JUMBO SHRIMP FALL TO KNIGHTS 5-2

The Charlotte Knights blasted two home runs in a fourrun fourth inning propelling them to a 5-2 victory over the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp Wednesday afternoon. With the score tied at one in the fourth inning, Yolbert Sánchez and Evan Skoug each singled to begin the frame against Jacksonville (21-24) starter Ronald Bolaños (1-5). Stephen Piscotty homered (2) to left field to put Charlotte (23-24) ahead 4-1. With two outs in the inning, Lenyn Sosa homered (7) to right to tack on a run for the Knights.

PEN PAI

The Jacksonville bullpen struggled mightily during a seven-game stretch from April 14-26. Over that timeframe, Jumbo Shrimp relievers collectively surrendered 27 runs, 26 earned, on 38 hits (11.7 H/9) in 29.1 innings for a 7.98 ERA. However, in the 23 games since, Jacksonville relievers have combined to cede 44 runs, 37 earned, on 85 hits (6.7 H/9) in 117.2 innings for a 2.83 ERA. The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen has combined for 132 strikeouts (10.1 K/9) against 67 walks (5.1 BB/9) during this recent run.

WALKING ON SUNSHINE

Over the season's first eight games, Jacksonville mustered only 25 walks, the second-fewest such total in the International League. However, the Jumbo Shrimp have shown a significant amount of patience of late; Jacksonville has registered 182 free passes over the last 37 games since April 11, a figure that ranks tied for sixth in the International League. During this stretch, the club has walked in 12.5 percent of their plate appearances. In comparison, the Jumbo Shrimp walked in just 7.6 percent of plate appearances in their first eight games of 2023.

AUSTIN POWERS

Jacksonville catcher **Austin Allen** entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 16 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 18-for-54 (.333/.410/.759/1.169) at the plate with five doubles, six home runs, 11 RBIs, seven walks and 12 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances in 2022, Allen has whiffed just 18.3 percent of the time this season. His .167 BABIP is the second-lowest of the 178 IL players with at least 100 plate appearances in 2023.

KING CHARLES

Over an eight-game stretch from April 14-27, Charles Leblanc went just 1-for-26 (.038) at the plate. The native of Laval in Canada has been absurdly hot since then. Over the last 23 games dating back to April 28, Leblanc is a scorching 22-for-75 (.293/.459/.440/.899) with three doubles, one triple, two home runs, seven RBIs and a remarkable 23 walks. On the entirety of the 2023 campaign, the 26-year-old has walked (35) nearly as much he has struck out (39). Leblanc ranks fourth in the International League in walk percentage (21.2 percent) and in total walks (35). His swinging-strike rate of 7.9 percent is 27th-lowest out of the IL's 178 qualified hitters.

THE MAYOR OF STARKVILLE

An offseason trade acquisition from the New York Mets, Jacksonville outfielder Jake Mangum has had an outstanding start to the 2023 season. The former Mississippi State Bulldog is 44-for-142 (.310/.344/.444/.788) with 10 doubles, three triples, one home run, 18 RBIs, six walks and 13 runs scored to start the campaign. Among the 178 qualified players in the IL, Mangum is tied for the eighth-highest line drive rate (32.1 percent) and eighth-highest opposite-field rate (42.1 percent). Those figures were at 28.2 and 32.2 percent, respectively, while playing for Triple-A Syracuse in 2022.

NOT THIS WAY

Jacksonville starting pitching seemed to find their footing in the middle part of April into May. From April 13-May 5, Jacksonville starters yielded 42 runs, 35 earned on 90 hits (8.2 H/9) in 98.2 innings for a strong 3.19 ERA. However, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have struggled mightly of late. Over their last 17 games, they've combined to surrender 70 runs, 67 earned, on 80 hits (13.1 H/9) in 55.2 innings for a 10.83 ERA. During this stretch, Jacksonville starters have walked 45 (7.3 BB/9) against only 40 strikeouts (6.5 K/9).

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville split their last series with Charlotte back in April. They outscored the Knights 19-8 in the first three games before falling in the final three in games all determined by three runs or fewer... Jacksonville has lost 10 of their last 14 games.

ABOUT CHI CHI

-González was called up to the majors for the first time on May 30, 2015, and made his major league debut that day. He faced the veteran lineup of the Boston Red Sox and began the game pitching 5 2/3 innings without surrendering a hit. It was the longest no-hit stretch to begin a career for a Rangers pitcher since 1992.

-The Baltimore Orioles selected González in the 11th round of the 2010 Major League Baseball draft. Rather than sign with the Orioles, González attended Oral Roberts University, where he played college baseball for the Oral Roberts Golden Eagles.

-González starred at Oral Roberts University, where he is now in the University's Hall of Fame. He earned many accoldaes such as 2011 Collegiate Baseball and NCBWA Freshman All-American, 2x Pitcher of the Year (Summit League and Southland Conference) and finished second in the NCAA in 2013 with 126 strikeouts.
