CASTILLO ON THE BUMP: Carlos Castillo will take the ball in the rubber match with Fort Myers tonight. Last Friday vs Dunedin, Castillo allowed two unearned runs over five innings with five strikeouts. Overall, Castillo has made 18 apperances and 15 starts for Bradenton this season, and has pitched to a 4.17 ERA over a careerhigh 69 innings. Castillo generally keeps the ball on the ground as he has pitched to a 46.4 percent groundball rate this season. He mixes in a sinker (91.9 mph), slider (83.5 mph), changeup (86.7) and curveball (80.6 mph). For Castillo, four of his five hardest pitches of the year came during his last start. Moreover, 12 of his 13 hardest pitches this year have been thrown since the beginning of June (topped out at 95.2 on 6/1). During his last outing versus Dunedin, he tossed a five innings allowing two unearned runs while punching out a season-high seven hitters.

TONY TATORS: Pirates No. 21 prospect (MLB Pipeline) Tony Blanco Jr. demolished his first Single-A homer last night in the bottom of the sixth inning last night after sending a fastball 415 feet to left field, that cleared the confines of LECOM Park. The ball left his bat at 118.9 miles per hour, marking the hardest-hit ball in Single-A this season, clearing the next closest batted ball by 4.4 mph. MARAUDERS MASHERS: The Bradenton Marauders return from the All-Star Break as one of the best home-run hitting teams in all of Class-A. Their 81 longballs this season are the most in the Florida State League and Class-A (80, San Jose - California League). 125 of their 451 total runs have been generated via the long ball (27.7%). They're 28-23 when leaving the yard at least once, and 17-28 when not homering at all. They're seen four players launch 9+ home runs this season, more than any other team in the FSL (A. Plaz, Y. De Los Santos, K. Griffin, J. Severino)

BURNING THE BASE PATHS: Yordany De Los Santos stole his 40th stolen base of the season on Friday, adding to a career-best mark (34 between FCL/Single-A in 2024). In the process, he passed Jesus Castillo (2023), for the most single-season stolen bases by a Marauder in franchise history. He ranks first in the Florida State League and seventh in Single-A. Moreover, he sits only behind Konnor Griffin (44) for the most swipes in the Pittsburgh Pirates system. They are the ninth and tenth 40+ stolen-base seasons in Pirates-MilB history. The two are approaching Rich Thompson for the most in a season by a Pirates minor leaguer when he stole 58 in 2005 between Double-A Altoona and Triple-A Indianapolis.

ELECTRIC EDWARD: Newly-named Pirates No. 6 prospect Edward Florentino (prev. Carlos Castillo will take the mound in the rubber match with Fort Myers tonight. Last Friday vs Dunedin, Castillo allowed two unearned runs over five innings with five strikeouts.
