YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels homered four times and beat the RubberDucks, 11-4. Richmond opened the scoring in the first with an RBI double by Marco Luciano and a two-run homer by Carter Aldrete to take a 3-0 lead. Wade Meckler drove in a run with his first Double-A hit in the second and a run scored on a wild pitch to extend the lead to 5-0. Akron brought in a run with a single by Jose Tena in the third and closed the gap to 5-3 with fourth-inning RBIs by Korey Holland and Petey Haplin. In the bottom of the fourth, Carter Williams hit a solo homer and Luciano added a three-run homer to open a 9-3 lead. Aaron Bracho hit a solo home run in the sixth to bring the score to 9-4. Ismael Munguia hit the Flying Squirrels' fourth homer of the night in the sixth, a solo shot, and Robert Emery added a sac fly in the eighth to cap the scoring.

TDDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. This series is the first set between these two teams this year. They will play 18 total games against each other this season. Richmond will travel to Akron for a six-game series from July 18-23. The RubberDucks return to The Diamond for the Flying Squirrels' final regular-season homestand from September 5-10.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are 2-6 in their last eight games but have won two-of-their-last three after a season-long five-game losing streak to open last week's series in Erie. Richmond has been in first place in the division all but four days this season. The Flying Squirrels have dropped seven-of-their-last-nine games dating back to the last homestand against Altoona. The Richmond pitching staff is leading the Eastern League in ERA (3.34).

THE RUBBERDUCKS have won six-of-their-last-nine games, including taking four-of-six in last week's series in Altoona. Akron's pitching staff is ranked fourth in the Eastern League in ERA (3.76) and tied for first in saves (12). The RubberDucks have the third-lowest team batting average (.215) in the EL. Akron's roster includes eight of Baseball America's top-30 Cleveland prospects, including SS Angel Martinez (No. 8), INF Jose Tena (No. 14), LHP Joey Cantillo (No. 18), INF Gabriel Rodriguez (No. 21), OF Petey Halpin (No. 25), LHP Doug Nikhazy (No. 27), RHP Tanner Burns (No. 29) and C Bryan Lavastida (No. 30). There are seven Akron players on MLB.com's top-30 Cleveland prospects list, including Martinez (No. 9), Halpin (No. 15), Cantillo (No. 17), Burns (No. 20), Tena (No. 21), Nikhazy (No. 28) and Jack Leftwich (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Ryan Murphy makes his sixth start of the season and eighth-overall appearance. He faced the SeaWolves in his last start last Friday night and allowed four runs, three in the first inning, in his 3.1 innings in a loss. Last year, Murphy began the season with High-A Eugene and went 1-0 with a 2.90 ERA in seven starts. He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in later-June and made two starts before being placed on the injured list for most of the rest of the season. Murphy was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Le Moyne College near Syracuse, NY, and was the highest-drafted Division II player that year. Murphy is currently rated by Baseball America as the No. 20 Giants prospect and No. 27 by MLB. com. For more on Murphy, see page two.

FÜR AKRON: Left-hander Doug Nikhazy makes his fifth start and seventh appearance of the year. His last start was last Thursday at Altoona, when he went four innings and allowed one run with five strikeouts. It was his second straight start working four innings and allowing one run. Nikhazy was selected by Cleveland in the second round (58th overall) in 2021 out of Ole Miss. In college, he set the Rebels' freshman record with 86 strikeouts in 2019 and ranked fifth in NCAA Division I with 142 strikeouts in 2021. He began his first professional season last year with High-A Lake County and went 4-4 with a 3.19 ERA in 21 starts. He joined Double-A Akron for his final six outings of the year, going 0-2 with an 11.57 ERA. Nikhazy is rated by Baseball America as the No. 27 Guardians prospect and No. 28 by MLB.com.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels' sold out crowd of 9,810 fans on Wednesday was the largest crowd in the Eastern League this year. It was the first sellout of the 2023 season (Opening Day was sold out but rained out) and the fourth crowd of at least 8,000 at The Diamond this year. For the season, the Flying Squirrels lead all 30 Double-A teams in average attendance (6.477). Last year, they led Double-A in average (6,160) and total (406,560) fans for the first time in franchise history.

LUCY, I'M HOME: Shortstop Marco Luciano was activated with the Flying Squirrels on May 2 and made his official Double-A debut on May 3. He joined the Richmond roster for last year's Eastern League playoffs, going 1-for-8 at the plate in the Division Series against Erie in September. Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the Giants' No. 1 prospect and the No. 30 prospect in baseball. MLB.com has him rated as the Giants' No. 2 prospect and No. 20 overall. Baseball America also rates Luciano as the Giants' top power-hitting prospect. On May 4, Luciano drove a 394-foot solo homer for his first Double-A hit. Luciano added a homer in Sunday's win over the SeaWolves and hit his third home run on Wednesday, tying a career high with four RBIs. He has reached base in eight-of-his-11 games started this season.

FULL MUNGUIA: Ismael Munguia is batting .355 (22-for-62) with two homers, eight doubles and six RBIs over his last 16 games, including eight multi-hit games, since April 27. He kicked off the stretch on April 27 in Bowie with a homer on the third pitch of the game, his second Double-A home run. He went deep for the third time on Wednesday night, part of his third three-hit game of the year. Munguia tied for fifth in the Eastern League in hits (37), ranks 10th in total bases (54) and tied for seventh in runs scored (22). His .291 batting average out of the leadoff spot in the order is the second-highest in the league, trailing only Hartford's Bladimir Restituyo (.308).

VAUN RETURNS: Outfielder **Vaun Brown** was reinstated from the injured list with the Flying Squirrels on Tuesday. After missing the start of the season with an injury, he joined Low-A San Jose on a rehab assignment in late-April and played five games before joining High-A Eugene for five games. In the nine games on his rehab assignment, Brown hit .351 (13-for-37). Last year, Brown played his first full professional season and led all full-season minor leaguers in batting average (.346) and OPS (1.060). He also ranked third in the minors in SLG (.623) and sixth in OBP (.437). Brown joined the Flying Squirrels last August and made his Double-A debut in Akron, but left that game in the fifth inning with an injury and did not play again for the year. Brown is rated by Baseball America as the No. 6 Giants prospect and No. 5 by MLB.com. Baseball America also lists Brown as the Giants' best athlete and best hitter for average.

WELCOME, WADE: The Flying Squirrels activated Wade Meckler on Wednesday and he made his Double-A debut that night, picking up three hits and scoring two runs. He knocked an RBI single in the second inning for his first Double-A hit. At the time of his promotion from High-A Eugene, Meckler ranked fourth in the Northwest League in hits (36). He is rated by Baseball America as having the "best strike-zone discipline" in the Giants system. Among batters with at least 80 plate appearances this year, Meckler leads the minors in batting average (.464). He also ranks third in the minors (min. 80 PA) in BABIP (.507), seventh in OBP (.500) and fifth in wRC+ (203). Meckler was selected by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Oregon State. He played 23 games last year after the draft, including 11 games to close the season with Low-A San Jose, where he hit .439 in 11 games.

BURGDS THE KING: Reliever Raymond Burgos has pitched 11 games without allowing an earned run this season, the longest streak in the Eastern League this year. The only run Burgos has allowed overall this season was a extra-innings placed runner in a loss to the Curve on May 3. Among Eastern League relievers (min. 8 G, no starts), Burgos ranks first in runners left on base (95.0%). He is one of only four pitchers in the minors this year who has pitched at least 15.0 innings and has not allowed an earned run.

STRUNG ARMS: The Flying Squirrels' pitching staff has posted a 3.34 ERA this year, which leads the Eastern League and is the second-best in Double-A behind Tulsa (2.83) and fourth-best among all 120 minor league teams. Richmond's 2.41 bullpen ERA is the lowest in the minors this year. The Flying Squirrels are 10-for-13 (76.9 percent) in save opportunities this year, which is the second-best save conversion percentage in Double-A behind Amarillo's 77.8 percent (7-for-9).

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Luis Matos is ranked sixth in batting average (.304), tied for ninth in OBP (.398) and tied for seventh in hits (35). Hayden Cantrelle is sixth in OBP (.420). Ismael Munguia is tied for fifth in hits (37), is 10th in total bases (54) and tied for seventh in runs scored (22). Tyler Fitzgerald is tied for first in triples (3). Kai-Wei Teng is third in strikeouts (42), fourth in BAA (.186) and third in WHIP (1.05).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1, No. 30 overall), Vaun Brown (No. 6), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Nick Swiney (No. 24) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the organization's best power hitter. Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. Brown is rated as the best hitter for average and the best athlete. Wade Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Brown (No. 5), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
