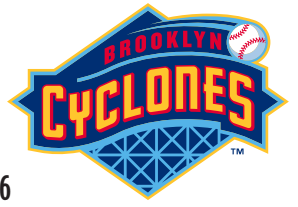

**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn dropped the opening game of their series with Hudson Valley, 4-2, on Tuesday night...LF **Rhyan Thomas** provided the only 2 runs for the Cyclones with a 2-run home run to right in the 9th...DH **William Lugo** and SS **Jett Williams** each accrued multi-hit games, while CF **Alex Ramirez** reached base 4 times on a single and 3 walks...Renegades took the lead in the 2nd on a solo home run to right by 3B **Ben Cowles**...LF **Jesús Rodríguez** added a 2-run home run to left-center in the 6th...Cowles would tack on an RBI single...RF **Anthony Hall** also posted a multi-hit game with a pair of doubles...RHP **Baron Stuart** did not allow a run over 5.0+ innings to earn the win, while LHP **Joel Valdez** recorded the final out for his first save since 2019.

**TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS:** Brooklyn collected their 10th shutout win of the season with a 6-0 blanking of Aberdeen on Sunday afternoon...LHP **Joey Lucchesi** (4.2 IP), RHP **Paul Gervase** (3.1), and LHP **Eli Ankeney** (1.0) combined on a 3-hitter...On Friday night, 2 different pitchers combined on a 3-hit, 5-0 shutout...RHPs **Joander Suárez** (6.0 IP) and **Brendan Hardy** (3.0) united to blank the IronBirds...4 of Brooklyn's 10 shutouts have come against Aberdeen...With Sunday's performance, the Cyclones have tied the franchise record for shutouts in a single season with 10...Before 2023, it had happened on 4 separate occasions...It last happened over 76 games in the New York-Penn League in 2014...The 10 shutouts are tied for 5th-most in all of Minor League Baseball and tied for 2nd among South Atlantic League squads.

**BIG RED DAWG:** OF **Ryan Clifford** was added to Brooklyn's roster on August 3...The 20-year-old was acquired by the New York Mets with OF **Drew Gilbert** from the Houston Astros in exchange for RHP **Justin Verlander** on August 1...The 2022 11th-round pick enters Wednesday 2nd in the South Atlantic League in slugging percentage (.528)...Greenville's INF **Blaze Jordan** (.533) is 1st...He is also 3rd in OPS (.887) and tied for 3rd in home runs (18)...Clifford is also 1st in isolated power (.266), and 4th in wOBA (.385) and wRC+ (133).

**THE RHY-T STUFF:** In 27 games since July 4 at Wilmington, OF **Rhyan Thomas** is slashing .368/.402/.474 with a .876 OPS at the dish and a 140 wRC+...Thomas has added 12 runs scored, 4 doubles, 2 home runs, 13 RBI, and 6 walks to only 6 strikeouts...Since July 18 at Hudson Valley, the left-handed swinger is slashing .382/.405/.513 with a .918 OPS and 151 wRC+ in 21 games...Thomas already has more RBI (13) than he did in St. Lucie (9) in 24 fewer plate appearances (139 to 115)...Since the start of July, Thomas ranks 2nd in the South Atlantic League in batting average (.357) and has 5 fewer strikeouts (7) than any other batter.

**THE JETT AND JACOB SHOW:** INFs **Jett Williams** and **Jacob Reimer** have made an impact since making their Cyclones debut on August 1...Since returning from the All-Star break on July 14, the 19-year-old is slashing .294/.358/.424...Ramirez is 25-for-85 at the plate (.294) with 11 runs scored, 6 doubles, a home run, 11 RBI, 9 walks, and 5 stolen bases...Alex is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Wednesday, the Dominican native passed INF **Luke Ritter** (80) for 2nd in franchise history in RBI last Friday and is 9 (82) behind INF **José Perozo** (91) for the all-time mark...He surpassed Perozo for 1st in doubles (36), is 2nd in total bases (226) and hits (153), tied for 2nd in walks (68), and 3rd in runs scored (80).

**ALEX THE AMAZING:** Since the start of June, OF **Alex Ramirez** is tied for 3rd in the South Atlantic League in runs scored (40)...Dating back to his 6-hit game on July 21 at Hudson Valley, the 20-year-old is slashing .294/.358/.424...Ramirez is 25-for-85 at the plate (.294) with 11 runs scored, 6 doubles, a home run, 11 RBI, 9 walks, and 5 stolen bases...Alex is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Wednesday, the Dominican native passed INF **Luke Ritter** (80) for 2nd in franchise history in RBI last Friday and is 9 (82) behind INF **José Perozo** (91) for the all-time mark...He surpassed Perozo for 1st in doubles (36), is 2nd in total bases (226) and hits (153), tied for 2nd in walks (68), and 3rd in runs scored (80).

**AIR JORDANY:** RHP **Jordany Ventura** set new career highs in innings pitched (71) and strikeouts (9), earning the win and tossing a quality start in August 2's win at Jersey Shore...He then set a new career-high with 10 strikeouts in his next start on August 9 vs. Aberdeen, allowing 1 run and 1 hit over 6.2 innings...Ventura tossed a career and team-season-high 101 pitches and 66 strikes...The 101 pitches were the most thrown by a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP **Briam Campuzano** tossed 103 pitches (57 strikes) over 5.2 innings in a 5-2 loss at West Virginia on July 28, 2018...In 5 starts with Brooklyn, the Mets' No. 29 prospect per *Baseball America* is 3-0 with a 2.73 ERA (8 ER in 26.1 IP), 13 walks (12.7 BB%), and 27 strikeouts (26.5 K%)...Narrowed down to his last 3 starts, Ventura is 3-0 with a 2.37 ERA (5 ER in 19.0 IP) and 8 walks (11.3 BB%) to 23 strikeouts (32.4 K%) with only 6 hits allowed...Brooklyn is 5-0 in starts made by the 23-year-old.

**THE ROCO SHOW:** RHP **Robert Colina** has been on a tear since he struck out a season-high 7 on June 21 vs. Hudson Valley, which was matched on August 1 at Jersey Shore...After matching a season-high 5.1 innings in his start on Tuesday, Colina holds a 3-1 record with a 2.34 ERA (9 ER in 34.2 IP)...The 22-year-old has surrendered just 27 hits and walked 6 with 42 strikeouts over his last 9 appearances (4 starts)...Colina's strikeout rate is up 2.9 percent (31.3 K%) and the walk rate is down 2.8 percent (4.5 BB%) during the period.

**ACE OF GERVASE:** RHP **Paul Gervase** was transferred to Double-A Binghamton on Tuesday after dominating South Atlantic League hitters out of the bullpen in 2023...At the time of his promotion, among Minor League relievers with 45.0-plus innings pitched, the 23-year-old ranked 5th in strikeouts-per-9 innings (14.55), 8th in batting average against (.146), and 10th in ERA (1.72)...In the SAL alone, Gervase led relief arms in ERA (1.72), strikeouts (76), fewest hits allowed (24), strikeouts-per-9 innings (14.55), and was 2nd in opposing OPS (.526)...In his final outing on Sunday vs. Aberdeen, the former Louisiana State star set career-bests in innings pitched (3.1) and strikeouts (7), earning the victory.

**THE BEST AROUND:** Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Wednesday, Brooklyn has posted a MILB-low 3.01 ERA (225 ER in 673.0 IP) over their last 77 games, holding a 43-34 record in that span...The Rangers' Single-A Down East (3.28) is 2nd in the minors...The Cyclones have hurled 9 shutouts — which is tied for 2nd in MILB — in that span and hold a strikeout rate of 28.0% and a walk rate of 10.6%...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the lowest opposing OPS (.619), in addition to the 3rd lowest hits-per-9 innings (6.89) and batting average against (.209) in that period.

**BULLPEN BOOM:** The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Wednesday, Brooklyn holds the best bullpen ERA (3.39) in the entire South Atlantic League and the 3rd-lowest throughout Minor League Baseball...The Rangers' Single-A Down East (3.09) leads MILB and Hudson Valley (3.56) is 2nd in the SAL.

**vs. HUDSON VALLEY:** Brooklyn continues a 2-week homestand with 6 games against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Renegades possess 3 of New York's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: OF **Spencer Jones** (6), INF **Jared Serna** (17), and LHP **Brock Selvidge** (29)...Brooklyn and Hudson Valley are meeting at Maimonides Park for the 2nd and final time and the first time since Brooklyn captured 4-of-6 from June 20-25...The Cyclones are 12-7 (.632) against the Renegades in the first 19 meetings of the campaign...Dating back to their first meeting in 2001, Brooklyn is 138-141 all-time against Hudson Valley (.495).

**TOP OF THE CYCLONE:** Brooklyn's has dropped just 1 of their last 9 series since Greenville won 4-of-6 on Coney Island from June 6-11...The Cyclones are 6-1-2 in their last 9 sets...The Cyclones are 26-17 in the second half and hold a 2-game lead in the North Division of the SAL over Jersey Shore (24-19).

**PLUNK-O:** The Cyclones' pitching staff tied a painful franchise record on Saturday night by plunking 5 Aberdeen hitters...Brooklyn pitching had not drilled 5 batters in a game since they hit 5 on July 3, 2018, in a 5-1 loss at home vs. Staten Island...The Cyclones also plunked 5 in an 8-3 loss vs. Hudson Valley on June 26, 2017...Only 1 team in the South Atlantic League has plunked more in 2023...Hudson Valley plunked 6 Cyclones hitters on May 19 in Wappingers Falls.

**DIAL IT UP TO TEN:** RHP **Joander Suárez** became the 5th different Cyclone pitcher to strike out 10 or more batters in a game in 2023 when he whiffed 11 IronBirds on Friday night...RHP **Jordany Ventura** punched out 10 vs. Aberdeen on Wednesday, RHP **Cameron Foster** K'd 12 vs. Wilmington on July 29, RHP **Tyler Stuart** struck out 11 vs. Hudson Valley on June 22, and RHP **Blade Tidwell** accomplished the feat on 4 separate occasions...Only Greenville has had more pitchers (6) strike out 10-plus hitters in a game this year (RHP **Ángel Bastardo** [2x], RHP **Isaac Coffey** [3x], RHP **Hunter Dobbins**, RHP **Wikelman González** [3x], LHP **Dalton Rogers**, and RHP **Luis Peralés**)...Since 2005, only one other Brooklyn squad had 5 different arms punch out 10 or more in a single game during a season...In 2013, LHP **Darío Álvarez** (12; 7/24 @ LOW), RHP **Miller Díaz** (11; 8/23 @ VER), RHP **Robert Gsellman** (13; 8/24 @ VER), RHP **Dawrin Frias** (11; 8/27 vs. TRI), and RHP **John Gant** (7/26 @ ABD).

**YO-JOANDER:** RHP **Joander Suárez** continues to hit his stride after returning from Tommy John surgery in June of 2021...The 23-year-old set a new career-high with 11 strikeouts over 6.0 innings in a shutout victory vs. Aberdeen on Friday night...Over his last 10 appearances (9 starts) since June 14 at Aberdeen, Suárez holds only a 3-5 record, but a 3.28 ERA (17 ER in 46.2 IP), 15 walks (7.8 BB%), and 66 strikeouts (34.2 K%)...Narrowed down to his last 6 starts, the Cumaná, Venezuela native is 1-4, yet holds a 3.00 ERA (9 ER in 33.0 IP) with 8 walks (5.9 BB%) and 47 strikeouts (34.8 K%)...Since the start of July, Suárez ranks 6th among SAL pitchers in strikeouts (50).

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects last Wednesday...10 members of the 2023 squad are featured...OF **Ryan Clifford** (No. 3), SS **Jett Williams** (4), C **Kevin Parada** (7), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (9), RHP **Christian Scott** (10), OF **Alex Ramirez** (12), 3B **Jacob Reimer** (14), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (22), RHP **Raimon Gómez** (24), and RHP **Jordany Ventura** (29)...Williams (No. 98) and Clifford (99) also appear on the publication's list of Top 100 prospects...Former Cyclones listed include INF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 6), RHP **Mike Vasil** (8), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (9), OF **Matt Rudick** (20), and RHP **Junior Santos** (27)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island...MLB Pipeline released their updated list last Thursday evening...8 members of the 2023 team are recognized...SS **Jett Williams** (No. 3), C **Kevin Parada** (5), OF **Ryan Clifford** (6), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (10), OF **Alex Ramirez** (11), RHP **Christian Scott** (12), IF **Jacob Reimer** (13), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (17), and RHP **Raimon Gómez** (25)...Former Brooklyn stars featured are: IF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 4), RHP **Mike Vasil** (9), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (16), and OF **Matt Rudick** (27)...Williams (No. 84), Mauricio (93), and Parada (96) are recognized in the Top 100.

**OUT IN FRONT:** SS **Jett Williams** started the home first inning for the Cyclones with a solo home run off RHP **Trace Bright** — the first of his Brooklyn career — in last Wednesday's win vs. Aberdeen...The 19-year-old's blast marked the 2nd leadoff home run for the Cyclones in 2023...LF **Alex Ramirez** was the first to accomplish the feat, smacking a solo home run to left-center field off RHP **Johan Domínguez** on May 24 vs. Winston-Salem...Both leadoff home runs came in Wednesday afternoon games on Coney Island...OF **Ross Adolph** and INF **Rylan Sandoval** are tied for the franchise record in leadoff home runs with 3 in 2018 and 2010, respectively.

**BIG APPLE ELI:** LHP **Eli Ankeney** tossed another scoreless frame on Sunday afternoon vs. Aberdeen...Between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie, the 22-year-old has accrued a 1.38 ERA (5 ER in 32.2 IP) in 22 appearances (1 start)...Among Minor League pitchers with 30.0-plus innings pitched and 1-or-fewer starts, Ankeney is 10th in ERA (1.38)...Ankeney is also tied for 3rd in the fewest hits allowed (15)...Since making his Brooklyn debut on June 3 at Jersey Shore, the Phoenix, Ariz. native is 4th among South Atlantic League relievers with 20.0-plus IP in ERA (1.90), tied for 4th in fewest hits allowed (13), and 6th in batting average against (16.5).

**DE RECORD SETTER:** OF **Omar De Los Santos** entered as a pinch-runner and stole second base on July 21 at Hudson Valley, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 35 swipes breaks INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 4th in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 105 stolen bases in that span, which is 7th most in MILB...Only Mariners farmhand OF **Jonatan Clase** (116), Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (114), D'Backs prospect OF **Wilderd Patiño** (114), Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (114), Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (111), and Cardinals prospect OF **Mike Antico** (107) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 57 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 48.

**VICIOUS VENTURA:** Ventura set new career highs in innings pitched (7.1) and strikeouts (9), earning the win and tossing a quality start in August 2's win at Jersey Shore...He then set a new career-high with 10 strikeouts in his next start on August 9 vs. Aberdeen, allowing 1 run and 1 hit over 6.2 innings...Ventura tossed a career and team-season-high 101 pitches and 66 strikes...The 101 pitches were the most thrown by a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP **Briam Campusano** tossed 103 pitches (57 strikes) over 5.2 innings in a 5-2 loss at West Virginia on July 28, 2018... **AIR JORDANY:** Ventura joined Brooklyn from Single-A St. Lucie on July 14...In 15 appearances (13 starts) in the Florida State League, the 23-year-old registered a 4-3 record with a 5.67 ERA (34 ER in 54.0 IP)...Issued 50 walks and struck out 60...Has struggled in a starting role in 2023...In 13 starts, holds a 3-3 mark with a 6.70 ERA (33 ER in 44.1 IP)...Is 1-0 with a 0.93 ERA (1 ER in 9.2 IP) in a pair of relief outings...Tossed his first career complete game in a 5-inning loss at Palm Beach on June 16...Yielded 1 run on 3 hits over 4.0 innings.

**TOP PROSPECT:** Ventura is ranked as the Mets' No. 29 prospect by *Baseball America*...The right-hander was deemed the organization's No. 19 farmhand entering 2022 and No. 20 before 2021 by *Baseball America*.

**ON THE MEND:** Ventura is in the midst of his first full professional season since 2019...The Dominican native missed the entire 2021 season and most of 2022 while recovering from Tommy John surgery.

**2022:** Started the campaign on St. Lucie's 60-day injured list...Joined the Florida Complex League Mets on a rehab assignment on June 5...Tossed a pair of perfect innings on June 6 vs. the FCL Astros Orange, striking out 3...Reinstated from the IL on June 12...Made 3 starts in the Florida State League...Did not receive a decision and posted a 5.40 ERA (4 ER in 6.2 IP) with 2 walks and 10 strikeouts...Placed on the 7-day injured list for the remainder of the season on June 29.
