BLEDAY HOMERS, BUT JUMBO SHRIMP LOSE 12-5

JJ Bleday homered on Thursday, but Jacksonville fell 12-5 to Charlotte. For the second straight day, the Knights had a big second inning, scoring four runs before adding three more in the third. Bleday hit a two-run shot in the fifth. Erik González added an RBI double later in the inning to cut the deficit to 7-3. However, Charlotte scored one in the fifth and two in both the sixth and seventh frames for a 12-3 advantage. The Jumbo Shrimp added runs on a Willians Astudillo RBI double in the eighth and Demetrius Sims RBI single in the ninth to get it to 12-5.

NINE STEPS FORWARD, TWO STEPS BACK

From April 15-26, the Jumbo Shrimp won nine of 10 games behind both great offense and pitching. The club hit .301/.388/.509/.897 as a team with a 2.35 ERA that placed third out of 120 Minor League Baseball teams during this stretch. Thus, Jacksonville posted some dominating results, outscroing their opponents during this stretch by a whopping 73-30 margin and compiling a 106-65 advantage in hits and 17-3 margin in home runs. However, over the last two days, the club has come back down to Earth in two lopsided defeats to Charlotte. The Knights have outscored the Jumbo Shrimp 22-6 with a 32-14 advantage in hits and 4-2 homer margin.

CHARLES LE MAGNIFIQUE

Charles Leblanc went 0-for-3 with a walk and run scored on Thursday, continuing a fantastic start to 2022. The Laval, Quebic City native has already reached base multiple times in nine of his 18 games this year. On the season, Leblanc ranks ninth in the International League in OPS (1.006), 10th in batting average (.339), 11th in on-base percentage (.425), 14th in slugging percentage (.581) and tied for 17th in hits (21). Among the 137 qualified hitters in the circuit, Leblanc also places ninth in both wOBA (.438) and wRC+ (167).

SIX & DIP

Heading into play on Friday, Jacksonville has scored at least six runs in eight of their last 13 games, and 10 of the club's 21 contests this year. In 2021, the Jumbo Shrimn mustered at least six tallied in only 48 of their 130 games (36.9 percent). When scoring at least six runs this year, Jacksonville is 8-2.

MEN OF STEAL

Heading into play on April 17, Jacksonville had stolen just four bases, tied for the third-fewest in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp swiped five bases in Durham that night, matching the franchise's most in any game since the Jacksonville Suns swiped six bases on April 10, 2016 against Birmingham. In the 10 games from April 17 on, the Jumbo Shrimp have collected 15 stolen bases, tied for the fifth-most in Triple-A. Jacksonville has been caught only three times during this stretch, a success rate of 83.3 percent.

THIS CUBAN IS CRUSHING MISSILES

Over his last eight games, Lorenzo Quintana has gone 14-for-34 at the plate, slashing .412/.474/.882/1.356 with four doubles, four home runs, 13 RBIs and nine runs scored. This hot stretch has pushed Quintana up the International League leaderboards on the season; the native of Pinar del Rio in Cuba ranks in the top 15 of the league in batting average (5th; .344), slugging (5th; .656), OPS (6th; 1.042), home runs (T-6th; 5), RBIs (T-6th; 17), hits (T-12th; 22) and extra-base hits (T-13th; 10). Of the 137 qualified hitters in the International League, Quintana has posted the sixthlowest strikeout rate (12.9 percent) behind the 39th-lowest swinging-strike rate (9.6 percent). He places seventh in both wOBA (.445) and wRC+ (172).

THE CHICKS DIG IT

Jacksonville has popped 29 home runs thus far in 2022, ranking fourth in the International League. The home run power the Jumbo Shrimp have shown has been a rarity for teams on the First Coast in recent years; no Jacksonville team has finished outside the bottom 10 in either Triple-A (2021) or Double-A (2014-19) in home runs since 2013, when the Jacksonville Suns bashed 104 bombs to place 14th in Double-A. In fact, the last time a Jacksonville club ranked in the top 10 of its level in long balls was 2009, when the Suns cracked 110 homers. Heading into play on Friday, the Jumbo Shrimp have homered in six consecutive games, their best such streak of the young season.

SHRIMP SPECK

Erik González leads the IL in batting average (.375) while ranking second in hits (27), tied for eighth in doubles (8) and 21st in on-base percentage (.403).

ABOUT DANIEL

-Castano was included by the St. Louis Cardinals along with right-handers Sandy Alcantara, and Zac Gallen and outfielder Magneuris Sierra on December 14, 2017 in a trade with the Miami Marlins for outfielder Marcell Ozuna.

-A product of Lake Travis High School, one of Castano's teammates in high school was Baker Mayfield, formerly the quarterback of the Cleveland Browns. Castano threw a no-hitter in the District 4A playoff series against Crockett in 2013.

-Castano starred at Baylor University, earning All-Big 12 Honorable Mention in 2015, as well as a spot on the 2014 Big 12 All-Freshman Team. That 2015 season saw Castano post a 3.48 ERA, the 25th-lowest in school history. He tied for first on the team in strikeouts (45) and wins (four), while finishing second in innings pitched (77.1).

2022 SEASON

-Castano began the season with Miami but was optioned to Jacksonville on April 28.

2021 SEASON

-In his final start of 2021, Castano no-hit Gwinnett for 7.0 innings before yielding a leadoff single to Chadwick Tromp in the eighth. He ultimately ceded two hits in 8.0 shutout frames.

-Castano made four starts with the Marlins before being optioned on May θ to Jacksonville.

-Castano was placed on the 10-day injured list on June 8 with a left shoulder impingement, one day after being recalled from Jacksonville to Miami. The lefty was later transferred to the 60-day IL on July 9. He was optioned again to Jacksonville on August 9 following the conclusion of his rehab assignment with the Jumbo Shrimp.

2020 SEASON

-Castano made his major league debut for the Marlins on August 8, 2020 at the New York Mets' Citi Field in Queens.

-After posting a 4.11 ERA in his first four starts (15.1 IP, 16 H, 8 BB, 8 K), Castano went 1-0 with a 1.88 ERA over his final three outings, including two starts (14.1 IP, 14 H, 3 BB, 4 K).

2019 SEASON

-Castano began the season with High-A Jupiter before earning a promotion on May $28\,\mathrm{to}$ Jacksonville.

-The left-hander worked a minimum of 6.0 innings in each of his six starts from July 15 through August 16. During that span, Castano went 5-0 with a 1.73 ERA in 41.2 innings. He whiffed 40 against three walks and 26 hits against.

-Castano matched Jacksonville's Marlins era record (2009-present) by whiffing a careerhigh 13 batters in a career-best 9.0 innings on August 8 against Mississippi. The outing marked Jacksonville's first nine-inning complete game since Justin Nicolino's gem on July 29, 2014 at Montgomery.
