INDY BITS

ABOUT SUNDAY NIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians were limited to just three hits and shut out for the second consecutive night by the Nashville Sounds on Sunday evening in the series finale at First Horizon Park, 3-0. Scoreless through the front third of the game, the Sounds jumped in front in the bottom of the fourth against Indians starter Aaron Shortridge with an RBI double to left-center field from Owen Miller. An inning later, Freddy Zamora singled home Chris Roller to push it to 2-0 before former Indian Vinny Capra brought Carlos Rodriguez in with an RBI single to tie a bow on the Sounds' scoring. The Indians were silenced for the second night in a row by Sounds pitching, spearheaded by starter Mitch White (W, 3-3) who worked 5.0 innings and allowed just two hits while striking out seven. Fishers native and former Indiana University pitcher Craig Yoho struck out the side in order, and No. 2 Brewers prospect Jacob Misiorowski set down all five Indians batters he faced in his first appearance out of the bullpen in his professional career. To finish the job, Nashville closer Kevin Herget recorded four outs, three of which via strikeout.

SILENCED BY THE SOUNDS: For the second consecutive night on Sunday, the Indians were shut out by the Sounds, 3-0. It was the sixth time they have been shut out this season, five of which have come on the road. The Indians were previously shut out by Nashville once since the Sounds joined the International League in 2021, the last shutout coming exactly one year prior on Aug. 10, 2023, at Victory Field. The pair of shutouts came after the Indians threw their fourth shutout of the season behind Bubba Chandler's 7.0 shutout innings on Friday. The Indians were last shut out in consecutive games from July 6-7, 2021, at Columbus.

NICK KNACKS: Nick Yorke went 1-for-3 on Sunday night to extend his hitting streak to 15 games and on-base streak to 19 games since June 19. During his 15-gamer between Triple-A Worcester and Indianapolis since July 25, which ranks as the longest active hitting streak in the International League, he is hitting .346 (18-for-52) with six doubles and eight RBI. Since the beginning of June, York ranks sixth in the International League in batting average (.322), tied for seventh in runs (37) and ninth in OBP (.410). He is currently rated as Pittsburgh's No. 5 prospect by MLB Pipeline after being traded to Pittsburgh from Boston on July 29 in exchange for RHP Quinn Priester, and has 14 hits, four extra-base hits and six RBI in 11 games with Indy since.

COOKING WITH GAS: Billy Cook, who was traded to Pittsburgh from Baltimore in exchange for RHP Patrick Reilly on July 30, is tied for the International League lead in doubles (five) and extra-base hits (six) and is tied for third in stolen bases (four) since making his organization debut with the Indians on Aug. 3. In eight games with the Indians he is hitting .360 (9-for-25) with a .452 on-base percentage and 1.132 OPS. Cook has now reached base safely in 10 of 12 games since July 26 (1) with Triple-A Norfolk with a .461 batting average (18-for-39), nine runs, eight doubles, one triple, two home runs and eight RBI between both teams. That stretch featured a stretch of two extra-base hits in four consecutive games, the longest such streak in the International League since at least 2015.

BILLY ON BASE: Billy McKinney extended his on-base streak to 12 games with a walk on Sunday night. Since May 9 when his streak began, he is hitting .350 (14-for-40) with an .872 OPS. Sunday night's contest broke up a six-game hitting streak, and in his last seven he is hitting .318 (7-for-22) with a home run and two RBI. Since returning from the injured list on July 24, he is hitting .323 (10-for-31) with a .417 on-base percentage and .836 OPS in nine games, including a season-high three-hit performance in his first game back at Iowa.

IL PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Minor League Baseball and the Indianapolis Indians yesterday announced that the Pittsburgh Pirates No. 1 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, right-handed pitcher Bubba Chandler, has been named the International League Pitcher of the Week after tossing 7.0 shutout innings in his Triple-A debut on Aug. 9. Chandler, 21, was promoted from Double-A Altoona to Indianapolis on Aug. 8 and made his Triple-A debut the next day at First Horizon Park against the Nashville Sounds. He took a no-hitter into the sixth inning and earned the win after allowing just two base knocks with one walk and six strikeouts. Currently rated by MLB Pipeline as the No. 48 prospect in MiLB, Chandler has the lowest WHIP (0.62) and second-lowest batting average against (.140) among all full-season MiLB qualifiers since June 21. In 19 games with Altoona (16 starts), he went 6-7 with a 3.70 ERA (33er/80.1ip), 94 strikeouts, 1.01 WHIP and .192 batting average against (55-for-287).

TONIGHT: The Indians will look to rebound from a series loss last week at Nashville with a six-game series against the St. Paul Saints, Triple-A affiliate of the Minnesota Twins. The Saints visited Victory Field from April 16-21, with the Indians taking five of six games. The two teams have one more series scheduled in the 2024 season, with Indianapolis heading to the Twin Cities for the final six games of the campaign from Sept. 17-22. Kicking off the stretch for Indianapolis tonight is RHP Luis Cessa (4-4, 4.11), who earned his second win of the season with Omaha on May 15 when he tossed 5.0 shutout innings with five strikeouts at CHS Field. Countering for the Saints tonight is RHP Andrew Morris in his Triple-A debut.

LUIS ON A ROLL: Luis Cessa made his ninth appearance (eighth start) with the Indians last Wednesday and took a no-decision as he tossed 5.0 shutout innings and exited with two runners on to begin the sixth. He was charged with two runs (one earned) with four walks and five strikeouts through the outing. Cessa has now tossed at least 5.0 innings in each of his last four starts with a 2.86 ERA (7er/22.0ip) and 18 strikeouts since July 21. He was one inning shy of his second consecutive quality start after allowing three runs (two earned) over 6.0 innings on Aug. 1 vs. Toledo.

THIS DATE IN 1964: Dave DeBusschere, who was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in 1983, hit a second-inning grand slam off Fergie Jenkins to lift the Indians to a 7-2 win over Arkansas at old Victory Field. Jenkins was inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in 1991. DeBusschere earned his 12th win of the season after throwing 6.0 innings and yielding only two runs with five strikeouts. Marv Staehle, Ramon Conde and Jim Koranda registered multi-hit performances in the victory.
