ABOUT LAST NIGHT... A seven-run inning proved fatal for the Vancouver Canadians in an 8-5 loss to the Tri-City Dust Devils (Angels) Tuesday night at Ron Tonkin Field.

With the game tied 1-1 to start the third, Tri-City erupted for seven runs on seven hits – six of which were singles – over 12 batters to take an 8-1 lead.

Despite the deficit, Vancouver bounced back and gave themselves a chance to tie the game multiple times but couldn't quite cash in. The C's responded to the crooked number in the third with three runs of their own in the bottom of the inning. Tanner Morris and Spencer Horwitz started the stanza with singles to put runners at the corners for Orelvis Martinez, who singled home a run to make it 8-2. A wild pitch put men on second and third before Will Robertson sent a deep drive to center that was caught for a run-scoring sacrifice fly then Sebastian Espino delivered an RBI single to bring the C's within four.

Base hits from Horwitz and Robertson in the fifth inning preceded an Espino sacrifice fly that ran the score to 8-5, but three different opportunities to tie the game – two on with no outs in the seventh, a pair of runners aboard with two outs in the eighth and a lead-off double in the ninth – sputtered as the C's dropped game one of the series.

Vancouver's bullpen was terrific tonight. Justin Maese, Gabriel Ponce, Cobi Johnson and Willy Gaston combined on six and two-thirds innings of scoreless relief to keep the game within striking distance.

Tri-City started the scoring in the second with a solo home run from Beaverton, OR native Kenyon Yovan before the Canadians tied it in the bottom of the frame with a walk, two singles and an RBI groundout from Eric Rivera.

DEVILS MAY CARE: The Canadians take on Tri-City this week for their second and final meeting with the Angels affiliate this season. These two teams haven't met since the first week of the season when they split six games at Gesa Stadium in Pasco. That eek, the Dust Devils outscored the C's 31-28 but Vancouver won the last two games of the series by a combined score of 11-4.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

ON THIS DATE IN CANADIANS BASEBALL HISTORY: August 18, 2008 – The C's rallied for two runs in the bottom of the seventh for a come-from-behind 6-5 win over the Boise Hawks at Nat Bailey Stadium. David Thomas tied the game with an RBI groundout before a throwing error on a ground ball off the bat of Jeremy Barfield brought home the go-ahead score. Dusty Napoleon had homered in the sixth to tie the game at four before the Hawks retook the lead. Jose Guzman earned his 13th save by striking out the side in the top of the ninth.

DID YOU KNOW?: Sem Robberse is from Zeist, Netherlands, the birthplace of Hall of Fame pitcher Bert Blyleven. Zeist can trace its roots back to the year 838 when it first appeared in local records for the region that now includes Utrecht, a city 35 miles southeast of Amsterdam that is the fourth-largest city in the country.

HIT PARADE: Vancouver has reached double digits in hits – averaging 13 each night – for eight consecutive games, yet they're only 4-4 in that span. The C's have outscored opponents 68-60 over this recent stretch.

SPARE NO EX-SPENCE: Spencer Horwitz is in the midst of his best stretch at the plate this season, highlighted by a career-high four hits last night. In the last seven games, the Timonium, MD native is 14-for-28 (.500) with three doubles, a home run – his first since June 29 – seven runs scored and nine RBI.

ON THE HILL: MLB.com's #20 Blue Jays prospect Sem Robberse gets the nod for Vancouver tonight in his second career High-A start. He had a rough go in his debut on August 12 when he gave up two hits, walked one and K'd four. He was Los Angeles' second round pick (45th overall) in the 2021 draft out of St. Mary's, where his 112 punch outs his junior season led the West Coast Conference and was the fifth-most in Gaels history. Bush, 21, pitched for Washington State and Central Arizona College for his first two years of college after he declined signing out of high school as a 40th round pick by Kansas City. He's from Ogden, UT.
