**Today:** The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, play the fourth game in a six-game series at the West Michigan Whitecaps, High-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. This is the 477th all-time meeting between the two teams and the fourth tilt in a 21-game season series; the Nuts dropped the opener in a 2-0 shutout, but have recovered to take each of the last two games, the first two home losses of the year for West Michigan.

**Yesterday:** Lugnuts 4, Whitecaps 2. 19-year-old **Steven Echavarria** earned his first professional victory with 4 2/3 scoreless innings as the bulk man, following opener **Corey Avant**, and the Lugnuts used a three-run fifth inning to beat West Michigan in a Thursday matinee.

**On Deck:** The GLIAC Tournament is taking place on Jackson® Field™, while the Lugnuts play the Whitecaps in a pair of matinees over the weekend, returning home for a six-game series running from May 13-18 against the South Bend Cubs.

### LUG•NOTES

**Prospecting:** The Nuts boast the Athletics' second, third, fourth and fifth selections in the 2024 draft: slugging third baseman **Tommy White** (40th overall), currently on the Injured List; southpaw starter **Gage Jump** (73rd), shortstop **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer** (75th) and outfielder **Rodney Green, Jr.** (104th). White is rated the A's No. 7 prospect, Kuroda-Grauer is No. 10, Jump is No. 13 and Green is No. 18. The Lugnuts also have 19-year-old **Steven Echavarria**, rated No. 12, and outfielder **Nate Nankil**, who is No. 28.

**Quieting the Caps:** The Whitecaps have scored only five runs in the first three games of the series, the lowest run total for any team in the Midwest League this week.

**Staying in the Park:** West Michigan has not homered yet in this series, just like the Lake County Captains (first in the MWL with 27 HRs) did not homer at all against in the Lugnuts in their six-game series from April 29-May 4. The last time the Lugnuts allowed a home run, it was April 29 vs. Fort Wayne – a game in which the TinCaps hit three homers in a 5-4 win, including **Brandon Butterworth** on **Grant Judkins'** first pitch of the game, **Braedon Karpathios'** two-run go-ahead homer in the sixth inning, and **Nerwilian Cedeño's** game-winning two-run homer off **Henry Gómez** in the ninth.

**Leading the League:** The Lugnuts' offense is atop the Midwest League with a .261 team batting average, 255 base hits and a scant 202 strikeouts (in contrast to Dayton's league-worst .193 average, 184 hits and 312 whiffs).

**Congratulations!** Minor League Baseball named **Gage Jump** its Midwest League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 28-May 4, recognizing Jump's near-perfect effort on a rain-shortened Thursday in Lansing: a five-inning complete game shutout with seven strikeouts while allowing only one baserunner, a Jonah Advincula single in the fourth inning. Jump edged teammates **Kyle Robinson** (six hitless innings) and **Grant Judkins** (six scoreless innings, two hits allowed) for the honor.

**Congratulations, Part II:** Starter **Kyle Robinson** was honored on the field on Sunday as the Lugnuts Booster Club Player of the Month for April. Robinson earned the win in the Lugnuts' first victory of the season on April 6 at Fort Wayne, following up with one earned run allowed in five innings vs. Great Lakes on April 10; two runs allowed in 4 2/3 innings at Wisconsin on April 17; and back to back quality starts, with six innings of one-run ball vs. Fort Wayne on April 24 and six hitless innings vs. Lake County on April 30.

#### Lugnut League Leaders:

- **Rodney Green, Jr.** is tied for Midwest League lead in home runs (6).
- **Blaze Pontes** leads the league with 11 appearances, while **Mark Adamiak** is tied for the league lead with four saves.

- **Gage Jump** is tied for the Midwest League lead with 45 strikeouts and four victories.

**DK at the Helm:** The 19th manager in Lugnuts history is **Darryl Kennedy**, entering his second year in the A's organization. Kennedy distinguished himself as a catcher at Manatee Community College before starring at the University of North Florida and was named an NCAA All-American in 1991 en route to North Florida's Hall of Fame, inducted in 2017. Kennedy played in the Minor Leagues for seven seasons, including parts of four seasons in Triple-A.

## MAY 9TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2015:** Fort Wayne had scheduled Saturday night postgame fireworks, and so the TinCaps shot them off as soon as the game ended... which came after a one-hour, 38-minute rain delay before first pitch and then a three-hour, 48-minute game that concluded after midnight. Edwin Moreno's suicide squeeze in the bottom of the 10th inning (against a five-infielder infield, as directed by manager Ken Huckaby, bringing right fielder J.D. Davis into the infield) brought Nick Torres in with the winning run for a 5-4 Fort Wayne victory. Anthony Alford reached base five times in the loss, with two hits and three walks.

**2019:** Nick Podkul stole home to end a 22-inning scoring drought, but the Lugnuts lost at Kane County, 3-1. The Nuts entered the series having been shut out 6-0 and 6-0 by Quad Cities in the final two games of a three-game sweep – and things would get worse, as this series-opening loss set the tone for a three-game sweep at Kane County, concluding an 0-6 road trip.

**No-No History:** Facing the Cedar Rapids Kernels on June 13, 2024, relieved Jake Garland to open the 6th inning and tossed 2 2/3 hitless innings, walking one and striking out three, as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 combined no-hitter of the Kernels... it was the 4th no-hitter in franchise history as well as the first home no-hitter since 2003.

**At Pella High School:** 2016 Iowa Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior... Des Moines Register's All-Iowa Baseball Player of the Year as both a junior and a senior, 2015 and 2016... 2015 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention... as a senior: 10-1, 0.64 ERA, 123 K, batting .421 with six homers and 12 steals... as a junior: 11-1, 0.56 ERA, 74 IP, 112 K, 10 BB, batting .520 with 14 doubles, nine triples, 13 homers, 57 RBIs, 51 runs, 15 steals... in his high school career, won 28 career games and totaled 337 career strikeouts.

**Onward to Des Moines:** Entered the 2017 Big Ten season ranked by Baseball America as the No. 8 freshman... two-way player, hitting .270 in 31 starts as a DH (and three starts as a pitcher hitting for himself)... 2018 Academic All-Big Ten... No. 3 starter in 2019; 2019 Collegiate Baseball Player National Pitcher of the Week (Feb. 18), tossing six no-hit innings with 11 strikeouts; ranked 7th in the Big Ten in ERA (2.72)... No. 2 starter in 2020 before season was halted early due to the pandemic: 2-0, 3.00, 4 GS, 21 IP, 24 K, 5 BB... signed with the Athletics following the shortened five-round draft.
