

## **Terms and Conditions**

The San Antonio 1888 Baseball Foundation and the San Antonio Missions Baseball Club have established the Extra Innings Equipment Drive with the following considerations.

Foundation and Missions staff and volunteers will conduct equipment drives with the purpose of collecting gently used sports equipment for redistribution to youth sports leagues and organizations with a purpose to enhance the opportunity for every child to play youth sports and gradually eliminate the availability and affordability of equipment as a barrier to participation.

Collection events will occur at Nelson Wolff Stadium and at various corporate locations around the San Antonio community.

All donations will be considered “anonymous”, and donors will be presented a receipt, on request, that can be filled out as desired by individual donors. Donors who contribute an item or items with a Fair Market Value of \$250 and more (as determined by donor), or who make a direct financial contribution over \$250, can request appropriate acknowledgement from the Foundation for IRS purposes and will be asked to provide contact details. An acknowledgement letter will be sent at a later date but within the tax year that the item was received. If you receive property or services (*e.g.*, sports tickets) in exchange for your donation, your tax deduction will be limited to the amount by which the value of your donation exceeds the value of the property you receive in return. Please speak to your personal tax advisor if you have any questions.

**Acceptance of Donated Equipment:** We will accept almost all sports equipment /items associated with: Baseball, softball, soccer, football, basketball, ice hockey, field hockey, golf, tennis, and lacrosse and more. We also accept PE/Recess items for use by schools. Headgear items such as football helmets must be less than five years old. The Foundation reserves the right to reject any headgear or other donated item regardless of age or condition.

**Items that we do NOT accept:** We don’t accept athletic clothing (sweatshirts, compression shirts, individual jerseys, underwear, hats), bicycles, bicycle helmets, trophies, running/cross training shoes, fishing gear, swimming equipment, ski/snowboard equipment and cups/jock straps.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** We appreciate the donor assuring that donations are still in safe, functional condition. **Our overall guidance is to donate equipment that you would allow your kids to use.**

Final determination of acceptance of items for re-distribution is subject to absolute discretion of San Antonio 1888 Baseball Foundation and San Antonio Missions Baseball Club and all decisions are final. Donated items deemed unsuitable for continued use will be disposed of appropriately and not returned to original donors.
