Today's Game

The Reading Fightin Phils remain home and continue a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. It is the fifth-of-six matchups this season between the teams, with all six meetings coming at FirstEnergy Stadium. Erie traveled to Reading from Sept. 3-8, last season, and after Reading won the first two games, the SeaWolves won the last four contests. The Fightin Phils haven't traveled to Erie since July 26-21, of the 2022 season. With a win on Saturday, the Fightin Phils will finish May with a winning record (14-13), which would be their first winning month since June of 2024 (13-12).

Game 47 Recap

The Fightin Phils used a ninth-inning rally for a come-from-behind 5-4 win against Erie on Friday night. The SeaWolves and R-Phils traded jabs in the first inning, with each team plating a run. After Erie grabbed a 2-1 lead in the second, Reading responded when Aidan Miller launched the fifth home run of his season deep into left field to put Reading up 3-2. Some misfortune cost Luke Russo in the fourth as Erie plated two-more runs to go up 4-3. In total, Russo allowed four runs (three earned) on six hits over five innings of work, with a Double-A high five strikeouts and Reading-low one walk. Both teams' bats remained quiet moving forward, with Reading's bullpen tandem of Tommy McCollum (2.0 IP) and Travis Kuhn (2.0 IP) keeping Erie off the board, and not allowing any hits. Down by one in the ninth, the Fightin Phils tied the game on a sac fly to the right field corner off the bat of Hendry Mendez. Then, a wild pitch from Richard Guash scored Luis Verdugo to give Reading a 5-4, walk-off victory.

Putting the Fight in Fightins

Reading's come-from-behind win on Friday night was the second time this week, and fourth time this season the Fightin Phils won a game when trailing entering the ninth inning. The other instances were May 25 at Portland, along with April 8 and 13 at Somerset. It was the first time they won a game when trailing after eight innings at home this year. This comes after the R-Phils won just once in 2024 when trailing after eight innings. Ironically, that lone instance was Sept. 4, 2024, at home against Erie, when the Fightin Phils won on a catchers' interference call 6-5, when they trailed 5-2 entering the bottom of the ninth inning.

It's Miller Time

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller launched his fifth home run of the season on Friday night. The two-run shot traveled 413 feet and was 114 miles per hour off the bat. After hitting just .203 in April, Miller has posted a .274/.358/.417 (.775 OPS) slash line over 23 May games, along with 11 runs, three doubles, three home runs and eight RBI. Miller has proved to be a threat on the bases this season as well, as he ranks tied for third in the Eastern League with 16 stolen bases. He is well on track to blow pass Reading's season-high in stolen bases from 2024, which was 20 from Gabriel Rincones Jr.

Anthony Keeps Rolling

Keaton Anthony enters today with a team-best eight-game hit and 16-game on-base streak, the latter of which matches a season-high. His 16-game on-base streak is second-longest active in the Eastern League, trailing only Erie's Max Anderson. Anthony also trails Anderson for the best average in the Eastern League as well, with Anderson hitting .339 and Anthony posting a .324 average. His other Eastern League ranks are: 6th OBP (.383), 8th SLG (.503), T-6th OPS (.886), T-5th hits (47), T-1st 2B (18) and 4th in XBH (21). Anthony has been red-hot in the month of May, slashing .378/.439/.595 (1.034 OPS) over 21 games, along with 11 runs, 11 doubles, one triple, one home run and 12 RBI. This came after Anthony hit .268 over 19 April games.

Pineda's May

After a slow start to the season that saw Leandro Pineda hit just .104 in April, he has been red-hot in May. Over 24 games this month, Pineda is slashing .296/.351/.451 (.802 OPS), with 10 runs, eight doubles, one home run and six RBI. Pineda ranks 10th in the Eastern League in average (.296) and T-4th in doubles during the month of May.

Pitching Powers

The Fightin Phils bullpen has been strong over Reading's last three wins (Sunday, Tuesday and Friday). Over those three games, the bullpen has combined for: 14.0 IP, 5 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 2 BB, 11 SO.

From One Corner of the State to the Other

Erie enters tonight trailing Akron by one game for first place in the Southwest Division, and for the best record in the Eastern League. The SeaWolves took five-of-six from Hartford at home last week, winning the first five and losing on Sunday. After this week, Erie returns home and welcomes Richmond. Erie's roster fetures 10 of the Tigers' top-30 prospects: Thayron Liranzo (5), Jaden Hamm (7), Jake Miller (15), Joseph Montalvo (17), Roberto Campos (20), Max Anderson (21), Justice Bigbie (25), RJ Petit (28) and Yosber Sanche (30).

SeaWolves Pitcher

Lefty Carlos Pena makes his ninth appearance and sixth start of the season tonight for Erie. He is 1-3, with a 1.99 ERA (7 ER, 31.2 IP), along with allowing 25 hits, seven walks and 28 strikeouts. Pena last pitched Sunday against Hartford, allowing one run on six hits over five innings in a loss, with two strikeouts. He spent most of 2024 with Erie, but also made two appearances with West Michigan (A+), combining to go 8-8, with a 3.46 ERA over 27 games and 19 starts. At Reading on Sept. 7, 2024, Pena allowed one run on five hits over four innings in a no-decision, with two strikeouts. The 26-year old signed with the Tigers as an international free agent in 2019 out of the Dominican Republic.

In his second start of the week at Portland, Cabrera managed to keep Reading in it, and ultimately landed a no-decision. He allowed three runs, but was the victim of some defensive misfortune and one of the runs was unearned. He struck out just three, but was much more efficient, allowing a season-low one walk. Cabrera was relieved by Tommy McCollum in the bottom of the sixth inning.

2025 Season:

- Prior to the 2025 season, Cabrera was added to the Phillies 40-man roster (on 11/19/24) to protect him from the Rule-5 Draft
- The Phillies optioned Cabrera to Reading (AA) on March 8
- Appeared in relief for the Phillies in the Spring Breakout Game (3/14 vs PIT) and tossed two innings following Moises Chace, who started the game
- Opens the season ranked as the Phillies No. 11 Prospect (MLB Pipeline)
- Named the Fightin Phils Opening Day starter and allowed 1 ER over 4.2 IP in a no-decision on Apr. 4 vs Portland
- Suffered first loss of season over 4.1 IP at Somerset on Apr. 10
- Earned first victory of season Apr. 16 vs Binghamton, posting season-highs in IP (5.0) and strikeouts (7)
- Threw season-high in innings (6.0), pitches (89) and runs (4) on Apr. 22 at Portland
- Leads team with 31 walks allowed; matched career-high with five May 1 vs HBG
- Had season-best outing May 8 at BNG, matching season-high with six innings and setting season-best with eight strikeouts in no-decision
- Matched season-high with four runs allowed and surrendered first two home runs of season in no-decision May 15 vs New Hampshire
- Allowed four runs and walked five batters for second time this season May 20 vs Portland
- Season-low one walk surrendered May 25 at Portland in no-decision
