### TULSA THUMPS FRISCO ON SATURDAY NIGHT:

The Frisco RoughRiders could not overcome an early four-run deficit to the Tulsa Drillers and lost 10-4 on Saturday at Riders Field. Tulsa (17-27, 58-55) put up four runs in the first inning with two hits and four walks. With the victory, Tulsa won the series over Frisco (23-21, 54-58) with one game remaining. **Jax Biggers** homered in the ninth inning, his ninth long ball of the year and a solo shot. Down 4-0 after the first inning, the Riders cut the margin in half in the second inning. **Aaron Zavala** started a two-out rally with a double, his first of two hits on the day. **Keyber Rodriguez**, **David Garcia** and **Chris Seise** all singled consecutively, the latter two for RBIs. Seise added a double later in the game. **Kellen Strahm** tripled in the sixth inning and scored on **Liam Hicks'** sacrifice fly. Hicks later walked to extend his streak of reaching base in all 30 home games this year. **Ryan Garcia** (3-9) lasted 0.2 innings in his start, charged with three earned runs and the loss. **Robby Ahlstrom** pitched the next 2.1 innings without a run and struck out the side in order in his final inning. **Danny Duffy** covered the next two innings without a run allowed. **Triston Polley** chipped in a scoreless ninth inning. Orlando Ortiz-Mayr (2-4) was the winning pitcher, dealing 5.1 innings for Tulsa with three earned runs.

### NEW MONTH, NEW ME:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the mound this season, but in the month of August, they have been fantastic. In the 17 games in August, (8-9 record) the RoughRiders lead the Texas League with a 3.83 ERA while allowing a league-low 13 home runs and .226 BAA. **Ryan Garcia** was brilliant on Tuesday in Coprus, allowing just two base runners on walks over six no-hit innings with six strikeouts. **Nick Krauth** then followed up with a second quality start, giving the RoughRiders their first back-to-back quality starts since May 31st and June 1st when **Owen White** and **Jack Leiter** completed the feat. On the offensive side in the month, Frisco is second-to-last in the Texas League with a .723 OPS and last in runs per game with 4.6 per contest.

### WINS AND LOSSES WITH RISP:

The RoughRiders won four in a row in Corpus Christi before losing their last six of their last seven entering Sunday's game. Over the four wins in a row, the Riders allowed just three runs on the pitching side (0.75 ERA) while scoring 4.8 runs per game and hitting .250 (8-for-32) with runners in scoring position. Over the last seven games, Frisco has allowed 49 runs (6.49 ERA) while scoring 4.3 runs per game and hitting .213 (17-for-80) with runners in scoring position.

### THE ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on the road this season. In the second half, Frisco is a league-best 12-9 on the road and they have the second-best road record overall in the Texas League at 30-27. Away from Riders Field, Frisco is averaging a league-best 5.8 runs per game and they have a league-high 107 doubles on the road as well. At home, the Riders are just 23-29 on the season, only trailing Wichita for the worst home record in the Texas League.

### HAUV YOURSELF A YEAR:

**Trevor Hauver** has been fantastic recently for the RoughRiders on the offensive side. On June 16th, he was hitting .218/.337/.368/.705, but in the 46 games since, he is batting .292/.409/.485/.894 with 13 doubles, six home runs, 29 RBIs and 35 walks. In those games, he has raised his average 37 points and his OPS 96 points.

### CARTER WALKS SO THE ROUGHRIDERS CAN RUN:

**Evan Carter** has been fantastic at drawing walks and getting on base this season. Carter's 70 walks are second in the Texas League despite only playing in 77 percent of the RoughRiders games this year. His 16.3 percent walk rate this year is fourth-highest in the league as well. He has walked 20 times in his last 19 games. His .410 OBP on the season is ninth in all of Double-A and among all 12 players in Double-A with a .400 OBP or better. Carter is the youngest at 20 years old.

### HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

**Liam Hicks** has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 28 games, Hicks is batting .323 (31-for-96)/.436/.438/.874 with six doubles, a triple, a home run, 14 RBIs, 18 walks and 14 runs scored. In his last 15 games, he is batting .340 (17-for-50) with a .912 OPS.

### K'S BY KELLY:

RoughRiders reliever **Antoine Kelly** has been incredible out of the Riders bullpen recently. He allowed an earned run for the first time on Thursday in his last 21.2 innings. During that stretch, he had 25 strikeouts to three walks while recording four saves. He has converted on all nine save opportunities this season. He was named Texas Rangers Minor League Reliever of the Month for July.

### ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks**, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

### ABOUT NICK

-Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior season, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games.

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current RoughRiders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 5-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five one-run innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on February 23rd.

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the Rangers as a free agent on June 15th.

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the RoughRiders touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MiLB experience.

### 2023 SEASON

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing three runs over four innings.

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among RoughRiders starting pitchers.

-Threw four scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-5.

-Allowed a run in the fourth inning against Amarillo on April 26th, snapping a 14.2-consecutive innings scoreless streak dating back to April 7th.

-Joined Triple-A Round Rock on May 2nd for a spot start and make two appearances. In his start, he went 3.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 1 K. Allowed a grand slam to David Freitas of Oklahoma City in relief appearance.

### 2022 SEASON

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0, 2.25 ERA out of the bullpen.

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads.

### 2021 SEASON

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts.

-Earned Low-A East Pitcher of the Week title, including once for a complete-game, one-hitter on August 28th vs. Fayetteville (9.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 9 K).
