Binghamton scored all three runs on a three-run homer from Rowdey Jordan in the fifth. Sammy Tavarez returned to the mound for the first time since May 31 with a scoreless inning and two strikeouts. Jordan reached base five times going 3-for-3 and was a triple shy of the cycle.

**Fryman is Heating Up:** Infielder **Branden Fryman** is riding a 10-game hitting streak. Over that span, he has 14 hits, four doubles, two triples, three runs batted in, and six runs. He has drawn two walks and has a stolen base over that span too. He hit two triples on Friday against Hartford and two doubles on Tuesday at Portland.

Jordan's Brand: Rowdey Jordan reached base five separate times in the series opener at Portland, going 3-for-3 with a three-run homer and was a triple shy of the cycle. It was Jordan's 13th multi-hit game and third three-hit game of the year. It was his 12th multi-RBI game and fourth three-RBI game of the season. Jordan has upped his average to .252, which is the second-best mark on the team. He leads the team in runs (37) and ranks top three on the team in doubles, homers, RBIs, walks, and stolen bases.

**Dominant Dom:** RHP **Dom Hamel** will make his 14th start and 15th appearance for Binghamton this season on Wednesday night at Portland. Hamel is coming off a start against Hartford in which he tied season highs with six innings pitched and nine strikeouts. Hamel has gone a season-high six innings in his past two starts and in three of his last four starts. In his last three starts that he went six frames, he totaled 18 innings and 25 strikeouts. Hamel went 3.1 scoreless frames with seven strikeouts at Portland in his first start of the season on April 7.


**The Bullpen:** The Rumble Ponies' bullpen was lights out in the series against Hartford. Over 18.1 innings of work, the Ponies' bullpen allowed just one earned run and has totaled 16 strikeouts. Daison Acosta made two appearances and tossed three perfect innings. Dedniel Núñez made two appearances and has allowed one hit over three scoreless frames with four strikeouts. Sammy Tavarez tossed a perfect frame with two Ks on Tuesday at Portland, in his first outing since May 31.

Last Start: Hamel tied his season high with six innings pitched and nine strikeouts on Thursday at home against Hartford. He allowed three runs on seven hits with no walks. It was the second-straight start where he tossed a season-high six innings. Hamel left the game with a one-run lead. Three out of his last four outings have been a season-high six frames.

World Baseball Classic: Hamel represented Team Puerto Rico in the 2023 World Baseball Classic. He honored his late mother, who passed away 11 days before the Mets selected him in the 2021 MLB Draft. He was WBC teammates with current New York Mets, Francisco Lindor and Edwin Díaz.

2022: Was named the 2022 New York Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Year. He led all Mets minor leaguers with 10 wins and 145 strikeouts. Began the season with St. Lucie (A) and pitched to a 5-2 record with a 3.84 ERA in 14 appearances and 13 starts. He tossed 63.1 innings and struck out 71 batters, before he was assigned to Brooklyn (A+) on July 4. He went 5-1 on the mound with a 2.59 ERA in 11 starts for the Cyclones. He struck out 74 hitters over 55.2 innings and opponents hit just .180 against him.

BACKGROUND: Ranks as the Mets' No. 2 pitching prospect and No. 6 overall Mets' prospect by MLB Pipeline. He was drafted out of Dallas Baptist University in the 3rd round (81st overall) by the Mets in 2021. Hamel went 13-2 on the mound and racked up 136 strikeouts in his final year at DBU in 2021. He spent his first two years at Yavapai College in Arizona.

#### Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo. He pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Detroit Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five career saves and a 5.36 ERA.

Darin Everson- Hitting Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 1st year in the Mets organization. Everson spent the previous five seasons as the Colorado Rockies Hitting Coordinator and 10 years in the Rockies organization. He previously was part of the Marlins organization for four years and served as an Associate Scout with the Baltimore Orioles from 2003-04. Everson played professionally as a catcher and first basemen for seven seasons with the Montreal Expos, Pittsburgh Pirates, and Boston Red Sox organizations.
