TODAY'S GAMES: Sugar Land continues their six-game series at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark against the Oklahoma City Dodgers. RHP Misael Tamarez is slated to start with RHP Ronel Blanco also scheduled to pitch.

ABOUT FRIDAY NIGHT: The Space Cowboys scored four in the top of the first including two on a double by Rylan Bannon... Sugar Land added two more in the top of the third, but a six-run fourth helped the Dodgers come back and top the Space Cowboys 7-6.

ROSTER MOVES: RHP Misael Tamarez activated from the Injured List... RHP Cesar Gomez transferred to Corpus Christi from Sugar Land. OF Marty Costes activated from the IL.

HOME GROWN TALENT: Sugar Land's roster has 10 players drafted by the Astros, 6 international signings and 1 player signed as non-drafted free agents in the five-round 2020 MLB Draft.

PROSPECTING: The Space Cowboys active roster boasts five of the Astros Top 30 Prospects according to MLB Pipeline. They include C Korey Lee (#5), OF Pedro León (#6), OF Justin Dirden (#7), INF Joe Perez (#14) & RHP Forrest Whitley (#19)

RECORD SETTING DAY IN ABQ: On 5/7 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys topped several franchise records in a 24-8 win over the Albuquerque Isotopes. They included:

- Most Hits in a Game: 30
- Most Extra-Base Hits: 14
- Total Bases: 60
- Most Individual Hits in a game: Korey Lee - 6

Sugar Land also tied the franchise record for runs scored in a game (24) and individual at bats, with three different players recording 7 trips to the plate.... This came just three days after Sugar Land had set new single-game records for doubles in a game (9), extra-base hits (13) & at bats (50) in a game on Thursday, 5/4.

LEAVE 'EM ON: Over their six games against El Paso, Sugar Land pitching stranded 59 Chihuahuas' base runners and held El Paso to just 9 hits with runners in scoring position, with El Paso going 9-for-62 (.145) with RISP. In the first four games against OKC, the Dodgers have gone 8-for-51 (.157) with runners in scoring position and stranded 32 runners.

BEGINNING WITH A BANG: Bligh Madris hit a lead-off home run on the very first pitch of Thursday night's game, his fifth overall homer of the season... It was the third lead-off home run this year by Madris, who has hit in the lead-off spot just 13 total times for the Space Cowboys. His lead-off home runs have twice come on the first pitch with the other coming on the second pitch of the game. Madris has accounted for three of the four lead-off homers for the Space Cowboys this season... When hitting in the lead-off spot this year, Madris is slashing .368/.464/.719/1.183 with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 4 home runs and 9 RBI

WHAT A WEEK: The Space Cowboys had the most prolific week for any team in MiLB this season during their trip to Albuquerque from 5/2-5/7, hitting .395 with 100 hits and 76 runs scored. Here is how their offensive output ranked compared to every other single-week high in MiLB.

GOING IN FRONT IN GRAND FASHION: On 5/13, for the second time in 8 games, the Space Cowboys hit a go-ahead grand slam in the seventh inning, with Rylan Bannon launching a grand slam. The grand slam capped a six-run frame and helped finish a comeback from 4-1 down to win 7-5... Justin Dirden delivered the other go-ahead grand slam on Friday, 5/5 @ ABQ, part of a 7-run frame that pushed the Space Cowboys over the top after trailing 8-2 going to the seventh.

GOT 'EM! C Korey Lee threw out Tim Lopes in the top of the 6th on 5/11, Lee's 11 caught stealing in 33 total attempts this year. His 11 caught stealing are the most in the Pacific Coast League. In 2022 with Sugar Land, Lee was tied for fifth in the Pacific Coast League in caught stealing, throwing out 17 of 62 attempted base stealers (27.4%)

GRAE ALL DAY: Grae Kessinger continues to get on base at a great clip for the Space Cowboys, reaching in 32 of his first 41 games with Sugar Land while recording hits in 26 of 41 contests, including 18 of the last 24... Kessinger had his 11-game hitting streak snapped on Tuesday night, going 0-for-4... His 11-game hitting streak is tied with Korey Lee for the longest hitting streak by a Space Cowboys player this year... On the league leader board, Kessinger is currently 8th in runs scored (32).

DOING IT WITH DEFENSE: Despite committing an error on Thursday night, the Space Cowboys have committed just 28 errors this year, the second fewest in the PCL... Their .981 fielding percentage is tied for the sixth best in Triple-A this season.

NEEDING A LATE HIT: In their four games against the Dodgers, the Space Cowboys have been held to just four total hits from the fifth inning on, and have had just two hits, both singles, after the fifth inning.

GRAND DAY FOR DIRDEN: Outfielder Justin Dirden had a career day on 5/4 against ABQ, going 4-for-5 with 3 doubles, a grand slam, 6 RBI and 2 runs scored... The six RBI are a new career high for Dirden... The former SEMO Redhawk also tied two single-game Space Cowboys franchise records with three doubles and four extra-base hits. Dirden then hit a go-ahead grand slam on Friday night in a 9-8 Space Cowboys win.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: In the seventh inning on 5/5 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys rallied for seven runs, charging back from an 8-2 deficit for a 9-8 win. Justin Dirden delivered the go-ahead hit with a grand slam, his second consecutive day with a grand slam. It's the first time the Space Cowboys have hit grand slams on back-to-back days. The closest grand slams were the first and second slams hit in Sugar Land's affiliated history on 5/13 & 5/17 (G2) @ RR in 2021, both hit by Jose Siri.

MATIJEVIC'S CAREER NIGHT: On Tuesday, 5/2 @ Albuquerque, INF JJ Matijevic re-wrote the Sugar Land Space Cowboys record books, going 5-for-6 with a double, 2 triples, 8 RBI and 2 runs scored. Since the Sugar Land franchise joined the affiliated ranks, Matijevic is the first player to record five hits in a game, surpassing the 17 times a player had registered four hits in a game, most recently done by... Matijevic on 4/5/23 vs. RR. His 8 RBI also establish a new single-game franchise record for Sugar Land, overtaking the 7 RBI recorded by Lewis Brinson on 8/3/22 @ LV. Matijevic also recorded two triples, the first player to record two three-baggers in single game. In the series finale on 5/7, Korey Lee surpassed Matijevic with six hits in a game.

For Matijevic, it was his first five-hit game of his career, passing his previous high of 4 hits on 6/21/21 @ ELP and the most RBI in a game for Matijevic in his career, surpassing his 5 RBI on 7/2/19 with Corpus Christi @ Frisco.

UNA NUEVA Y DULCE IDENTIDAD: As part of MiLB's 'Copa de la Diversión,' the Space Cowboys will rebrand on multiple occasions in 2023 as 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land.' The name is to honor the Latino community's contribution to the foundation and growth of the City of Sugar Land, which are as real as the sugar that gives our hometown its name. The primary logo of 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land,' is vibrant and features a watermelon candy capped in a flame of chamoy and chili powder.

WHERE TO FIND US: Once again in 2023, all 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard on ESPN 92.5 FM (Gow Media). An audio streaming link is also available at sspacecowboys.com. All Space Cowboys games can be seen on MiLB.TV. Garrett Greene begins his first year as the 'Voice of the Space Cowboys' and will be on the call for all game, home and away. He'll be joined by longtime Houston area broadcaster Gerald Sanchez for home games.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his fourth season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his third with Sugar Land. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with two seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

TO INFINITY AND BEYOND: Key elements of the Space Cowboys brand include the Mission Patch, Horizon Gradient and Primary Space Cowboys Logo.

- **Primary Logo:** The primary logo features the Space Cowboy donning a traditional cowboy hat, a bandanna and a blast shield over his face that is peppered with space dust and has a starburst at the eye.
- **Horizon Gradient:** Inspired by a shot of the horizon of the earth from space, the color palette and gradient feature light blue, navy, orange, gray and black notes that are prominent in the franchise's logo and uniforms. The colors represent the ever-expanding Sugar Land community and an exciting new chapter on the horizon.
- **Mission Patch:** This patch will be featured on all three uniforms and serves as an alternate logo. It intertwines elements from the Texas state flag, with a rocket superimposed over the front ready to launch.

READY TO RIDE: The Space Cowboys brand pays respect to elements that are key to the identity of Greater Houston. The NASA Johnson Space Center is located in Houston and the Cowboys element is a nod to the rugged, Western roots that are embedded in Houston as Texas' largest city.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Erick Abreu, hitting coach Aaron Westlake and development coach Wladimir Sutil. Abreu returns for his third season in Sugar Land as the pitching coach for the Astros' Triple-A affiliate. He's previously worked as the pitching coach for Astros affiliates at the Single A, Short-Season, Appalachian League, Gulf Coast League and Dominican Summer League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014. Westlake spent 2022 as the hitting coach in Double-A Corpus Christi and worked as a development coach for the Florida Gulf Coast League Astros in 2021. Sutil enters his second season on the Space Cowboys staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

SHOW BEFORE THE SHOW: Made his Triple A debut on Sept. 8, 2022 at Round Rock ... Made four appearances to end the year with Sugar Land, going 1-1 with a 2.50 ERA... In his final appearance of 2022, threw five no-hit innings against and allowed a run on five walks and six strikeouts.
