MARTIN AND MORENO'S THREE-HIT NIGHTS LEAD NEW HAMPSHIRE TO 12-4 WIN: Starting pitcher Zach Logue retired 16 of the last 17 batters he faced while Gabriel Moreno and LJ Talley each drove in three runs to lead the Fisher Cats to a 12-4 over the Sea Dogs last night at Delta Dental Stadium. Austin Martin and Moreno each tallied three hits as New Hampshire matched a season-high with 16.

LOGUE IMPROVES TO 2-0: Logue became the first New Hampshire pitcher to work six innings in a start this season. He walked one and struck out six batters. The only run the Sea Dogs scored off Logue came in the top of the first inning on an RBI single by Joey Meneses.

THE STREAKS: Otto López went 1-for-4 to extend his hit streak to Double-A Northeast-leading fourteen games....Gabriel Moreno, recently added to *Baseball America's* Top 100 Prospects list, has now hit in a career-best 11 straight games. His three-hit performance last night lifted his average to .444, second-best in the league and all of Double-A.

HAS IT EVER HAPPENED?: New Hampshire has scored 12 runs in back-to-back victories over Portland. It's the first time New Hampshire has scored 12 in back-to-back games since May 26-27, 2011 (13-7 at Portland, followed by a 15-3 home win over New Britain). It's the fourth time that's happened. New Hampshire has never scored 12 or more in three consecutive games.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: On this date in 2006, the Fisher Cats won at Connecticut 23-9. The 23 runs and 26 hits still stand as the club records, and the 32 total runs make it the highest scoring game in team history. 3B Eric Arnold went 4-for-6 with 7 RBI, and Adam Lind had 5 hits.... The Fisher Cats went out the next night and lost 2-0 to the Defenders (SF Giants) in Norwich.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays fell in 12 to Tampa Bay, 9-7. Vlad Guerrero Jr. hit two homers, driving in four runs....Triple-A Buffalo won 6-4 at Worcester. Nate Pearson started for the Bisons, allowing one run in 3.0 IP. Bryan Baker picked up the win in relief with five strikeouts in two scoreless innings. Riley Adams homered off Fisher Cats alum Marcus Walden in a three-run ninth to lift Buffalo...Adv. A Vancouver dropped a 4-3 decision last night to Hillsboro...and Class-A Dunedin blanked Clearwater 1-0.

COMING UP: Next week, the Fisher Cats will head to New Jersey to wrap up the season series with the Somerset Patriots (New York Yankees Double-A affiliate). Following that, the Fisher Cats will return home to Delta Dental Stadium to face the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (New York Mets) starting on June 1.

ROSTER MOVES: May 21: RHP Willy Gaston transferred from High-A Dunedin to New Hampshire. The 25-year old, both in Havana, Cuba, made his Double-A debut last night. He had appeared in four games, all in relief for the D-Jays, going 2-0, 1.69 ERA. He had struck out 13 in 10.2 IP.

ON THE HILL: Toronto Blue Jays number two pitching prospect and number four overall prospect Simeon Woods Richardson gets the start today. He fanned seven Somerset Patriots in his last outing and boasts a stellar ERA of 1.29. Opposite Woods Richardson, Frank German (0-2, 7.04 ERA) takes the mound for the Sea Dogs. German only lasted two-thirds of an inning in his only start against the Fisher Cats this year, giving up five runs on two hits with three walks.

LAST TIME OUT: Threw five scoreless innings against the Patriots with seven strikeouts, picking up his first win of the season. He has had either seven or eight strikeouts in each of his three outings this season.

v. PORTLAND: Gave up three runs in four innings in his Double-A debut against the Sea Dogs on May 6th. Struck out eight of the 17 batters he faced.

2021: Matched a career-high with eight strikeouts in Double-A debut 5/6 G1 at Portland. Allowed 3 runs (1 earned) in 4.0 IP. Followed that up with another eight strikeouts in home opener vs. Somerset. Allowed only one hit (a HR) in his five innings vs. Patriots.

2019: Didn't miss a start while splitting time with Adv. A Columbia in the Mets system and with the Dunedin Blue Jays after the trade. Went 3-2 with a 2.54 ERA in his six starts with Dunedin, with 29 strikeouts in 28.1 IP. Held FSL hitters to a .182 average. Finished the season with a combined 126 strikeouts in 106.2 IP.

2018: In Mets system, made a couple starts for the GCL Mets and Kingsport Mets (Appy League). Did not allow a run in first six outings as a pro.

Career/Personal Notes: On the opening day roster for the Fisher Cats for the first time, and is the youngest on the roster.

Obtained: Selected by the Mets in the 2nd round of the 2018 draft (Kempner HS, Sugar Land, TX).
