

Good Morning

R-Phils.

Today, the Reading Fightin Phils continue a six-game series on the road at the Somerset Patriots. It's the second of 18 matchups between the teams this season. Reading returns to Somerset from July 4-9 and the Patriots come to Reading from August 15-20. In 2022, Reading went 7-11 vs Somerset, going 5-5 at home and 2-7 on the road.

Long Night

Last night, Reading fell in a back-and-forth slugfest at Somerset. The Patriots struck first, but Reading responded multiple times. The Fightin Phils cranked three home runs in the sixth inning, coming from Oliver Dunn, Cody Roberts and Carlos De La Cruz. But, it wasn't enough as Somerset batted around in the bottom of the seventh in which the Patriots scored seven runs.

Offensive Production

Through a little over a month, Reading's offense continues to rank towards the top of the Eastern League in multiple categories. The Fightin Phils lead the league in hitting at .259, which is 10 points ahead of second-place Portland. Reading also ranks fourth in runs scored. The offensive production has been helped by six double-digit scoring games so far. Reading had nine double-digit scoring games in 2022.

Oliver Getting It Dunn

Oliver Dunn had another excellent game last night, this time agasint his former team in Somerset. Dunn collected three hits, including a home run, which was his third in the last week. Over his last five games, Dunn is hitting .353. He is slashing .281 over his last ten.

Unique Numbers

Through 33 games, Reading has scored first in 17 games. In those 17 games, Reading holds just a 7-10 record. In 2022, the Fightin Phils were 56-30 when scoring first. So history would suggest that those treds will likely flip at some point. Also, when looking at a tell-tale number for Reading's season, the Fightin Phils are 8-5 when scoring north of five runs and 4-16 when scoring less than five runs. Reading is also above .500 when committing no errors and 2-12 when committing one error or more.

Around the Organization

The Philadelphia Phillies close out their series with the San Francisco Giants this afternoon at 3:45 before returning home to welcome the Cubs on Friday. Lehigh Valley fell to Worcester 9-4 last night to dip below .500 on the season. Jersey Shore fell to Wilmington 8-3, while Clearwater beat Bradenton 12-10 to improve to a Florida State League best 25-9 on the season.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 17, 2016: At Bowie, J.P. Crawford goes 3-for-6 with a double, 3 RBIs and a run in Reading's 9-1 win. Nick Pivetta shuts out the Baysox for 7.0 innings, giving up only 2 hits and a walk while striking out 6 for his 4th win.

'Sup Somerset

This is the first series of the season between Reading and Somerset. The Patriots sit second in the Northeast Division with a 21-12 record. Last week at Portland, Somerset split the six-game series, with the teams alternating wins in the series between the top-two teams in the division. Next up, the Patriots hit the road for a six-game series at Erie next week before welcoming Portland to Jersey the week after.

Coffee with Castano

Righty Blas Castano gets the ball this morning for Somerset. He has dominated over four games (three starts) in 2023. Castano is 3-0 with a 1.77 ERA, while allowing 11 hits, seven bals and 23 strikeouts in 20.1 innings pitched. He went five innings, allowing two runs on four hits eight days ago in a win at Portland. He split 2022 between Hudson Valley and Somerset, going 5-9 with a 3.86 ERA over 22 games and 21 starts.

Phillies Number Three Prosepct. Started season on injured list.McGarry has been a prospect since his high school days, when he was a late-round pick of the Rangers before honoring his commitment to Virginia. With the Cavaliers, he showed off his premium arm strength as well as a lack of familiarity with the strike zone, making him an intriguing, yet enigmatic college arm in 2021. The Phillies thought McGarry's stuff was worth taking in the fifth round, and he pitched his way from High-A to Triple-A in his first full season of pro ball. If you're just evaluating pure stuff, McGarry could be considered one of the better pitching prospects in the game. He's flirted with 100 mph in the past and was up to 99 mph at the upper levels in 2022, averaging over 95 mph. It's an elite pitch not just because of velocity, but because of his vertical approach angle as well. His mid-80s slider can be plus at times, missing a ton of bats, and he fools hitters with an upper-70s curve too. He doesn't throw his changeup nearly as much as the breaking stuff, but it has characteristics of a plus pitch. He added a hard cutter at the end of last year to give him a potential five-pitch mix. How often McGarry can land his elite-level stuff in the strike zone will determine exactly what he can be in the big leagues. A 13.9 K/9 rate to start off his pro career shows he can fool pro hitters, but even with some improvements since joining the Phillies, he's walked 5.4 per nine entering 2023. There's hope that as he adds mass to his loose 6-foot-2 frame, he can keep refining his delivery and throw enough strikes to start, a role he'll continue for now unless there's a need as a reliever in Philadelphia.
