<u>June 14: RubberDucks 7, Yard Goats 1:</u> Guy Lipscomb had a four hit day while **Joe Lampe** and **Jorge Burgos** hit back-to-back first inning home runs. **Tommy Mace** struck out five over five innings in the win.

Today's starting pitcher: Zach Jacobs makes his first start of the season for the RubberDucks. In 16 relief appearances this season, Jacobs has struck out 31 over 28.2 innings pitched. He has gone multiple innings in 11 of his 16 appearances and has not allowed a run in his last six outings (12.0 IP). He has faced Hartford twice this week tossing two perfect innings with two strikeouts.

Stretch run: Entering Sunday, the RubberDucks sit 1.5 games back of the Erie SeaWolves for the Eastern League Southwest Division first half title and playoff spot. Erie's 2.5 game lead earlier this week was the largest lead either team has had over the other since the start of the season. Akron's largest lead was 1.5 games on May 28. Erie holds the tiebreaker over Akron. The last day of the first half is June 22.

<u>Pitching strong:</u> The RubberDucks enter Sunday with the second-best ERA (2.97) in Double-A. A lot of this success is due to the starting pitching of the Ducks. Akron starters have the best ERA (2.28) in the EL and Double-A while tossing the seventh most innings (287.2) in Double-A.

Good eye: The RubberDucks have walked 275 times this season, which is most in the Eastern League and third most in Double-A. Cooper Ingle (39) leads the RubberDucks and is second in the Eastern League while Dayan Frias (38) is second on the RubberDucks and third in the EL in free passes. The RubberDucks worked eight walks in their win on May 31 in Somerset. 11 Akron batters have worked double digit walks so far this season, and seven (Frias, Ingle, Jorge Burgos, Kahlil Watson, Jake Fox and Alex Mooney) have drawn 20+ walks.

May man: Cooper Ingle is red hot at the plate. Since his average dropped to a season low .179 on April 17, the RubberDucks catcher has picked up a hit in 31 of his 44 games played. In the month of May, Ingle hit.345/.472/.607 with 13 doubles (most in the Eastern League), three home runs (tied most on the RubberDucks), 17 RBI (second most in EL and Ducks) and 21 walks (tied most on the Ducks). Ingle has now raised his average to .278 on the season, which is the highest by an active Akron batter. His 56 hits this year are the most by an Akron batter. Ingle had his first professional four-hit game on June 3 against Chesapeake at Canal Park.

RubberDucks travel to the Yard Goats: Akron and Hartford will face off for the only meeting between the two clubs in 2025. Akron was 5-7 against Hartford in 2024 including going 2-4 at Dunkin' Park. Akron leads the all-time series between the two franchises 33-22. Top prospects in this series include:

What a Guy: Guy Lipscomb is on fire for the RubberDucks. He is hitting .364 (12-33) with two homers, two doubles and four RBI in nine games played this month. This week in Hartford, Lipscomb has eight of his 12 hits this month including a four-hit game against the Yard Goats on June 14. He has raised his season average from .220 at the end of May to .258 entering Sunday.

<u>Bringing them home:</u> Three Akron batters rank top 10 in the Eastern League in RBI this season. **Jorge Burgos** leads the EL with 45 while **Cooper Ingle** and **Joe Lampe** are eighth and ninth with 35 and 34.

Powering the Lampe: Joe Lampe has been showing off some power at the plate as of late. Since May 23, Lampe has five doubles, four homers and a triple in 17 games played. The second year RubberDucks outfielder has raised his season average from .177 to .220 in that span. He has driven in 17 of his 34 RBI during this stretch as well.

<u>The future is Genao:</u> Angel Genao picked up his first Double-A hit as part of a two-hit game on June 11 in Hartford. The #53 prospect in MLB (according to MLB Pipeline), recorded his first Double-A RBI the night before. After going hitless in his first Double-A game, Genao has six hits, two doubles and two RBI against the Yard Goats this week. He has recorded a two-hit performance in back-to-back games.

Miller time: Jake Miller has worked seven straight scoreless outings (13 innings) out of the RubberDucks bullpen. He has struck out 18 batters and allowed just five hits in that span. The right-hander has the second lowest ERA (1.47) on the Ducks staff (min. 10.0IP) while tossing multiple innings in 12 of his 20 outings this season.

<u>Can't start a fire without a spark:</u> The RubberDucks are outscoring opponents 74-28 in the first two innings and 44-11 in the first inning this season. Akron is 33-9 when scoring first (most wins in the Eastern League when scoring first). The RubberDucks batters have 90 hits the first time through the order this year. Akron leadoff man **Cooper Ingle** is batting .293 when leading off an inning this season.

2025 RUBBERDUCKS FIELD STAFF

#26 Manager Greg DiCenzo enters his fifth season with the Guardians organization. The 2024 season will be DiCenzo's second as RubberDucks manager, and fourth as a manager in the Guardians organization. He guided the RubberDucks to an 80-58 record and an Eastern League playoff appearance in 2024.

Prior to becoming Triple-A Columbus' bench coach in 2023, DiCenzo spent the 2021 and 2022 seasons as the manager in High-A Lake County. He guided the Captains to a 141-108 record in his two seasons including a Midwest League finals appearance in 2022.

A native of Duxbury, MA, DiCenzo was the head baseball coach at Holy Cross for 12 seasons prior to joining the Cleveland organization. The Crusaders went 137-109 in Patriot League play during his tenure, including a 2017 Patriot League Championship, and posted 20-win seasons in 10 of those 12 years.

#55 Hitting Coach Jordan Becker enters his sixth season with the Guardians organization and second with the RubberDucks. In 2023, Becker served as the hitting coach for Lake County.

Becker joined the Cleveland organization in 2019 after a collegiate coaching career that saw stops at Riverside Community College and New Mexico State University.

#29 Hitting Coach lan Forster enters his sixth season in the Guardians organization and second season in Akron. Forster will also be a hitting coach for RubberDucks and returns to Akron after serving as the RubberDucks assistant hitting coach in 2023. He was the Arizona Complex Guardians hitting coach in 2024

A graduate of North Olmsted High School, Forster played four years at Baldwin Wallace University in Berea.

#12 Pitching Coach Kevin Erminio enters his sixth season in the Guardians organization and first season with the RubberDucks. Prior to coming to Akron, Erminio was the pitching coach for the Lake County Captains for the 2023 and 2024 seasons.

Erminio joined the Guardians organization after a collegiate coaching career that included stops as a pitching coach in Oxford at Miami University and 13 seasons at Kennesaw State.

#54 Pitching Coach Michael Poole enters his third season in the Guardians organization and second season with the RubberDucks. He will be a pitching coach in 2025 after spending 2024 as Akron's assistant pitching coach. Prior to joining the RubberDucks, Poole was the pitching development coach on the Arizona Complex Academy staff.

A native of Akron, Poole played at Cuyahoga Community College and Lake Erie College before starting his coaching career at Inspiration Academy (FL) in 2019. Poole was an assistant coach at LSU-Eunice for the Bengals D2 JUCO World Series Championship season in 2021.

#49 Bench Coach Marc Mumper enters his third season in the Guardians organization and first season in Akron. He will also serve as the Guardians organization's assistant infield coordinator. Prior to coming to Akron, Mumper spent 2024 as the bench coach for Lake County.

A native of Highlands Ranch, CO, Mumper played 157 games from 2016-19 for Grand Canyon University. He then went on to coach at the college level in several different roles from 2019-22 before joining the Guardians organization.

#41 Development Coach Seth Caddell enters his second season as a coach in the Guardians organization and second season with the RubberDucks. Before joining the RubberDucks coaching staff in 2024, Caddell played in the Guardians organization for three seasons as a catcher.

Athletic Trainer Derrik Diaz enters his eighth season in the Guardians organization and second season with the RubberDucks. He also serves as the Guardians organization's assistant coordinator for Dominican Republic Medical Services. Diaz was the Eastern League Athletic Trainer of the Year in 2024. Prior to coming to Akron, Diaz served as the head athletic trainer for the Dominican Republic Complex in 2023.

Assistant Athletic Trainer Karina Gonzalez enters her third season in the Guardians organization and second season in Akron. Prior to coming to Akron, Gonzalez spent the 2023 season at the Guardians complex in Goodyear.

Strength and Conditioning Coach Mo Cuevas enters his 10th season with the Guardians organization and third season in Akron. He was the Eastern League Strength Coach of the Year in 2024. Prior to joining the RubberDucks, Cuevas served as the Guardians rehab strength and conditioning coach in 2022.

Baseball Technology Fellow Kade Enders enters his first season in Akron. A native of Medina, Enders previously worked as an intern for USA baseball, video associate for the Los Angeles Dodgers and baseball performance science video intern for the Tampa Bay Rays before joining the Guardians organization.

We Are the RubberDucks

On October 29, 2013, team owner **Ken Babby** and general manager **Jim Pfander** stood before a capacity audience at the Akron Civic Theater and announced that the team would be known henceforth as the **Akron RubberDucks**. In addition to being symbolic of the fun, family-friendly brand of entertainment offered by minor league baseball, the name also honors Akron's long history as the "**Rubber Capital of the World.**" Brandiose Marketing of San Diego, California designed the team logo, colors, and various marks and insignias. Please note that for print coverage, *RubberDucks* is spelled as one word with a capital "D." In broadcast coverage, referring to the team as "the 'Ducks" is an acceptable variation of the team's nickname.
