#### NOTES

LAST TIME DUT: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies used a balanced offensive attack to defeat the Portland Sea Dogs, 8-4, on Wednesday at Hadlock Field. All nine batters recorded at least one hit and seven players scored at least one run for Binghamton. Kevin Parada went 2-for-4 with three runs batted in, and a two-run home run (11). Jett Williams recorded his third-straight multi-hit game, and he has six hits over that span. Jaylen Palmer recorded a multi-hit game and hit an RBI single. Ryan Clifford hit an RBI single and walked. Jonah Tong allowed three runs with five strikeouts over 3.1 innings. Justin Lawson earned his first Double-A win in his debut with three strikeouts over 1.2 hitless and scoreless frames.

JETT IS SDARIN', FLYIN': Mets No. 2 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 53 overall prospect Jett Williams recorded his third-straight multi-hit game on Wednesday at Hadlock Field, as he went 2-for-4 with an RBI, a run, and a double. Over his last three games, the 20-year-old is hitting .462 (6-for-13) with one double, one RBI, two runs, and just two strikeouts. Williams' three multi-hit games come after he went 2-for-23 (.087 AVG) with 14 strikeouts and no walks over his first five games after being activated from the 60-day injured list on August 30. Williams played in 11 games with Binghamton in April. He underwent wrist surgery on June 6 and missed a total of 109 Double-A games this year. The former first-round pick in 2022 has played in 25 regular season games at the Double-A level across the last two seasons.

**CLIFFORD THE BING RED DDG:** Mets No. 4 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 77 overall prospect **Ryan Clifford** hit an RBI single in the first inning on Wednesday at Portland, and later drew a walk. Clifford crushed a go-ahead two-run home run in the eighth inning against Portland on Tuesday. He is now tied for the third-most home runs (17) in the Eastern League. He has 16 home runs since the start of June and two homers over his last four games. He also ranks third in Minor League Baseball with 91 walks, across High-A Brooklyn (32) and Double-A Binghamton (59). Clifford has reached base safely in 21 of his last 24 games since August 15 and is slashing .271/.380/.435/.815 with four home runs, two doubles, 12 RBIs, eight runs scored, and 14 walks in that span. The 21-year-old ranks among the Eastern League in HR (T-3rd most), BB (T-8th), OPS (9th), SLG (11th), and OBP (11th).

**MR. SEPTEMBER: Jaylen Palmer** hit two singles and drove in a run on Wednesday at Portland, which extended his on-base streak to 11 games. In nine games since the calendar flipped to September, Palmer his slashing .355/.412/.677/1.089 with two home runs, a walk-off HR, four doubles, seven RBIs, two runs, and three walks. Over his last 26 games since August 6, Palmer is hitting .286 with an .893 OPS, 26 hits, five home runs, nine doubles, 15 runs batted in, and 12 runs scored. Palmer is finishing 2024 strong, after he took off to finish the 2023 season. He hit six home runs with 17 RBIs and held a .974 OPS in 21 games for Triple-A Syracuse to finish the 2023 season.

HOME RUN RACE: With four games left to play, Zach Kokoska (HFD) currently leads the Eastern League with 19 home runs. Jeremiah Jackson (18) is tied for second in the EL with Jud Fabian (BOW) and Chris Meyers (ERI). Ryan Clifford (17) is tied for third in the EL with Gage Workman (ERI).



-Reid Brignac (pronounced Brin-yac) is coming off leading the Rumble Ponies to the postseason last season, for the first time since 2017. In 2023, under Brignac's tutelage, the Ponies went on a second-half surge, going 39-27 overall and 17-5 over their last 22 games. Brignac's team swept the Somerset Patriots in the Eastern League Division Series to lead the Ponies to the ELCS before falling to Erie.

He was initially drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft, out of St. Amant High School.

Sager's pitching staff in 2023 set a Binghamton franchise record with 15 shutouts and took home five Eastern League honors, highlighted by Mike Vasil winning Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for May and Dom Hamel being named EL Pitcher of the Month for September. Sager's staff also ranked first among the 30 Double-A clubs in strike rate and walks issued, and second in opponent on-base percentage. On September 7 at Hartford, right-hander Joander Suarez threw the eighth no-hitter in franchise history, facing the minimum 21 batters over seven innings.

-Sager previously spent 20 years coaching in the Detroit Tigers organization and pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five saves and a 5.36 ERA. Sager was originally drafted by the Padres in the 10th round of the 1988 MLB Draft, out of the University of Toledo.


