hit safely in the first 10 games of May and though that streak is over, he is still 16-57 (,281) this month with, a home run, triple, and seven RBIs...On May 10th, he had the first four-hit game of his professinal career as well...A Baltimore native, Bennett was a 20th round pick of the Phillies in 2023 from Wake Forest

Cole Cookin...Cole Roberts has hit safely in seven of his last eight games (7-27 with four walks and three RBIs)...Roberts joined the BlueClaws on 5/6 from Reading, where he was 3-11 and is in his first season with the Phillies after beginning his career with the Diamondbacks organization...He is the son of Dodgers manager Dave Roberts and played collegiately at Loyola Marymount.

Walk-a-Thon...Luke Davis has drawn 27 walks in just 102 plate appearances so far this season...Davis has at least two walks in seven games this season and had a team-reocrd tying four in a 4/18 game at Greensboro... The BlueClaws High-A record is 60 walks by Baron Radcliff in 408 plate appearances in 2022...The 22 year old Davis signed with the Phillies in July out of Long Beach City College where he was the South Coast Conference Player of the Year.

Lock It Down...Jaydenn Estanista got his third save of the season, tying him for the team lead, and seventh professional save, in the win on Saturday, his second save of the series after he saved Tuesday's game (his first save was on 4/30 at Hudson Valley...Tommy McCollum (promoted to Reading on 5/1), has three...Paxton Thompson also has one save this year for Jersey Shore.

Big Innings...The BlueClaws have allowed four-plus runs in an inning 17 times this season, including once in both games of Friday's double-header (second most of any team in the league, behind Asheville's 20), in 15 different games over which they are 1-14...Their lone win in a game in which they allowed four runs in an inning was game two of the 4/12 double-header against Aberdeen, an 8-7 come-from-behind win (Eduardo Lopez go-ahead home run in the 5th of the seven inning game)...Nine of the 15 innings have included multiple walks

From the Draft... Carson DeMartini is the lone member of the Phillies 2024 draft class to open the season with the BlueClaws (4th round pick, Virginia Tech)... This is the third straight year only one member of the previous year's draft class opened the season with the BlueClaws (2024 – 3B Zach Arnold, 11th round, 2023; 2023 – OF Troy Schreffler, 15th round, 2022)... DeMartini hit the game winning home run in the Spring Breakout game against the Pirates on March 14th ... He had 46 home runs at Virginia Tech including 24 as a jun round, 2022)... DeMartini hit the game winning home run in the Spring Breakout game against the Pirates on March 14th...He had 46 home runs at Virginia Tech including 24 as a junior last year...Aaron Combs was an 8th round pick last year by the White Sox and traded to the Phillies (for LHP Tyler Gilbert) on New Year's Day.

New to the Phillies...The BlueClaws roster includes six players that were acquired by the Phillies in the off-season: RHP Augusto Calderon (Minor League Rule-5 from the Cardinals), RHP Aaron Combs (from the White Sox for LHP Tyler Gilbert), OF Dylan Campbell (from the Dodgers for international bonus pool money), RHP Josh Hejka (from the Mets in February for cash considerations), OF Eduardo Lopez (Minor League Rule-5 from the Red Sox), and OF Elio Prado (Minor League Rule-5 from the Orioles)...C Luis Caicuto was a Minor League Rule-5 pick from the Diamondbacks in December of 2023...The Phillies were the only team to use six picks in the 2024 Minor League Rule-5 Draft.

Comebacks...The BlueClaws erased a 4-0 deficit on May 10th to come back and top Aberdeen 9-8, matching their largest comeback win of the season...Their win on 4/17 at Greensboro was their first of the season in which they trailed after the 8th inning – they had five such wins last year (last one was 7/21/24 at Brooklyn when they tied the game in the 9th inning on an RBI double from Felix Reyes and scored three times in the 10th)...Meanwhile, the BlueClaws lost a 7-0 lead on 4/18 at Greensboro, their largest blown lead since also losing a 7-0 at Greensboro, on 5/31/15, and the fourth time since 2011 (4/19/12 at Hagerstown and 4/22/11 at Asheville) they have lost a seven run lead...The BlueClaws gave up two in the ninth to fall on 5/3 at Hudson Valley, a game they led in the ninth after a Jordan Viars tie-breaking home run put them up 4-3 earlier in the innine.

Power Index...Devin Saltiban led all current BlueClaws with 18 home runs in 2024 (17 with Clearwater)...Jordan Viars had 14 last year, 12 with Clearwater and two (both in the final series of the season) with Jersey Shore...Dylan Campbell hit 10 with Great Lakes in the Dodgers system.

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws have one walk-off win this year – a 5/6 win over Aberdeen on a home run by Kehden Hettiger...The BlueClaws had three walk-off wins in 2024 –July 23rd vs Abedeen (Keaton Anthony RBI single), plus July 9th against Hudson Valley (Emaarion Boyd 2-run single) and April 5th against Aberdeen (Opening Night, Boyd scores on wild pitch)...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen.

Going For Five...The BlueClaws enter 2025 with four straight winning halves, both halves in 2023 and 2024, all four halves managed by Greg Brodzinski...The BlueClaws had 10 straight winning halves from 2006 through 2010, all 10 halves in that five year stretch, a streak snapped when they went 33-35 in the first half of the 2011 season.

New to ShoreTown...Of the 31 players on the BlueClaws Break Camp Roster, 13 are making their BlueClaws debuts this season...Of the remaining 18, 14 were with the BlueClaws at the end of the 2024 season (the remaining four were with Reading: RHP Andrew Baker, RHP Tommy McCollum, C Jordan Dissin, IF Zach Arnold)...Baker, McCollum, and Dissin have all been promoted to Reading, though Baker has since returned.

Just Grand...Bryan Rincon's grand slam on 5/20 vs Brooklyn was the BlueClaws first since Jordan Dissin's on June 11, 2024 at Greensboro...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they hit three grand slams in two weeks in 2024 – one by Justin Crawford (May 30th), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9th), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...These were the only three grand slams hit by the BlueClaws in 2024.

From The Shore to the Show...126 players have now gone From the Shore, to the Show. Mick Abel made his Phillies debut on 5/18 to become the first to debut this year...Two debuted last year (Ben Brown debuted with the Cubs and Sam Aldegheri debuted with the Angels)...Aldegheri, who was with the BlueClaws from Opening Day 2024 through July 6th, joins Orion Kerkering (2023) as the only players to ever play for the BlueClaws and in the big leagues in the same year (non-rehab).

Just Win Baby...The BlueClaws are the only team in the South Atlantic League and High-A to win more than 70 games in both 2023 (73-58) and 2024 (74-58).

Bull Back for a Third...Greg Brodzinski returns to manage the BlueClaws in 2025 after leading

the BlueClaws to a 73-58 mark in 2023 (and a postseason berth) and a 74-58 mark in 2024...<u>He is the first manager to lead the BlueClaws in three seasons</u> (PJ Forbes in 2004-05, Steve Roadcap in 2007-08, Mickey Morandini in 2012-13, Shawn Williams in 2015-16 and Marty Malloy in 2017-18 are
