SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Senators, 4-3, for their fourth straight win. **Andy Thomas** opened the scoring in the third with a two-run double. **Simon Whiteman** opened a 3-0 lead in the fourth with an RBI double. In the fifth, **Marco Luciano** hit a solo homer, his 10th of the season, to extend the lead to 4-0. Frankie Tostado broke the shutout with an RBI groundout in the sixth. In the eighth, Trey Lipscomb hit a two-run single to pull the Senators within a run. In the top of the ninth, Harrisburg loaded the bases, but Tostado flied out to deep center to end the game. **Mason Black** started and worked 4.1 scoreless innings, his fourth consecutive start without allowing a run. **Jose Cruz** closed out his fourth save.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. This series is the second of the year between the two teams. The Flying Squirrels opened the season with a three-game sweep against the Fightin Phils at The Diamond on April 8 and 9. Today marks the first game of the second half of this year's Eastern League season. The second-half champions of each division will face the Erie SeaWolves and the Somerset Patriots in the playoffs this September.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS went 33-36 in the second half, finishing in fourth place in the Southwest Division. They were 14-7 through their first 21 games but are 19-29 since May 3, but have won four straight, tying their longest winning streak of the year. Over the last four games, the Flying Squirrels are batting .336 (41-for-122) with three homers, 11 doubles and have scored 23 runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.86 ERA is second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 246.1 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 348.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.33 ERA, which is the second-lowest in Double-A and is sixth-lowest of the 120 teams in the minors. Richmond has played the second-most one-run games in the league this year (24) behind Harrisburg (25), and are tied for the most one-run losses (16) with Harrisburg.

THE FIGHTIN PHILS were 28-40 in the first half of the season, which was last in the Eastern League. Last week, Reading won four-of-six at Portland, including three straight wins to open the series, which tied their longest win streak of the season. The Fightin Phils opened the season 0-5, including a three-game sweep at The Diamond to begin the year. The Reading offense leads the league in batting average (.267), hits (617), total bases (1006), triples (15), OBP (.355), SLG (.435) and OPS (.790). Reading's roster includes six of Baseball America's top-30 Phillies prospects, including RHP Mick Abel (No. 2), RHP Griff McGarry (No. 4), OF Johan Rojas (No. 5), OF Ethan Wilson (No. 11), OF Carlos De La Cruz (No. 17) and OF Jhailyn Ortiz (No. 22). McGarry is rated by Baseball America as having the best fastball, Ortiz is rated as having the best outfield arm and Baron Radcliff is rated as the best power hitter. MLB.com's top-30 Phillies prospect list includes Abel (No. 2), McGarry (No. 4), Rojas (No. 6), De La Cruz (No. 9), Wilson (No. 14) and Ortiz (No. 18).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Ryan Murphy** makes his 13th start of the season and his second appearance against the Fightin Phils. He last pitched on Thursday against the Senators and allowed three runs (two earned) over 2.2 innings in a loss. In his last four starts since June 4, Murphy is 0-2 with a 3.07 ERA (5 ER/14.2 IP). He pitched against the Fightin Phils out of the bullpen in the season-opener on April 8 at The Diamond and threw two scoreless innings. Last year, Murphy made his home debut at The Diamond against Reading and pitched five hitless, scoreless innings. Last year, Murphy began the season with High-A Eugene and went 1-0 with a 2.90 ERA in seven starts. He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in late-June and made two starts before being placed on the injured list for most of the rest of the season. Murphy was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Le Moyne College near Syracuse, N.Y., and was the highest-drafted Division II player that year. Murphy is currently rated by Baseball America as the No. 20 Giants prospect and No. 27 by MLB.com. **For more on Murphy, see page two.**

FOR READING: Right-hander Victor Vargas makes his sixth Double-A start. He last pitched on June 18 against the Yard Goats and allowed a season-high seven runs over three innings. The next day, he was placed on the development list. In his previous start on June 13, also against Hartford, he worked six innings and allowed one unearned run in a win. Vargas opened his season in May with High-A Jersey Shore and made three starts, posting a 4.91 ERA. Vargas signed with the Phillies in 2017. This season is his first at the Double-A level.

RETURN OF THE MECK: In Game 1 of Friday's doubleheader, **Wade Meckler** closed his historic performance with a two-run, walk-off single, giving the Flying Squirrels a 9-8 win in extras. Meckler went 5-for-5 and tied the single-game franchise record for hits. It was the 11th time a Richmond player has collected five hits in a game, joining **Conor Gillaspie** (2010), **Nick Noonan** (2010), **Juan Perez** (twice, 2011 and 2012), **Kelby Tomlinson** (2014), **Rando Moreno** (2015), **Austin Slater** (2016), **Tyler Fitzgerald** (2022), **Jacob Heyward** (2022) and **Patrick Bailey** (2023). On Friday, Meckler set a new career high for hits and tied his career high with four RBIs. Meckler has now reached base in all 16 of his Double-A games, including 22 hits and 12 walks. His on-base streak is the third-longest active streak in the league and the third-longest by a Richmond player this season. Meckler leads all MiLB hitters (min. 160 PA) this season with a .411 batting average, ranks first in BABIP (.459) and third in OBP (.478).

I LOVE LUCI: On June 4, **Marco Luciano** hit a grand slam and a two-run homer in the Flying Squirrels' 11-2 win. It was the fourth multi-homer game of his career. He went deep again with a two-run homer on Sunday afternoon and added a 432-foot, opposite-field two-run shot last Wednesday at Bowie. Luciano is tied for the team lead with nine homers this year. He went on a five-game hit streak from June 10-14, during which he hit .588 (10-for-17) with four homers, a double, five walks and 10 RBIs. After going 1-for-20 over his next five games, Luciano has picked up six hits in his last three games, including going 4-for-4 on Saturday and hitting a solo home run on Sunday.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: In his last two games since Saturday, **Andy Thomas** has driven in five runs. On Saturday, he hit a two-run double in the first inning and added an RBI single in the seventh. On Sunday, Thomas again opened the scoring with a two-run double in the third inning. For the year, Thomas leads the team with 32 RBIs. He has driven in three-or-more runs three times, including a season-high four RBIs on May 28 at Binghamton.

RAGIN' CANTRELLE: In his last nine games since June 14, **Hayden Cantrelle** has reached base 16 times, posting a .471 on-base percentage. In that stretch, he has picked up six hits, walked eight times and been hit by a pitch twice in 34 plate appearances. Cantrelle is hitless in his last five games but has walked six times. This season, he has been hit by a pitch 13 times, the most in the Eastern League. He also ranks sixth in the league in on-base percentage (.397) and tied for seventh in walks (43). He is also second among Giants minor leaguers in walks for the year.

OLD FRIENDS: Reading's roster includes former Flying Squirrels pitcher Matt Seelinger, who played with Richmond in 2021. The reliever spent that entire season with the Flying Squirrels, going 3-1 with a 3.07 ERA in 36 appearances. He was selected by the Phillies in the minor-league phase of the 2021 Rule 5 Draft. With Reading last year, Seelinger pitched against Richmond twice, both at The Diamond, and allowed one unearned run over 2.2 innings of work with four strikeouts. Seelinger is one of four former Richmond players in the Eastern League this year. Frankie Tostado, who was with the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, is playing with the Senators. Diego Rincones, who was with the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, is now playing for the Erie SeaWolves. Pitcher Grey Fenter, a member of the 2022 Flying Squirrels, is now with the Somerset Patriots.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Hayden Cantrelle** is sixth in OBP (.396) and tied for seventh in walks (41). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for third in triples (3). **Kai-Wei Teng** is tied for ninth in strikeouts (68). **Mason Black** is tied for first in games started (14).

WHERE THE FIGHTINS RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Matt Kroon is second in batting average (.327), seventh in OBP (.396), seventh in hits (70) and tied for sixth in doubles (16). Johan Rojas is fourth in batting average (.317), tied for eighth in RBIs (38), first in hits (88), tied for sixth in doubles (16), tied for first in triples (4), tied for sixth in extra-base hits (26), fifth in total bases (130), first in runs scored (49) and tied for fourth in stolen bases (26). Carlos De La Cruz is seventh in batting average (.299), tied for third in homers (14), ninth in SLG (.509), ninth in OPS (.881), third in hits (81), fifth in extra-base hits (28), third in total bases (138) and tied for second in runs scored (48). Oliver Dunn is fourth in RBIs (41), eighth in OBP (.395), 10th in OPS (.873), third in walks (48) Ethan Wilson is eighth in SLG (.510) and tied for sixth in extra-base hits (26). Madison Stokes is tied for sixth in doubles (16). Nick Podkul is tied for third in triples (3).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Marco Luciano** (No. 1), **Vaun Brown** (No. 6), **Carson Whisenhunt** (No. 8), **Mason Black** (No. 9), **Carson Seymour** (No. 12), **Landen Roupp** (No. 13), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 20), **Wade Meckler** (No. 23) and **Randy Rodriguez** (No. 30). Luciano is also rated as the No. 63 prospect on Baseball America's Top 100. In Baseball America's "Best Tools" list, Luciano is rated as the best power hitter, Brown is rated as the best hitter for average and best athlete, Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp is rated as having the best curveball and **José Cruz** is rated as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list includes 10 Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2, No. 13 overall), Brown (No. 5), Whisenhunt (No. 8), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 25), Murphy (No. 26), Cruz (No. 29) and Meckler (No. 30).
