### RIDERS EXPLODE ON OFFENSE IN WIN OVER MISSIONS:

The Frisco RoughRiders pushed past the San Antonio Missions 12-3 on Thursday night from Riders Field. Frisco (11-19, 49-49) roared in front, pounding seven runs in the bottom of the second. **Aaron Zavala**, **Tucker Mitchell** and **Jax Biggers** notched RBI singles before **Cam Cauley** pelted an RBI double and **Abimelec Ortiz** drilled a three-run homer, securing a 7-0 lead. The RoughRiders then added five runs in the bottom of the third. Zavala roped an RBI triple, then **Keith Jones II**, Biggers, Cauley and Ortiz banged RBI doubles, extending the lead to 12-0. In the top of the fifth, San Antonio (13-17, 52-47) loaded the bases and Wyatt Hoffman hit into a double play to score Marcos Castañon, cutting the lead to 12-1. The Missisions then tallied two more runs when Hoffman drew a bases-loaded hit by pitch and Devin Ortiz grounded into an RBI fielder's choice, shaving Frisco's lead to 12-3. RoughRiders reliever Jackson Kelley (1-1) earned the win, pitching two scoreless frames. San Antonio starter victor Lizarraga (2-8) took the loss, allowing 10 runs on 10 hits. Frisco starter Leandro Lopez coaxed just one earned run while whiffing seven.

After a tough month in June on offense, hitting .218/.308/.306/.614 with a league-worst 3.4 runs per game and just 13 homers (tied for second-fewest in the league), the Riders were better in July. The Riders were third in batting average (.244), third in slugging (.379), fourth in OPS (.664), third in home runs (22) and third in runs per game (4.8). The Riders were also 29-for-36 in steals during the

#### HE IS ARIMELECTRIC:

Abimelec Oritz has been on fire at the plate in July. In the month, he hit .341/.400/.682/1.082 over 21 games with eighth doubles, seven home runs, 17 RBIs and eight walks. In his last 12 games, he is batting .458 (22-for-48)/.481/.917/1.398 with seven doubles, five home runs and 13 RBIs. His seven home runs, .682 SLG and 1.082 OPS in July paced the Texas League while he was second in batting average and tied for first in doubles. In this series against San Antonio, Ortiz is hitting a ridiculous .667 (8-for-12)/.692/1.583/2.275 with home runs in three-straight games and seven total RBIs.

Aaron Zavala walked twice on July 18th, collecting his 207th career walk in a RoughRiders uniform to break the all-time franchise record, previously held by **Guilder Rodriguez**. Making it much more impressive, Zavala accomplished the feat in 312 games with a 15.1 percent walk rate over four seasons (2022-2025) while Rodriguez needed 524 RoughRiders games from 2009-2015 and a 9.8 percent walk rate.

HOLD ME CLOSE AND DON'T LET GO: In their last 17 games, the RoughRiders have had the lead or a tie game in the eighth inning in 13 of the 17 games, but they are 7-10. The Riders have blown six saves during that span. Their bullpen ERA of 4.99 in July is last in all of Double-A and while they have allowed 54 earned runs, they have also surrendered 12 unearned runs.

Keyber Rodriguez has been swinging a hot bat for the Riders recently. Since June 15th, in his last 29 games, he is hitting .336 (36-for-107)/.405/.402/.807 with seven doubles, seven RBIs, 12 walks, 14 runs scored and just 17 strikeouts. In July, he batted .310 (22-for-71) over 19 games.

CAULEY! CAULEY. CAULEY ANYTIME:
Cam Cauley has been incredible for the RoughRiders lately on offense. In his last 65 games since May 7th, he is batting .281/.337/.473/.810 with 19 doubles, eight home runs, 29 RBIs and 16 stolen bases. In his last 30 games, he is slashing .307/.346/.528/.874 with nine doubles, five home runs, 18 RBIs, 23 runs scored and nine steals.

The RoughRiders have now stolen at least one base in 25 of their last 31 games. Over those 31 games, they have stolen 47 total bases, which is second in the league. **Sebastian Walcott** is third in the league with 12 steals in that span while **Cam Cauley** is eighth with nine. Overall this season, the Riders are fifth in the league with 115 stolen bases.

Rangers top prospect Sebastian Walcott has showed off incredible consistency this season. In April, he hit .244 with a .766 OPS, in May, produced a .257 average and .811 OPS, but struggled with extra-base hits in June, hitting .239, but just a .640 OPS. This season, his walk rate of 12.0 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.4 percent, a career low. This season, he is on pace for 34 steals over 124 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are **Elvis Andrus** (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22). Walcott participated in the Futures Game for the second season in a row over the All-Star Break, going 0-for-1 with a sacrifice fly and a groundout to shortstop while playing third base defensively.

### **ABOUT DAVID**

-In 2021, he was signed by the New York Mets for \$30,000 as a free agent, but did not pitch. After the contract was voided, he then signed with the Rangers for \$10,000 in 2022.

-Father, David, has spent 16 seasons as an MiLB coach in the Mets organization and was named the 2019 Mets Milb Coach of the Year as the NYM Culf Coast League manager. Both his grandfather, Pompeyo, and great-uncle, Vic, played Major League Baseball. His younger brother, Gabriel, signed with the Angels in January of 2025 as a catcher and is currently their No. 14 prospect.

# **2025 SEASON**

- -Entered the season as the No. 16 prospect in the Rangers organization by Baseball America. He also was listed as having the best curveball in the organization by Baseball America.
- -No. 28 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.
- -Dominated in first 10 starts in High-A Hub City, going 4-0 with 1.09 ERA while striking out 68 batters in 49.1 innings to just 11 walks.
- -Went 3-0 with 0.96 ERA over five May starts, whiffing 35 in 28.0 innings to just four walks while holding opponents to a .152 batting average against. He was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month.
- -Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on 4/20.
- -Struggled in final High-A start, allowing a career-high six runs over 1.2 innings against Wilmington on 6/13.

#### **2024 SEASON**

- -Led all of Minor League Baseball (min. 20 GS) with a 1.88 ERA in 22 games, 21 games started. He never allowed more than three earned runs in a single outing between Low-A Down East and High-A Hickory.
- -Was named Carolina League Postseason All-Star.

#### **2023 SEASON**

- -Made state-side debut for the Down East Wood Ducks in one start.
- -Spent the offseason prior to 2024 with Tiburones de La Guarira of the Venezuelan Winter League, owning a 4.50 ERA, allowing 15 ER in 30.0 IP over nine games, six games started.
