### THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this day in 2000, Craig Wilson tied the club's single-game home run record with three blasts in a 10-9 win over Tucson at Greer Stadium. Wilson was a PCL All-Star that season and finished with 33 homers, one shy of tying the single-season club record.

**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds begin a seven-game series against the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp tonight at 121 Financial Ballpark. The Sounds are coming off a series split with Charlotte, while Jacksonville lost six of seven to the Durham Bulls. Eric Lauer makes his first start on rehab from Milwaukee, facing former Brewer hurler Chi Chi González.

**Eric Lauer:** 28-year-old Eric Lauer starts for Nashville on rehab assignment from the Milwaukee Brewers. The left-hander started 4-5 with a 5.48 ERA (42.2 IP/26 ER) for the Brewers in nine outings (8 starts) before being placed on the 15-day injured list with right shoulder impingement on May 21. Lauer was shelled for six runs (all earned) on six hits and three homers by Tampa Bay on May 20, his last appearance. The Elyria, Ohio native went 11-7 with a 3.69 ERA (158.2 IP/65 ER) in 29 starts for the Brewers in 2022. He has made one appearance with Nashville in his career, a start on May 20, 2021 vs. Gwinnett after he was optioned on May 15. He shut down the Strippers with five one-hit innings (0 R, 2 BB, 12 K) before being recalled later in the week. The Kent State University product was originally selected with the 25th pick of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft by San Diego.

**Chi Chi González:** 31-year-old Chi Chi González goes for Jacksonville tonight. The right-hander is 2-4 with a 5.80 ERA (45.0 IP/29 ER) in nine starts for the Jumbo Shrimp. He's also 0-0 with a 3.38 ERA (2.2 IP/1 ER) in two appearances with Miami in 2023. González took the loss in his last start on May 31 at Durham (G1), allowing three runs (all earned) on a homer and six other hits. He has pitched twice against Nashville this season, going 1-0 with a 0.69 ERA (13.0 IP/1 ER) on April 18 and April 23. Last season, González pitched in the Majors with three different organizations (Minnesota, Milwaukee, New York-AL). He combined to go 0-1 with a 5.87 ERA in the big leagues in 2022. He has also had time with Colorado (2019-21) and Texas (2015-16). The well-traveled hurler out of Oral Roberts University was originally selected with the 23rd pick of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft by the Rangers.

**2023 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2023: First: 1, Second: 6, Third: 2, Fourth: 15, Fifth: 21, Sixth: 9, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

**Rehabbing Brewers:** Left-hander Eric Lauer and right-hander J.B. Bukauskas join the Sounds in Jacksonville on rehab assignment from Milwaukee, while infielder Luis Urias has returned to Milwaukee. Lauer and Bukauskas become the sixth and seventh Brewers to play for Nashville on rehab this season, respectively (Adrian Houser, Tyrone Taylor, Gus Varland, Luke Voit and Urias).

**Pat is Raking:** Infielder Patrick Dorrian continued his prowess at the plate with his eighth homer of the season on Sunday, a two-run blast as part of Nashville's four-run fifth inning. Since May 5, Dorrian is batting .338 (25-for-74) with five doubles, seven homers, 20 RBI and 18 runs. The Lynn University product also stole multiple bases for the first time in his career.

**Devanney is Always On Base:** Shortstop Cam Devanney extended his on-base streak to 10 games with a walk in Sunday's loss. Since the streak began on May 17, Devanney has been hitting .314 (11-for-35) with five doubles, four RBI, five runs and an .816 OPS.

**(Almonst) Best in the League:** The Sounds pitching staff lost the lowest ERA mark after a 10-8 loss on Sunday. Their 4.28 ERA is second-best in the International League, trailing Indianapolis' 4.20 ERA. Nashville pitchers still hold the best WHIP (1.38) and are tied with the fewest walks with Memphis (226).

**Sounds in the Show:** Sounds first baseman Jon Singleton had his contract selected by Milwaukee on Saturday and recorded his first MLB hit since July 29, 2015 vs. Los Angeles-AL. Singleton became the 14th different Sound to get the call to Milwaukee in 2023, joining Joey Wiemer (4/1), Janson Junk (4/11), Colin Rea (4/13), Elvis Peguero (4/16), Alex Claudio (4/24), Jake Cousins (4/24), Tyson Miller (4/26), Bennett Sousa (5/5), Trevor Megill (5/15), J.B. Bukauskas (5/16), Ethan Small (5/26), Andruw Monasterio (5/27), and Abraham Toro (5/30).

**The Future Brew Crew:** Nashville currently has three players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects, which has been updated due to the recent graduations of INF Brice Turang and OF Joey Wiemer. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect.

**How Sweet It Is:** Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 628-546 record during an eight-season span.
