TONIGHT'S GAME

Round Rock and Sacramento will face off in game four of the series on Saturday night. River Cats RHP Drew Strotman is slated to start against Express RHP Glenn Otto with first pitch at Dell Diamond scheduled for 7:05 p.m. CT.

MAKE IT SEVEN IN A ROW

The E-Train rumbled to a 8-3 win on Friday. Sacramento struck first without recording a hit in the third after a ground out for CF Tyler Fitzgerald scored 1B Jacob Nottingham. In the third, LF Sandro Fabian crushed a solo homer to tie it up. Round Rock tallied another run in the fourth with an RBI single from 1B Dustin Harris to give the E-Train a 2-1 lead. Sacramento tied the game at two in the fifth with a home run from SS Brett Wisely. Fabian delivered again in the sixth with an RBI single and the Express led 3-2. CF Elier Hernandez batted with the bases loaded in the seventh and reached on an error, allowing C Matt Whatley to score. With the bases still juiced, Crim smashed a grand slam 453 feet to extend the lead to 8-2. Sacramento tacked a run across on a ground out in the ninth inning from LF Michael Gigliotti but Round Rock still held on for the comfortable 8-3 win.

THIRD TIME'S THE CHARM

Rangers RHP Glenn Otto is scheduled to start on Saturday. Otto has not thrown more than 3.0 innings in either of his two rehab starts. He has allowed just three total hits. The home run Otto gave up in his first start was just the 10th given up in his minor league career over eight seasons and 203.0 innings. In his Major League career, he's allowed 23 in 159.0 innings.

WARM WELCOME TO TRIPLE-A

In his Triple-A debut, RHP Owen White tossed 5.0 innings and allowed only two runs on one hit with three walks and four strikeouts. The righty tossed 5.0 innings or more in six outings this year at Double-A Frisco. His teammate in Frisco, OF Dustin Harris made his Triple-A debut on Tuesday and in three games thus far, he's hitting .545 (6-for-11) with a double, triple, home run, three RBI, four runs, two walks and two strikeouts.

HE JUST KEEPS GOING

On Friday night, Express OF Elier Hernandez extended his hitting streak to 24 games with a single. His franchise-record streak is the longest of the season in the Pacific Coast League and dates back to May 24. During the hitting streak, he is batting .421 (45-107) with nine doubles, two triples, eight home runs, 30 runs scored, 37 RBI, nine walks and 24 strikeouts.

CRIM HAVING A GRAND OLE' TIME

Express DH Blaine Crim launched a grand slam in last night's 8-3 win which was the first grand slam for Round Rock since May 25 at Albuquerque off the bat of INF Davis Wendzel. Crim finished the night 2-for-4 with a home run, four RBI and two runs scored. He's hit a home run in three consecutive games which is the fourth time in his career that he's homered in three or more consecutive games but it is the first time he's accomplished the feat at the Triple-A level.

PUTTING UP NUMBERS

In three games against Sacramento, the Express have tallied 34 runs, including eight home runs. They are batting .367 (40-109) to start the series which are the most runs and home runs for Round Rock in the first three games of a series this season.

WEEKEND ROSTER MOVES

On Saturday morning, RHP Yerry Rodriguez was recalled by the Texas Rangers and C Miguel Ojeda was transferred to the Arizona Complex League. OF Bubba Thompson was reinstated from the 7-Day Injured List and C Jordan Procysen was reinstated from the Development List.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.

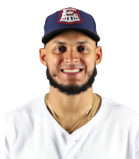
