TODAY'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Tacoma Rainiers (Seattle Mariners affiliate) gear up for the final contest of their six-game set on Sunday afternoon at Cheney Stadium. The Express were held to four hits in a 5-1 loss on Saturday night. After a scoreless first inning, the Rainiers grabbed an early 1-0 lead in the second on a solo home run from 1B Patrick Wisdom. Wisdom followed his solo home run in the second with a three-run shot in the third inning to grow the Tacoma lead to four. In the fifth, Wisdom hit his third homer of the game, giving Tacoma a 5-0 advantage. SS Keyber Rodriguez provided the first hit and run for the Express with a solo home run in the sixth, making it a 5-1 game. Round Rock tallied a hit in each of the final four innings but fell 5-1 on Saturday night.

WHERE WE STAND

Round Rock is seeking its 5th series win of the year...guaranteed a series split after their victory on Friday night...lost each of their last 2 series...have not won 3 consecutive G since 4/19-/23...4-6 in their last 10, 6-9 in their last 15 and 9-11 in their last 20 G...with 2 G remaining in the month, must win both to avoid club's lowest win percentage entering July...are 34-46 (.425) looking to pass franchise's worst from 2007 when they were 36-47 (.434).

NO HANDOUTS

After drawing 8 walks in Friday's win, the Express did not draw a single walk last night...Tacoma has held Round Rock without a walk twice this week after the E-Train had drawn at least 1 in 173 consecutive games dating back to 5/29/25... since 2023, Round Rock is 0-10 when held to 0 walks.

SEEING THE SLUG

The E-Train have homered in a season-long 9 consecutive games...previous high was 4 games (6/10-13)...in June, they are 2nd in the PCL in home runs (30) after entering the month last in the league in homers for the season (42)...1st time recording 30 homers in a month since August of 2025 (33)...are currently batting .274 and slugging .460 this month, their best in a month since June of 2025 (.289 AVG and .473 SLG).

MORE THAN A BACKSTOP

After entering June with the worst batting average (.168), slugging percentage (.249) and OPS (.543) among Triple-A catchers this season, Round Rock's catchers have slashed .281/.319/.438/.757 during the month of June.

NO K'S IN CASTILLO

INF Diego Castillo recorded 1 of Round Rock's 4 hits on Saturday night...has hit safely in 8 of his last 11 games...slashing .385/.457/.538 with just 2 strikeoutsout in that span...has gone 8 consecutive games and 34 plate appearances without striking out, the 2nd longest active streak in Triple-A (LV INF Joshua Kuroda-Grauer, 13 G).

CHENEY STADIUM FINISH

Express can collect their first series victory in Tacoma since September 19-24, 2023 when the E-Train clinched the second half title.

THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - SUNDAY, JUNE 28, 1992

Seventy-seven games into the season and 12 Nolan Ryan starts later, 45-year-old Nolan Ryan earned his first victory of the year as the Rangers beat the Tigers, 8-4 at Tiger Stadium. Ryan tossed 7.0 scoreless innings, allowing five hits and three walks while striking out seven over 116 pitches. Detroit right-hander Mark Leiter took the loss after allowing five earned runs on five hits and five walks with four strikeouts over 4.0 innings. "The best thing about this," Ryan told reporters after the game, "is that people will quit asking me about it. I know it's only natural people ask. But (the winless streak dating back to last Sept. 25) is a little misleading. It insinuates I haven't done the job, that I haven't pitched well. I know I can't get offended by it, but I'm also human." Texas took a 1-0 lead on Kevin Reimer's home run in the second inning. They built a 6-0 advantage with a five-run fifth. Brian Downing drilled a two-run homer, while Rafael Palmeiro, Ruben Sierra and Juan Gonzalez each drove in a run during the inning. The Tigers stormed back against the Texas bullpen as Cecil Fielder drove in three runs late, but the Rangers held on for the victory. "Anybody writing that it's all over is talking out of the side of his head. It's not a question of stuff. This was the same stuff he's shown. The same good stuff. It's a question of health and consistency," Rangers pitching coach Tom House said.

MANAGER KYLE MOORE

The 2026 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kyle Moore's first season with the E-Train. In 2025, Moore served as the bench coach for Triple-A Iowa of the Chicago Cubs organization. He previously served as the skipper in the Baltimore chain with Short-Season Aberdeen (2018), Low-A Delmarva (2019), High-A Aberdeen (2021) and Double-A Bowie (2022-23) - combining for a 321-286 (.529) record over five seasons. The 2019 Delmarva Shorebirds were named the 2019 MiLB Team of the Year, finishing with a 90-48 record, the most wins across all of MiLB that season.

A catcher in his playing days, Moore signed with the Orioles as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He played collegiately at University of Alabama after winning three high school state titles with Edgewood (Ala.) Academy. Moore transitioned to coaching in 2012 as a strength and conditioning coach with Delmarva.

PITCHING COACH DAVE BORKOWSKI

Former MLB pitcher Dave Borkowski (Boar-COW-ski) enters his fourth season on Round Rock's staff and 17th year in coaching. He will serve as the Express' pitching coach in 2026, reprising the role he held from 2023-24 after spending the 2025 campaign as the club's bullpen coach. Borkowski spent five seasons as a minor league instructor in the Los Angeles Dodgers' farm system.

His tenure also includes an 11-year stint as a minor league coach for the Houston Astros. Prior to joining the coaching ranks, Borkowski enjoyed a 15-year professional playing career that saw him post a 13-20 record and 5.87 ERA across seven MLB seasons with the Detroit Tigers (1999-2001), Baltimore Orioles (2004), and Houston (2006-08). He was originally selected by Detroit in the 11th round of the 1995 MLB Draft out of Sterling Heights (Mich.) High School.

BENCH COACH CHASE LAMBIN

Lambin enters his sixth year on the Express staff and will reprise his role as bench coach for the fifth straight year (beg. 2022). The 2026 campaign will mark Lambin's 12th in the Texas organization. He has previous stops as a hitting coach for High-A Down East (2019), Low-A Hickory (2018), Short-A Spokane (2017), and the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers (2016). He first joined the Rangers as a member of the Spokane coaching staff in 2015.

Lambin was selected by the New York Mets in the 34th round of the 2002 June draft out of the University of Louisiana at Lafayette and played in the Mets, Marlins, Nationals, Twins, and Royals organizations. He also has international experience, spending the 2009 season with Chiba Lotte in Japan. The versatile defender appeared at every position except catcher over the course of his career.

BULLPEN COACH JULIO VALDEZ

Valdez enters his seventh year in the organization and first as the Rangers' Triple-A pitching coach after serving in the same role with Double-A Frisco (2025), High-A Hickory (2024), Low-A Down East (2023), Rookie-level ACL Rangers (2022), and DSL Rangers (2020-21). During the canceled 2020 campaign, Valdez worked with pitchers at the Dominican Republic complex and Fall Developmental League in Arizona.

The Florida native played baseball at Alabama State University from 2012-16. He attended Lake Howell (Fla.) High School, where he posted a career 15-4 record and 2.20 ERA, and earned all-conference honors as a junior and senior. Valdez transitioned to an assistant coach role at Alabama State in 2017 before becoming Director of Pitching at the Texas Pitching Institute in El Paso, Texas. He spent two years at TPI before taking the same role at Baseball Rebellion in Durham, N.C., before joining the Rangers.

HITTING COACH MATT LAWSON

Former Rangers farmhand Matt Lawson returns for a fifth straight season as Round Rock's hitting coach. Lawson previously served as an assistant coach, hitting instructor, and recruiting coordinator at his alma mater, Missouri State University, from 2014-21. The Missouri native was selected by the Rangers in the 14th round of the 2007 MLB Draft and played seven professional seasons as an infielder in the Texas (2007-10), Seattle (2010), and Cleveland (2011-13) organizations. With Texas, he was named Short-A Spokane's team MVP as a rookie in 2007 and a league All-Star for High-A Bakersfield (2009) and Double-A Frisco (2010) before he was involved in the 2010 trade that brought Cliff Lee to the Rangers.

He holds a degree in psychology and a graduate degree in sports management.

DEVELOPMENT COACH KAWIKA EMSLEY-PAI

Emsley-Pai enters his sixth year in the Texas organization and returns to the Express as a development coach, this after beginning his Rangers tenure in the same role during the 2021 season. He has also served as Double-A Frisco's bench coach (2025) and was a development coach with Frisco (2023-24) and High-A Hickory (2022). He served as the Centralia (Wash.) College head coach and education advocate from 2019-21. Prior to his stint at Centralia, Emsley-Pai had a three-year stint as an education advocate at a maximum-security juvenile rehabilitation facility.

A former catcher in the minor leagues, Emsley-Pai spent six seasons with the Diamondbacks (2010) and Pirates (2011-15) organizations, topping out at Double-A Altoona in 2014. He was originally selected by Arizona in the 10th round of the 2010 June draft out of Lewis-Clark State College in Lewiston, Idaho after spending his freshman year at the University of Texas in 2008.

- Did not see official action in 2024 after undergoing 'Tommy John' ligament replacement surgery in June 2024. Returned to the mound on July 3, 2025 in the Arizona Complex League before appearing in 6 starts with Double-A Frisco before his promotion to Round Rock.... It was the first time he had seen official game action since March 9, 2024 during Cactus League play.
- Owned a 3.65 ERA (5 ER/12.1 IP) in three starts for Round Rock to end 2025.... Went a combined 9.1 IP in final two starts and allowed just 1 ER.
- In 2023, set career highs in wins, innings, strikeouts and games as he claimed the Nolan Ryan Pitcher of the Year award at season's end... paced all Texas minor leaguers (min. 100.0 IP) in strikeouts per 9.0 (10.53), while also ranking highly among organization pitchers in strikeouts (2nd) and wins (T-3rd).
- Originally acquired by Texas from the Seattle Mariners, along with a player to be named later (SS Andres Mesa), in exchange for RHP Rafael Montero on December 15, 2020. Corniell was traded before he ever threw a pitch in the Mariners organization.
- Originally signed by Seattle as an international free agent out of Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic on July 2, 2019. His signing bonus was the fifth-largest of the 2019-2020 international free agent class (\$630,000).
