SHRIMP DROP RUBBER GAME, 5-3

Victor Mesa Jr. homered and Jakob Marsee notched three hits on Sunday, but the Jumbo Shrimp lost 5-3 to the Stripers. Mesa Jr.'s homer started the second, but RBI singles from José Devers and David Fletcher put Gwinnett in front. A Deyvison De Los Santos RBI single in the third evened the score and then Jacob Berry's third-inning sacrifice fly put Jacksonville back in front. However, Eddys Leonard bashed a two-run homer in the fifth to give Gwinnett the advantage again. A Jarred Kelenic RBI double in the sixth set things at 5-3.

FOUR SCORE AND SEVEN YEARS AGO

Heading into play on Tuesday, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored at least four runs in 23 of their last 32 games (71.9 percent), including 19 contests with five tallies or more. Prior to this stretch, Jacksonville had plated four runs or more in just 30 of their first 63 games (47.6 percent). Perhaps the biggest reason for the increase in runs scored has been home runs; the Jumbo Shrimp rank tied for second in Triple-A with 50 home runs over the last 32 games. They swatted just 52 bombs over the first 63 games of the season, tied for 26th in Triple-A.

MARSEE-SAW

Heading into play on June 8, **Jakob Marsee** was hitting just .193 with a .651 OPS. Since that point, the Allen Park, Mich, native has registered hits in 25 of his 32 starts, including 13 contests with multiple hits. During this stretch, Marsee is 43-for-122 (.352/.437/.689/1.126 at the plate with seven doubles, two triples, 10 home runs, 23 RBIs, 19 walks and 23 runs. On the season, Marsee leads the IL in steals (42) and walks (60) while sharing the league lead in triples (5). He also ranks 17th in hits (81), 18th in OBP (.381) and tied for 18th in homers (13).

BERRY BLAST

Jacob Berry mustered just a .126 batting average and .452 OPS with 35 strikeouts through his first 30 games on the season. The former LSU Tiger has completely changed around his season since that point. Over his last 47 games, Berry has drawn as many walks (24) as strikeouts (24) while going 42-for-142 (.296/.404/.472/.876) at the plate with 11 doubles, one triple, four home runs, 23 RBIs and 24 runs.

PEAKS AND VALLEYS

Jacksonville dropped Sunday's rubber match at Gwinnett, marking the fourth consecutive non-winning series for the Jumbo Shrimp. Jacksonville, which has lost two sets and split two others, is just 6-8 (.429) during this stretch. This marks the Jumbo Shrimp's longest drought without winning a series since going eight sets in a row from May 9-July 3 of the 2023 campaign. During that porous stretch, Jacksonville posted a measly 18-31 (.367) record.

THE MORE, THE MERRIER

In 2024, Jacksonville shattered the city's previous Double-A/Triple-A era (1962-present) record of 20 different starting pitchers over the course of the season and used 28 different starters in 149 games. Meanwhile, through 95 games this season, the Jumbo Shrimp have already used 26 different starting pitchers. Perhaps unsurprisingly, Jacksonville starting pitchers have totaled just 372.1 innings (3.9 per start) this season, the sixth-fewest in Triple-A. That said, their 3.67 starters' ERA ranks second at the level.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD

With their starters working such a small amount of innings, Jacksonville's bullpen has been forced to shoulder the load throughout the 2025 campaign. Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have worked 455.0, or 55.0 percent, of the club's 827.1 innings this season. Despite the huge workload, Jacksonville's bullpen has posted the best ERA (3.80) in Triple-A, while also leading the level in BAA (.217).

MACKTION

In 30 games from May 10-June 21, **Joe Mack** went just 18-for-113 (.159) at the plate, totaling just a .428 OPS. The East Amherst, N.Y., native has been on an absolute tear over his last 17 games, however. During this stretch, Mack is a whopping 24-for-67 (.358/.386/.716/1.102) with six doubles, six home runs, 11 RBIs, three walks and 13 runs.

SHRIMP BITES

The Jumbo Shrimp have committed just three errors in their last 10 games, tied for third-fewest in Triple-A. Their 78 errors in the season's first 85 games were the second-most in Triple-A... At 57-38, Jacksonville is off to its best start since the 2007 Jacksonville Suns started the year 59-36.

ABOUT ADAM

-Mazur was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the second round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Iowa. He made his major league debut for the Padres on June 4, 2024, tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball at the Los Angeles Angels. Mazur was later included in the July 30 trade along with left-hander Robby Snelling and infielders Graham Pauley and Jay Beshears in exchange for left-hander Tanner Scott and right-hander Bryan Hoeing.

-Mazur began his collegiate career at South Dakota State University before transferring to Iowa. He made 15 starts for the Hawkeyes in 2022, going 7-3 with a 3.07 ERA. Over 93.2 innings, he yielded only 60 hits and 30 walks while striking out 98 to earn Big Ten Pitcher of the Year honors. His 98 strikeouts ranks as the fourthmost in a single-season in program history, and he ranked eighth nationally in hits allowed per nine innings (5.8).

-When he made his MLB debut on June 4, 2024, Mazur became the fourth former Hawkeye to pitch in a big league game since 2000, joining Wes Obermueller (2002), Matt Dermody (2016) and Nick Allgeyer (2021).

-As a second-round pick (53rd overall), Mazur was the highest-drafted Hawkeye since Tim Costo was picked eighth overall by Cleveland in 1990.

-Mazur is an alumnus of Woodbury High School in Woodbury, Minn, where he was a finalist for the Minnesota Mr. Baseball Award. He was high school teammates with former Jacksonville and current Miami Marlins right-hander Max Meyer.

In addition to his baseball prowess growing up, Mazur earned four letters in basketball and two in football.

-The youngest of three boys, Adam's older brother Brandon played college baseball at Grand View.

2024 SEASON

-Mazur began the season with Double-A San Antonio before earning a promotion to Triple-A El Paso. He had his contract selected by San Diego on June 4 and made his major league debut that night against the Angels.

-Mazur was named the International League Pitcher of the Week for August 20-25 after tossing 6.0 scoreless innings with one hit and one walk against four strikeouts in a 5-0 victory over Nashville on August 21.

2023 SEASON

-In 174 plate appearances, Mazur held right-handed hitters to a .208/.236/.286/.522 line compared to a .298/.332/.418/.750 batting line in 220 plate appearances for left-handed hitters.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-As a senior at Woodbury High School, Mazur compiled a 0.58 ERA with 112 strikeouts and only 12 walks in 72.1 innings. He also played shortstop, batting .377 with five doubles, one home run and 40 RBIs.
