**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost to the Senators, 3-1, for their fourth straight loss in the series. **Ismael Munguia** led off the game with a double and later scored on an RBI single by **Victor Bericoto** later in the first. The Senators took the lead in the fourth with a sac fly by J.T. Arruda and a single by Daylen Lile. **Nick Swiney** pitched 2.1 hitless innings and struck out three. **Nick Garcia** worked a scoreless eighth inning.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Harrisburg Senators in the finale of a six-game series. In both previous six-game series between the two teams, they each won three games. The Flying Squirrels went 3-3 in Harrisburg from April 16-21. The Flying Squirrels won the first three games of a series at The Diamond from July 9-14 before the Senators took the final three games. This is the final series between the two teams this year.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have lost four consecutive games since Wednesday to drop to a tie for last in the Southwest Division with Harrisburg and Altoona. They are 2-8 in their last 10 games since August 9. They have been held to two-or-less runs in six-of-their-last eight games since August 10's doubleheader. They have been held to one-or-less runs and four-or-less hits in four-of-their-last eight games.

**THE SENATORS** are tied for last place in the Southwest Division second-half standings. In the first half, they finished in second place, one game behind Erie. Harrisburg's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects, including INF Yohandy Morales (No. 6), RHP Andry Lara (No. 15), OF Daylen Lile (No. 18), OF Andrew Pinckney (No. 23) and RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 25). MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects list includes eight Harrisburg players, including INF Yohandy Morales (No. 9), OF Daylen Lile (No. 12), RHP Andry Lara (No. 17), RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 19), INF Kevin Made (No. 25 - on IL), RHP Marquis Grissom (No. 26) of OF Andrew Pinckney (No. 28).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Nick Sinacola** makes his 11th Double-A start and his third against the Senators. He faced the Senators on July 13 and allowed four runs over two innings. In the opener of this series, he allowed three runs over five innings to pick up a win. For the season, Sinacola is tied for first in the Giants system in wins (8). Out of Giants minor league pitchers who have worked at least 80 innings, he is first in BAA (.212), first in WHIP (0.98), second in BB/9 (1.88) and second in walk percentage (5.4%). He made his Double-A debut on June 6 against the Curve at The Diamond and allowed five runs over 4.1 innings. In his next five starts from June 12-July 4, he went 3-0 with a 1.33 ERA (4 ER/27.0 IP). He began the season with High-A Eugene and went 4-1 with a 2.68 ERA in 10 outings, including two starts. At the time of his promotion to Double-A, Sinacola ranked second among Northwest League pitchers (min. 40 IP) in WHIP (0.79), third in BB/9 (1.56), third in BAA (.190), ninth in ERA (2.68), and 10th in K/9 (8.48). He spent the entire 2023 season with the Emeralds and went 2-5 with a 4.58 ERA over 23 outings (20 starts). Sinacola was selected by the Giants in the seventh round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine, where he was the America East Pitcher of the Year that season as a senior. *For more on Sinacola, see page two.*

**FOR HARRISBURG:** Right-hander Kyle Luckham makes his 18th Double-A start of the season and his fourth against the Flying Squirrels. On April 16, he worked six innings and allowed two runs in a no-decision to open a series at The Diamond. On April 17 in the series finale, he allowed seven runs, tied for his highest this season, over five innings in a loss. He pitched against the Flying Squirrels on July 10 in Harrisburg and allowed five runs across 5.1 innings in a loss. Last time out, Luckham pitched for Triple-A Rochester at Buffalo last Sunday and surrendered four runs in 2.1 innings. Last year, he spent most of the season with High-A Wilmington and went 5-7 with a 4.85 ERA in 25 games (24 starts). He finished the year tied for first in the South Atlantic League in games started (24) and innings pitched (124.1) while ranking third in BAA (.252) and WHIP (1.23) and sixth in ERA (4.85). He was promoted to Double-A Harrisburg for his final start of the season on September 15 and allowed four runs (three earned) over five innings against the Baysox. Luckham was selected in the 15th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Nationals out of Arizona State University.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** The Flying Squirrels have turned 80 groundball double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 19 double plays this year, which is the most in the minor leagues. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. They matched that feat with four double plays in the first four innings at Harrisburg on Friday night with Bertrand pitching. Those four double plays were tied for the month induced by a pitcher in the Eastern League dating back to 2005, which is the first year those statistics are readily available. It has been accomplished by three other Richmond pitchers, including **Daryl Maday** in 2010, **Clayton Blackburn** twice in 2014 and **Garrett Williams** in 2019. Bertrand's 19 GIDPs this year are tied for the fourth-most in a season in franchise history, trailing 27 by **Craig Westcott** in 2012 (second-most in the Eastern league since at least 2005), 21 by **Clayton Tanner** in 2010 and 20 by **Mike MacDonald** in 2010.

**TURN IT UP TO 11:** On Wednesday, **Dylan Cumming** set a new career high with 11 strikeouts over his 4.1 innings. He became the first Richmond pitcher to strike out 11 in a game since 2022. He became the 12th pitcher in Flying Squirrels franchise history to record at least 11 strikeouts in a game, a list that also includes **Matt Frisbee** (franchise-record 13 in 2022), **Eric Surkamp**, **Mike Kickham**, **Justin Fitzgerald**, **Chris Heston**, **Clayton Blackburn**, **Tyler Beede**, **Conner Menez**, **Kai-Wei Teng**, **Bryan Brickhouse** and **Kyle Harrison**. For the 2024 season, Cumming's 11.88 K/9 is the fourth-highest in the minors among pitchers who have thrown at least 90 innings.

**BERICOTO BASHING:** In his last 51 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .296 (61-for-206) with four homers, 10 doubles, nine walks and 29 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he had not homered in 34 games before belting a two-run shot on August 9 off the scoreboard in left-center. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in 18-of-44 games dating back to June 15.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked ninth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,593), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Two of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 11) and SS **Diego Velasquez** (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features two Richmond players, including Velasquez (No. 17) and LHP **Jack Choate** (No. 21).

**BOULEVARD TO THE BAY:** This season, 12 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including **Joe Panik**, **Adam Duvall**, **Andrew Susac**, **Matt Duffy**, **Jackson Williams**, **Edwin Escobar**, **Hunter Strickland**, **Chris Dominguez**, **Gary Brown**, **Brett Bochy** and **Chris Heston**. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are **Erik Miller** (2023 Flying Squirrels), **Landen Roupp** (2022-23), **Kai-Wei Teng** (2022-23), **Nick Avila** (2022), **Randy Rodriguez** (2022-23), **Mason Black** (2023), **Gerson Garabito** (2021), **Spencer Bivens** (2023), **Raymond Burgos** (2023), **Hayden Birdsong** (2023-24), **Parker Dunshee** (2023) and **Grant McCray** (2024). Dating back to 2022, 21-of-the-last-23 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. Last year saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

**LOTTA INS, LOTTA OUTS, LOTTA WHAT-HAVE-YOUS:** There have been 59 players who have seen action for the Flying Squirrels this year, which is one shy of the franchise record for a single season. In 2018 and 2019, the Flying Squirrels had 60 different players see time on the field. This season, there have been 30 different pitchers used by the Flying Squirrels, which includes appearances by **Andy Thomas** on June 1 against the SeaWolves and **Luis Toribio** on August 10 against the Yard Goats. There have been 30 different hitters who have seen at least one plate appearance with Richmond this season.
