### Highlights

The **Kahlil Watson** (2x5, double, 3RBI) and **Kody Huff** (2x3, double, 2RBI) show continued, as the pair have combined to go 12x26 with 7XBH and 14RBI in the last 3G.

### Today's Games

The Clippers will send RHP **Pedro Avila** to the mound today, looking to take a 2-1 series lead for the second straight week (have not won a series since first two of the year). St. Paul will counter with LHP **Aaron Rozek**. Columbus is 4-11 (.267) versus left handers this year. Rozek has pitched against Columbus four times in his career, going 0-1 with a 6.89ERA (15.2IP, 20H, 12R, 12ER, 5BB, 10K).

### vs. the Saints

Columbus went 4-2 against the Saints in Minnesota last year, on the way to a 9-7 series record, and has won 46 of the last 73 overall opposing the Saints (397-310 run differential; 13 of 27 losses by a single run, only nine losses by more than two runs). Individually, **Kahlil Watson** is 10x31 (.323) with 3HR and 11RBI against the Saints in his career (7G) and **Stuart Fairchild** has hit .360 (9x25) in 7G.

### Nice, Round Numbers

The Clipper offense enters tonight sitting at exactly 140XBH (80 doubles, 10 triples and 50 homers) in exactly 1,400AB. That's good for a slugging percentage of .444 (6th best in the IL). However, there has been a relative power outage, with Columbus hitting just 18HR in the last 21G (32HR in first 20G). On the pitching side, homers have been consistent with 20HR in the first 21G and 21HR in the last 20G.

### Crazy Eighthths

Columbus had an 8th inning scoring streak snapped at 7G on Tuesday, but scored a trio in the 8th last game (zero runs in the 9th for the first time since 5/7). On the year, the Clippers have scored 75 runs from the 8th inning on (18 more than 2nd place), crafting a collective .966OPS (133 points ahead of 2nd). In the 8th alone, Columbus has 15 runs in the last 9G (more than three IL teams have all season).

### Always On

**Stuart Fairchild** is one of six Clippers with an on base streak stretching back over a week, coming into today at 9G (.500OBP since 5/2; **George Valera's** 7G streak has a .242OBP). Fairchild has drawn 10BB in 48PA this month (21%) and his .442OBP for the year ranks 4th in the IL. **Cooper Ingle** has relatively struggled in May, collecting 3BB to 12K in 32PA (20BB, 9K in 54PA prior).

### Since the Option

**Juan Brito** is hitting .259/.355/.574 with 4HR and 15RBI in 13G since getting optioned on 4/28 (9G hit streak snapped Tuesday: .316, 12x38). **George Valera** is hitting just .182 (8x44) with 2RBI in 10G since his option on 4/30 (.294, 10x34 with 12RBI in 8G rehab last month). Since the start of 2021, 11 Clippers have amassed 40 doubles (Brito, 55, Valera, 41, and **Nolan Jones** got 40 on Tuesday).

### Watch Out for Watson

**Kahlil Watson** is hitting .341/.461/.671 with 14XBH in his last 22G (1XBH in first 12G), having reached base in each of his last 13G (.453OBP since 4/23). Watson drew his 30th walk of the season Saturday and his 40th strikeout on Sunday (one of six in the IL with at least 30 of each) and, with his 7HR, he owns a three true outcome rate of 51.3% (8th highest among 122 IL hitters with at least 120PA).

### Hot Huff

**Kody Huff** rebounded from a pair of hitless games to end April with hits in each of his first 10G this month (.500, 18x36, seven multi-hit, 13RBI). The 10G hit streak is tied with Huff's career best, set during the first 10G of April, 4/1-4/12 (.316, 12x38; hit .220, 11x50, in last 13G of the month). In May, Huff leads the IL in hitting, ranks 2nd in OBP (.600) and doubles (6), 4th in SLG (.833) and tied for 7th in RBI.

### Hey Now

**Angel Genao** has hit safely in each of his last 6G (.440, 11x25, 6XBH, .800SLG), including three straight multi-hit games from 5/9-5/12. Genao was leading the Eastern League in walks (22) at the time of his promotion, but has drawn just a pair in 37PA with the Clippers (back to back games, 5/8-5/9). Genao is one of four Triple-A rookies to bat for Columbus this year (rookies account for 8.5% of PA).

### No Experience Necessary

**Maick Collado** has hit safely in every game since skipping over Double-A to make his Triple-A debut on 4/26 at Buffalo (13x34 with 7XBH and 6RBI in 9G). Collado was a career .228 hitter over 188G in Advanced-A with Lake County, having gone hitless in 6G this year (.147/.205/.294 in 10G). Between Columbus and Lake County, he already has nine doubles (career best is 13, set last year in 84G).

# Columbus Clippers Game Information

## This Date in Clipper History

5/15/2015

The Clippers overcame a 5-0 deficit in Pawtucket, scoring three times in the 8th, twice in the 9th and once in the 13th to down the Red Sox 6-5.

**Francisco Lindor** led the offense, going 3x6 with a triple and 3RBI. Lindor would spend one more month with Columbus before moving on to the Major Leagues, finishing 2nd in the 2015 American League Rookie of the Year voting (**Carlos Correa**, Houston).

## Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,423 to 1,372).

## Challenging Times

The Clippers are 54-57 (.486) in pitch reviews, with batters going 32-41 (.438) and pitchers/catchers going 22-16 (.579). They have run out of challenges in 24G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

## Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-3 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-36 when playing past regulation (.586, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 87G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

## On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to easily top 800 again, with an outside chance to establish a new team high (on pace for 889, would rank as 2nd most all-time; 898 scored in 1983).

## On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 65 through the first 41G (on pace for 238SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 17CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing (62) for the most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (nabbed 79 times in 2008, last time over 51).

## Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 77 grand slams and 1,920RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

## Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

## In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.75 through the first 41G (6.75ERA in last 12G, since 4/30). Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). However, the staff is pacing to give up only 150HR (lowest total since 133HR in 2018; averaging 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

## Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 10th in the IL this year (.978), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 22G this season (13-9, .591), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

## Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

## Good Baseball

**Stuart Fairchild** moved a runner into scoring position with a bunt single on 5/13 at St. Paul and that runner came around to score in a win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 86-23 (.789) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 3-2 mark this season (.600, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

## To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses last season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

## Manager Profile

**Andy Tracy** made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 407-426 (.489), 377-380 with Columbus (.498).

### Unfortunate Run:

Prior to 3GS from 4/19-5/1 (14.2IP, 16ER), Avila had only one stretch of consecutive games with at least 5ER in his previous 248G as a professional. That run came with El Paso in 2023, as he surrendered at least 5ER in each of 5G to end April (19.0IP, 27ER). In total, he has given up at least 5ER on 24 occasions, maxing out at 7ER with both Fort Wayne in 2017 and San Diego in 2023.

### 2026 Spring Training:

Avila pitched six times for Cleveland in spring training, turning in a 3.24ERA (8.1IP, 10H, 4R, 3ER, 1BB, 4K). He was released on 3/17, then signed a new minor league deal on 3/22 and assigned to minor league camp.

### Last Season:

Pitched for Yakult in Japan... in the Central League (Majors) went 7-8 with a 4.04ERA in 15G (82.1IP, 70H, 41R, 37ER, 30BB, 61K)... in the Eastern League (minors) was 0-1 with a 1.33ERA in 6G (20.1IP, 12H, 3R, 1ER, 12BB, 13K).
