**Down the RubberDucks:** The Somerset Patriots take on the Akron RubberDucks for the first time this season. Last night, the Patriots scored six of their seven runs on three home runs. Somerset has taken two of the first three against Akron.

**Playoff Picture:** The Double-A Northeast League will feature a two-team playoffs this season with one best-of-five Championship Series played between the two teams with the best overall records regardless of division. The Patriots currently find themselves 0.5 games behind the Bowie Baysox for the second playoff spot and 2.0 games behind the Akron RubberDucks for the best overall record in the league. The Portland Sea Dogs are also in the conversation, currently 1.5 game behind Somerset and 2.0 games behind the Baysox for the final playoff spot. 15 of the Patriots' final 21 games of the season are against Akron and Bowie.

**Breaux**, Chill: C Josh Breaux is 6-for-12 (.500) this week against the RubberDucks including two doubles and a pair of home runs. He has now hit safely in six-straight games, over which he is batting .400 (10-for-26) with two home runs, five RBI and six runs. Breaux now has 21 home runs on the year between High-A and Double-A. He currently ranks second in home runs in the Yankees minor league system, trailing only his teammate Dermis Garcia (25).

**Dermis Dingers:** INF Dermis Garcia hit his team-leading 25th home run of the season last night. Garcia owns the most homers among Yankees farmhands this season and lists eighth among all minor leaguers. The righty also continued a five-game hit streak with a pair of hits last night. Over the streak, Garcia is 7-for-21 (.333) with a homer and four RBI. He is also batting .276 in August with a .349 OBP, raising his overall average on the year from .179 to .203.

**Post Milone:** Thomas Milone extended his on-base streak to a team-high 38 games with a base hit Wednesday night. Milone's streak dates back to May 11th and spans three tours in Somerset sandwhiched around two separate stops with Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. He has now reached base safely in 42 of the 43 games in which he's played with Somerset.

**Medina Magic:** RHP Luis Medina struck out a career-high 12 batters last night. Medina retired the first eight batters he faced, striking out five of them, and finished with a no-decision after tossing 5.1 innings of two-run, two-hit baseball. Medina finished a streak of 13.1 consecutive innings without a walk when he walked Victor Nova in the third. The streak began after he lasted just two innings and walked five on August 6 vs. the Bowie Baysox.

**Arms Race:** Somerset's pitching staff owns the lowest ERA (3.36), BAA (.211), and most shutout wins (15) across all MiLB levels. Additionally, the team boasts the second-lowest WHIP (1.16) and ranks fifth in strikeouts (1,075). The Patriots pitching staff is just six strikeouts away from a franchise record for a single season. The current high (1,080) was set in 2016.

**Battering Bastidas:** INF Jesus Bastidas snapped a 15-game on-base streak last night. Bastidas reached base safely in all 15 games to start his time at the Double-A level since his promotion on 7/18 and hit safely in 12 of those 15 games. He currently owns a .283 batting average with a .415 OBP in Double-A, including a .424 OBP over eight games in August.
