#### LRST TIME OUT

(BUFFALO, NY - Sept 18) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders fell 7-6 to the Buffalo Bisons in ten innings. The loss dissipated the RailRiders playoff chances in the International League.

The RailRiders plated a pair in the third inning for a 2-0 lead. Jahmai Jones was hit by a pitch and Greg Allen reached on an error. Jorbit Vivas worked an RBI single while Ben Rice had a sacrifice fly.

In the next inning, Buffalo got on the board. Will Robertson recorded the third hit of the frame to drive in a run and cut down the lead to one. Will Warren worked five innings of one run ball. The Yankees #5 prospect struck out six on 85 pitches.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre added to their offense in the sixth inning. Rice led off with a double, and a hit batter and a walk loaded the bases. JC Escarra and Greg Allen each had RBI singles along with a Bisons error to make it 5-1.

In the seventh frame, Buffalo used a pair of home runs off of Anthony Misiewicz to tie things up. A pinch-hit three-run blast from Damiano Palmegiani and a solo shot off the bat of Rafael Lantigua made it five apiece.

Again, the game went tied into extras. In the top of the tenth, Rice was the placed runner on second and came all the way around to score on a sacrifice fly to right. The RailRiders led 6-5. SWB went to Oscar González, a position player, on the mound to finish the game. But, Max McDowell homered immediately to walk it off for Buffalo 7-5.

#### NEWS & NOTES

**TIME'S UP**- After dropping last night's game the RailRiders are officially out of the playoffs as Columbus clinched with a victory. The RailRiders are tied for second with Worcester four and a half games back. They currently have the second best record overall in the International League to the first half champs in Omaha who is 88-56.

**EXTRA EXTRA**- SWB holds a 7-4 record in extra inning games this season after winning Tuesday and falling last night. The RailRiders are 4-0 when the game goes into the eleventh or beyond.

**BEETER'S BACK**- Clayton Beeter has returned to the RailRiders after being placed on the Injured List on May 21. He made two appearances in Double-A Somerset before coming back into SWB's bullpen. In this stint he has worked two clean appearances out of the bullpen. Beeter made his Major League Debut with the Yankees earlier this season.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN**- The road has been kind to the RailRiders who are 42-28 in games played outside of PNC Field. They swept two road series - one at Norfolk and the other at Jacksonville, both in the first half of the season. This is the team's third trip up to Buffalo this season after making two quick three-game stints, one to start of the season and the other right after the All-Star Break. They are 12-7 against the Bisons this season and it is only fitting they wrap up their summer here.

**ROSTER BREAKDOWN**- SWB has had 30 different position players this season, including rehabbers DJ LeMahieu and Jon Berti. The team has featured 44 unique arms with 19 of them working out of the starting role at least once. It was the first time that Gerrit Cole pitched as a RailRider. Five different position players came out of the bullpen as well. Josh Maciejewski was the only pitcher to take a formal at-bat.

**WINNING WEDNESDAY**- The RailRiders finished off the first half of the season winning every Wednesday game they played. The team went 11-0 in the second contest of the week. Since then, they have gone 18-5 on Wednesday's with a few of those coming from split doubleheaders.

**RUNNING DOWN A DREAM**- The RailRiders set the single-season stolen base record in the International League with 238 steals, topping the mark of 223 set by Omaha last summer. They have reached 200 stolen bases for the first time in franchise history with an 83% success rate. This tops last year's franchise record of 174 swipes. Brandon Lockridge led in his tenure with 34 while Caleb Durbin has 28 and counting. Twenty-three players have had at least one. The Charleston Charlies also had 224 in 1976.

**WHO CAN GO?**- The RailRiders active roster currently contains ten players that are also on the Yankees 40-man roster. There are five pitchers, including one they view as a starter starter. The team also features five position players who are eligible for a quick call-up, including #16 Jorbit Vivas.
