**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds look to make it three wins in a row against the Norfolk Tides in a Thursday matinee at Harbor Park. Nashville took advantage of the weather last night to hold on to a rain-shortened 5-3 victory. Today, Milwaukee's No. 7 prospect (MLB Pipeline) Robert Gasser takes the mound for the Sounds, against rehabbing Baltimore Oriole Austin Voth.

**Robert Gasser:** 24-year-old Robert Gasser gets the nod for Nashville. The left-hander is 5-1 with a 4.18 ERA (90.1 IP/42 ER) in 18 appearances (17 starts). Gasser allowed five runs (4 ER) in 5.1 innings last time out against Jacksonville in a no-decision. Toted as the No. 7 prospect in the Brewers organization by MLB Pipeline, Gasser leads the International League in strikeouts with 109. He also ranks among league leaders in opponent batting average (3rd, .236), WHIP (3rd, 1.30), ERA (5th) and innings pitched (8th). A California native, Gasser was acquired by the Brewers in the trade that sent LHP Josh Hader to the Padres on August 1, 2022. He was taken by San Diego in the second round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Houston.

**Austin Voth:** 31-year-old Austin Voth makes his first Triple-A rehab appearance for Norfolk today. He's made a rehab start each with FCL Orioles and Double-A Bowie, combining for a 3.00 ERA (3.0 IP/1 ER). Voth pitched in 23 games for Baltimore, going 1-2 with a 4.94 ERA (31.0 IP/17 ER) and 31 strikeouts before hitting the injured list on June 14 with right elbow discomfort. The right-hander has appeared in 137 Major League games (39 starts) between Washington (2018-22) and Baltimore (2022-23), posting a 15-14 record and 4.87 ERA. Voth was claimed off waivers by Baltimore from Washington on June 7, 2022. He was originally drafted in the fifth round of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft by Washington out of the University of Washington.

**2023 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in the second half of 2023: First: 6 (Tied), Second: 9, Third: 6, Fourth: 2, Fifth: 0, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

**Keston Back to Hitting Bombs:** Infielder Keston Hiura broke a 12-game homerless streak with a solo blast in the fourth inning of last night's contest. Despite the homerless spell, he still leads the team with 15 clouts this season. When he was placed on Nashville's 7-day injured list on May 13, Hiura was tied for second in the International League with 12 home runs in 32 games, trailing only Memphis first baseman Luken Baker (had 14, now has league-leading 25).

**Cam Cranks It To 11:** After reaching via walk last night, infielder Cam Devaney has pieced together an 11-game on-base streak. Dating back to July 9, Devaney is batting .281 (9-for-32) with nine runs, three doubles, a homer, three RBI and more than twice as many walks (12) as strikeouts (5). Those 12 walks are tied for fourth-most in the International League and second-most on the team (Josh VanMeter, 13) during the span.

**Luis Logs Eight Straight:** Infielder Luis Urias has reached in eight consecutive games after ripping two hits, including a solo home run, in last night's contest. He boasts a .442 on-base percentage and a 1.018 OPS over the span. It was his eighth multi-hit game in 25 contests with Nashville this season.

**Please Stay in the Yard:** Nashville pitching has allowed only two home runs in their last seven games dating back to July 19 vs. Jacksonville. This comes after a stretch where they allowed 18 long balls in 12 contests to start the month of July. This season, the Sounds have allowed 93 home runs, the fewest in the International League and tied for the fewest at the Triple-A level (also Sacramento).

**Arms Race:** The series features the two top teams of the International League's ERA leaderboard in Nashville (4.45) and Norfolk (4.53). Nashville also leads the circuit in fewest earned runs allowed (413), fewest home runs allowed (93), fewest walks allowed (366) and WHIP (1.43). Norfolk paces the league in wins (60), saves (27), fewest runs allowed (452) and opponent batting average (.248).

**The Future Brew Crew:** Nashville currently has three players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect and right-handed pitcher Justin Jarvis is the No. 30 prospect.

**How Sweet It Is:** Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 653-561 record during an eight-season span.

**LAST OUTING:** Gasser worked into the sixth inning in his previous start, tossing 5.1 innings against Jacksonville on July 22. The southpaw allowed five runs (4 ER) on six hits, walking three hitters for the first time since May 19. He failed to earn a decision for the sixth straight time in Nashville's 10-9 defeat.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** Gasser has faced the Tides two times, both coming earlier this season (4/12 & 6/24). He is 0-0 with a 2.31 ERA (11.2 IP/3 ER) and 16 strikeouts.

### 2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Is on Nashville's Opening Day roster for the first time in his career
- Did not allow a run in 4.0+ innings in first start of season against Memphis
- Was first Nashville starter to pitch into the sixth in a start this season with 5.1 frames on April 12
- Allowed a career-high three home runs on April 30 vs. Omaha - one each in the third, fourth and fifth innings
- After posting 2.77 ERA (13.0 IP/4 ER) over first three starts, had 6.52 ERA (29.0 IP/21 ER) in next six games
- Spun a 6.2-inning gem in a convincing win on May 19 at Durham...was the longest outing this season by a Sounds pitcher at the time
- Tossed 7.0 scoreless inning gem on June 1 at Charlotte with no walks and nine strikeouts... followed it up with a 7.0-inning complete game on June 7 at Jacksonville, his first career complete game
- In bizarre outing on July 7 vs. Columbus, ejected after throwing one pitch (HBP, Brayan Rocchio)... is currently sole one-pitch start in full-season minors in 2023 and only one by a Nashville starter since at least 2000.
- After walking 25 hitters in first eight appearances (5.92 per 9 IP, 14.7%), has issued 10 free passes in last 10 starts (1.72 per 9 IP, 4.7%)
- Did not allow a first-inning run through first 15 starts of season... has the lowest first-inning opponent batting average (.109) in minors (min. 15 starts)
