LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones were unable to snatch a series victory, settling for a split after a 12-6 loss at Asheville...Brooklyn jumped out to an early 3-0 lead on a leadoff solo home run by CF Eli Serrano III and a 2-run blast by 1B Jacob Reimer...C Chris Suero added a 2-run shot in the 6th...Asheville scored 3 in the 1st, 3 in the 2nd, and 4 in the 5th to jump out to a 10-3 lead...RF Joseph Sullivan hit a go-ahead 3-run home run for the Tourists in the 2nd, adding a RBI triple as part of a 4-RBI day...Serrano, Suero, and SS Marco Vargas tallied multi-hit games for Brooklyn.

NEW ON THE BOARDWALK: The Cyclones made several roster moves on Monday ahead of Tuesday's series opener vs. Winston-Salem...Brooklyn added RHPs Matt Allan, Nate Dohm, and Raimon Gómez from Single-A St. Lucie...RHPs Anthony Nunez and Dylan Ross were transferred to Double-A Binghamton...Prior to 2025, Allan's last pitch in an official contest was in the deciding Game 3 of the 2019 New York-Penn League Championship Series vs. Lowell... Did not pitch in 2024 while recovering from injury, in 2023 after undergoing UCL revision surgery, and in 2021 date undergoing UCL revision surgery. and in 2021 due to Tommy John surgery... In 7 starts this year, Allan was 0-2 with a 3.60 ERA (6 ER in 15.0 IP), 11 walks and 17 strikeouts... Dohm tallied a 2-3 mark with a 3.18 ERA (10 ER in 28.1 IP), 10 walks, and 34 K's in 7 starts with St. Lucie...Dohm was tied for 5th in the Florida State League in strikeouts (34) and tied for 7th in innings pitched (28.1) at the time of his promotion...Gómez returns to Brooklyn after serving as the team's Opening Day starter in 2023...He made 3 starts before undergoing season-ending Tommy John surgery...In 6 appearances (3 starts), the 23-year-old was 2-0 with a 0.69 ERA (1 ER in 13.0 IP), 10 walks, and 20 strikeouts.

HOMER HAPPY: Brooklyn's offense erupted in the 2nd inning last Friday...RF Eli Serrano III, DH A.J. Ewing, and CF Carson Benge clubbed back-to-back-to-back home runs with 1 out in the frame off Asheville's RHP Yeriel Santos...lt marked just the 2nd time Brooklyn had hit 3-straight home runs in Minor League Baseball's Digital Era (2005-present)...2B Luke Ritter, 1B Joe Genord, and C José Mena first accomplished the feat with back-to-back-to-back shots in the 6th inning on June 20, 2021, at Wilmington...SS Jesús Báez added a 4th homer un in the frame, marking the first time in Mil.Bs Digital Era that the Cyclones powered 4 long balls in a single inning...The feat has been accomplished just 2 other times in Mil.B this season... Miami's Double-A Pensacola accomplished the feat with 4 homers in the 3rd inning on April 26 vs. Knoxville...Chicago-NL's Triple-A lowa blasted 5 home runs in the 7th inning on April 16 vs. St. Paul...Brooklyn enters Tuesday ranked 2nd in the South Atlantic League in home runs (32)...Since 2005, only the 2021 team (34) has hit home runs through the team's first 32 games.

HALL PASS: After an injury-shortened 2024, RHP Noah Hall has returned to form in 2025... Over his first 7 starts, the Charlotte, N.C. native is 3-2 with a 1.83 ERA (7 ER in 34.1 IP), 37 strike-outs and only 22 hits allowed...Entering Tuesday, Hall is 4th in the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.83), 5th in batting average against (1.82), tied for 5th in innings pitched (34.1), tied for 6th in double plays induced (3), and tied for 10th in strikeouts (37)...Hall's 56.0% groundball rate is also tops in the circuit...His 48.0% infield fly ball rate is 2nd...The University of South Carolina product became not only the 1st player in franchise history to start on consecutive Opening Days, but the 1st player in franchise history to start multiple Opening Days.

REIM TIME: INF Jacob Reimer remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season...The former 4th-round pick recorded more RBI (8) in the first 2 games of 2025 than he had in 25 outings (7) in an injury-plagued 2024...Reimer is 4th in Minor League Baseball in OPS (1.063) and slugging percentage (.641), tied for 4th in total bases (75), and tied for 9th in total bases (75), and tied for 9th in doubles (12)...The former 4th-round pick leads the South Atlantic League in total bases (75), hits (39), slugging percentage (.641), OPS (1.063), extra-base hits (21), and doubles (12), and tied for 1st in triples (3) and RBI (28)...Reimer is also 2nd in batting average (.333), tied for 2nd in runs scored (26), tied for 6th in home runs (6), and 8th in on-base percentage (.422)... Reimer enters Tuesday on a 14-game on-base streak since April 24...In that time, he is hitting .352/.470/.685/1.155 with 13 runs scored, 6 doubles, 4 home runs, 15 RBI, 9 walks, 2 steals, and 3 hit-by-pitches.

SUPER SUERO: C Chris Suero has been unstoppable in 2025...On April 17, he delivered the goahead 2-run double in the 9th, in a 7-3 comeback win at Aberdeen...On April 15, the 21-year-old recorded the 2nd multi-home run game of his career in an 8-7 victory...Suero powered a 2-run blast in the 2nd and added another 2-run shot in the 3rd...The Bronx native homered in 3-straight at-bats dating back to his solo shot in the 6th inning on April 13 vs. Hudson Valley... Entering play on Tuesday, Suero is tied for 2nd in the South Atlantic League in hit-by-pitches (8), tied for 6th in home runs (6), tied for 6th in extra-base hits (12), 8th in slugging percentage (.511), and tied for 9th in stolen bases (11), OPS (.893), and RBI (21).

SIR SERRANO: OF Eli Serrano III put together his best game as a professional in April 24's win at Jersey Shore...The 21-year-old went 5-for-6 at the plate, scored 3 runs, doubled twice, blasted a solo home run in the 8th, and drove in 3...Since 2005, Serrano was the 1st Cyclone to record 5- hits, 3+ runs, 3+ extra-base hits, a home run, and 3+ RBI in a single game...He is only the 2nd Brooklyn player to record 5-or-more hits, hit a home run, and drive in 3-or-more runs in a single game since 2005...28 Luke Ritter also accomplished the feat with 5 hits, a home run, and 3 RBI in a 5-4 win vs. Lowell in 11 innings on June 28, 2019...Ritter's home run was a game-tying blast in the 9th...Serrano is also the 2nd Cyclone to tally a 5-hit game at the High-A level and 9th overall since 2005...LF Alex Ramirez was the last player to accomplish the feat with a franchise-record 6 hits on July 21, 2023, at Hudson Valley...Entering Tuesday, Serrano is 4th in the South Attantic League in extra-base hits (14), tied for 6th in total bases (53), tied for 7th in runs scored (22), tied for 8th in home runs (5), and 9th in slugging percentage (.495).

**ALL ABOUT THE BENGE-AMINS:** OF **Carson Benge** has been heating up at the plate over the last few weeks...The 2024 first-round pick enters Tuesday tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League in runs scored (23) and 7th in hits (31)...The 22-year-old is riding a 4-game hitting streak since Thursday in which he is 6-for-16 (.375) at the plate with 4 runs scored, a double, a home run, 5 RBI, 4 walks, and 3 stolen bases...Benge has also reached base safely in 7-straight games since May 3 vs. Wilmington, hitting .308 (8-26) with 7 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, 7 RBI, 7 walks, and 4 stolen bases.

EW CAN'T STOP HIM: IF/OF A.J. Ewing has had a marvelous start to his 2025 season...Entering play on Tuesday, the 20-year-old is tied for 2nd in Minor League Baseball in triples (5) and 7th in batting average (.361) and stolen bases (21)...Ewing has reached base safely in all 10 games he's played with the Cyclones and has reached in 17-straight games since April 18 vs. Tampa with Single-A St. Lucie...In that time, Ewing is hitting .328/.430/.507/.937 with 12 runs scored, 3 doubles, 3 triples, a home run, 10 runs batted in, 12 walks, and 14 stolen bases.

MARCO POLO: IF Marco Vargas has not stopped hitting since joining the Cyclones at the start of last week...The 19-year-old has reached safely in all 10 games played with Brooklyn, and in all 23 contests he has appeared in this year between the Cyclones and Single-A St. Lucie...

Winston-Salem RHP Matt Allan (NR)

vs. WINSTON-SALEM: After a 3-3 road trip in Asheville, Brooklyn returns home for a 6-game series with the Dash...Winston-Salem enters the series after splitting a 6-game set at home vs. Bowling Green...This is the Cyclones only matchup with Dash in 2025...Winston-Salem is 4-8 on the road this season...The Dash boast 4 of the White Sox's Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF Braden Montgomery (4), INF Jeral Pérez (20), RHP Aldrin Batista (24), and UTL Sam Antonacci (29)...Batista is currently on the injured list...In 30 meetings since 2022, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 16-14 (.533)...Brooklyn is 7-5 (.583) in 12 games on Coney Island.

During the 22-game on-base streak, Vargas is hitting .337/.451/.434/.885 with 20 runs scored, 3 doubles, a triple, a home run, 13 RBI, 17 walks, and 7 stolen bases.

WHAT A RELIEF!: Brooklyn's bullpen has been dominant in the 2025 season...Entering play on Tuesday, Cyclones relievers have a 12-5 record with a 3.53 ERA (58 ER in 147.2 IP), 7 saves, 78 walks, and an eye-popping 206 strikeouts...Brooklyn's 12.56 strikeouts-per-nine-innings ratio is the best at High-A and 2nd-best in Mil.B...Chicago-NL's Triple-A lowa (13.05) holds the top spot...The Cyclones have also held opponents to a 188 batting average, which is the lowest at High-A and 6th-lowest in the minors...Pensacola is 1st (166)...On the year, Brooklyn relievers have a 33.72% strikeout rate.

AWARD SEASON: The Cyclones swept the South Atlantic League Player and Pitcher of the Month awards that were handed out last Monday...INF Jacob Reimer was recognized as the SAL Player of the Month, and LHP Zach Thornton, now at Double-A Binghamton, was named as the SAL Pitcher of the Month, and LHP Zach Thornton, now at Double-A Binghamton, was named as the SAL Pitcher of the Month...In 21 games during April, Reimer hit .318/.383/.659/1.042 with 18 runs scored, 8 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs, 21 RBI, 9 walks, and a stolen ase...The 21-year-old paced the SAL in doubles (8), extra-base hits (16), triples (3), slugging percentage (.659), and total bases (56)...Reimer also was 2nd in OPS (1.042), tied for 2nd in RBI (21) and hits (27), 4th in batting average (.318), tied for 4th in home runs (5), tied for 6th in runs scored (18)...The Yucaipa, Calif. native was also 5th in Minor League Baseball in slugging percentage (.659), tied for 5th in extra-base hits (16), and tied for 8th in total bases (56)...Thornton accrued a perfect 3-0 record with a 0.44 ERA (1 ER in 20.2 IP), 12 hits, 2 walks, and 25 strikeouts in 4 starts...Among SAL arms with 20.0-plus innings pitched in April, Thornton led the league in strikeout-to-walk ratio (12.50) and was tied with teammate RHP Joel Diaz for the league lead in ERA (0.44) and WHIP (0.68)...He also tied for first in wins (3) and sat 3rd in batting average against (162)... Additionally, IF/OF A.J. Ewing took home Florida State League Player of the Month honors in April...With Single-A St. Lucie, the 20-year-old hit .400/.506/.615/1.121 with 15 runs scored, 3 doubles, 4 triples, a home run, 20 RBI, and 14 swiped bags... Ewing paced the FSL in steals (14), batting average (.400), and OPS (1.121), and was tied for first in triples (4)...The Springboro, Ohio, native also ranked 2nd in on-base percentage (.506) and RBI (20), 3rd in slugging percentage (.456) and hits (26), and tied for 5th in total bases (40/0...In April. Ewing was tied for 2nd in MilB in triples (4), tied for 5th in

BORN TO RUNS: The Cyclones tallied 15 runs and 16 hits en route to a 15-1 win vs. Wilmington on April 30...lt marked the 3rd time this season in which Brooklyn collected 12 or more runs and 16 or more hits in a single game, and the 2nd time they've hit the 15-run plateau...The Cyclones also accrued 15 runs and 20 hits in a 15-1 win vs. Wilmington on April 5...April 24's 12-5 win over Jersey Shore marked the 6th time Brooklyn had tallied 12-plus runs and 17-plus hits in a single game since moving to the High-A level before the 2021 season...It was also the first time since 2021 that the Cyclones have had multiple games with 12+ runs and 17+ hits in the same season... Before this season, the Cyclones had not scored 15 or more runs in a game at home since putting up 16 runs and 19 hits in a 16-5 win vs. Hudson Valley on June 24, 2010.

**OFF AND RUNNING:** The Cyclones' 7-6 win over Wilmington on April 29 saw them nab a franchise record 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 different players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 set on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...On a night where 8 of Brooklyn's 9 starters were Top 30 prospects in the Mets organization per MLB Pipeline, C **Chris Suero** and DH **Jesús Báez** each swiped 2 bags, while 5 other players finished with a steal.

BROOKLYN TO THE BIGS: After 4 former Cyclones made their Major League debuts in 2024, 5 alumni have already accomplished the feat in 2025...RHP Blade Tidwell (2023) became the 5th to debut this year, suffering the loss in a start for the New York Mets in Game 1 of Sunday's doubleheader at St. Louis...Tidwell punched out C Pedro Pagés swinging for his first MLB strikeout in the 2nd...OF Rhylan Thomas (2023) went 1-for-4 with a double and 2 RBI in his debut Friday night for the Seattle Mariners at Texas...C Hayden Senger (18, '21) came off the bench and became the 103rd former Cyclone to play in the Majors and the 68th to debut with the New York Mets on Opening Day, March 27 at Houston...Three days later, on March 30, OF Jake Mangum (19, '21) batted second and played right field for the Tampa Bay Rays and went 0-for-3 with a walk...RHP Mike Vasil debuted for the Chicago White Sox a day later, tossing 2.0 innings of two-hit shutout relief, whiffing 1B Ty France for his first Major League strikeout...The franchise record for debuts in a single season is 9 in 2015 and 2017.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 11 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF Carson Benge (3), INF Jesús Báez (7), LHP Jonathan Santucci (12), INF Boston Baro (13), INF Marco Vargas (14), RHP Nate Dohm (18), INF Jacob Reimer (20), C Für Suero (21), OF Eli Serrano III (22) and C Ronald Hernández (26), and OF A.J. Ewing (27)...Of those 11, 5 have previous experience playing in Brooklyn...The Cyclones also possess 10 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhads per Baseball America...The list features Báez (3), Benge (7), Baro (15), Santucci (16), Vargas (17), Suero (20), Reimer (21), Dohm (23), Ewing (24), and RHP Raimon Gómez (26)...Brooklyn also hosts 11 of SNY's Top 30 from Joe DeMayo...Benge (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Dohm (20), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), Hernández (26), and Gómez (28).
