LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn dropped its third-straight contest, 6-2, on Wednesday night in Wilmington...RHP Jonah Tong tossed another quality start, allowing just one run on three hits over 6.0 innings...The 21-year-old did not issue a walk and whiffed seven...The Blue Rocks pulled away after Tong exited, bringing nine batters to the plate and scoring five runs in the bottom of the seventh...1B Mateo Gil collected a game-high three hits for the Cyclones...DH Kellum Clark added a pair of hits including a double and scoring a run on LF Omar De Los Santos' RBI triple in the ninth...DH T.J. White picked up two hits and two RBI for Wilmington...CF Jeremy De La Rosa added a two-run double to cap the five-run seventh...Blue Rocks RHP Bryan Cáceres tossed 5.0 innings of scoreless ball, scattering six hits, for his third win.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On July 11, 2004, CF Derran Watts laid down the "Bunt Heard 'Round the Borough" as a bunt single turned into a walk-off Little League home run in the bottom of the 10th inning...Staten Island makes a series of errors that allow Watts to circle the bags in the Cyclones' 3-2 wim...In 2013, manager Rich Donnelly earned his 100th win as Cyclones skipper, as Brooklyn won 4-3 at Auburn in Game 2 of a double-header...In 2016, C Brandon Brosher blasted two home runs, including a game-tying two-run shot in the ninth...LF Gene Cone's bases-loaded walk in the top of the 11th is the difference in Brooklyn's 6-5 win at Aberdeen... In 2021, Francisco Alvarez and Brett Baty departed the Cyclones to participate in the Sirius/XM All-Star Futures Game at Coors Field in Denver... Alvarez would hit a home run in the contest against future Major League RHP Marcos Diplan.

THE TONG SONG: RHP Jonah Tong has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks...Over his last four starts since June 20, the 21-year-old is 2-1 with an 0.82 ERA (2 ER in 22.0 IP), allowing only eight hits and six walks (7.40 BB%), while striking out 32 (39.51 K%)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native has led the circuit in strikeouts (70) and batting average against (.189)...He is also second in ERA (2.85), third in WHIP (1.14), and sixth in innings pitched (53.2)... Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 70.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is second in FIP (2.12), fifth in strikeout rate (36.1%), fifth in strikeout-to-walk rate (26.5%), and sixth in strikeouts (106).

TALK 2 'EM: RHP Kade Morris has started to find his stride at the High-A level...Since his start on June 21 vs. Jersey Shore, the 22-year-old holds a 1-1 record with a sparkling 1.96 ERA (4 ER in 18.1 IP)...He has yielded just 11 hits and eight walks (10.67%) while striking out 19 (25.33 K%)...Since June 20, Morris and RHP Jonah Tong have been two of the best arms in the South Atlantic League...In that span, Tong leads the circuit in ERA (0.82) and Morris (1.96) is fifth...Additionally, Kade is fourth in batting average against (1.69), sixth in WHIP (1.04), and ninth in innings pitched (18.1)...Since making his SAL debut on May 22, Morris is tied for fourth in the league in innings pitched (42.0), fifth in batting average against (.223), eighth in WHIP (1.24), and ninth in ERA (3.86).

TRAVELING CIRCUS: Starting with the June 25 game in Aberdeen, the Cyclones have just six home games in 28 days...Brooklyn's next full six-game home series will take place from July 23-28 vs. Rome...So far, Brooklyn is 4-10 in the stretch...The Cyclones played three games at home vs. Hudson Valley from July 1-3 and will play another three vs. Jersey Shore from July 19-21 immediately following the All-Star break...The stretch also includes a 12-day run without a day off (June 25-July 6), the longest of the season for Brooklyn.

WIZARD OF PAZ: OF **Karell Paz** is in the midst of one of his best offensive stretches of the 2024 season...Since clubbing a go-ahead two-run home run in the ninth inning on June 30 at Aberdeen, the 24-year-old is 9-for-28 (.321) at the plate in eight games...Paz has scored three runs and picked up three doubles, a home run, five runs batted in, three walks, and a pair of stolen bases...His OPS is .923 during that span.

MORABITO FUEL: OF Nick Morabito has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season...The 2I-year-old is tied for 11th in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (36)...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito is tied for third in the circuit in stolen bases (25), fourth in hits (58), and ninth in

vs. WILMINGTON: After a two-day break, Brooklyn travels south for a six-game series against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks boast three of Washington's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP Jarlin Susana (10), OF Jeremy De La Rosa (23), and INF T.J. White (25)... The Cyclones took 4-of-6 from Wilmington in the first meeting on Coney Island (April 23-28), but the Blue Rocks swept the season-opening series at Frawley Stadium (April 5-7) winning the last two games in walk-off fashion... Brooklyn was 9-9 at home and 7-5 on the road against the 'Rocks in the 2023 for a 16-14 record...Since 2021, the Cyclones are 46-45 all-time against Wilmington (.505).

runs scored (36)...On the year, the former second-round selection is tied for ninth in the league in stolen bases (25) and 10th in batting average (.280)...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.312), on-base percentage (.411), and stolen bases (36), and tied for first in hits (89)... He is also tied for second in runs scored (50) and tied for fourth in triples (4).

OMAR-I-GONE: OF Omar De Los Santos rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still sixth in the South Atlantic League with 30 stolen bases... The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT Jaylen Palmer's (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (67) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos has led the South Atlantic League (67) and is fifth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (139).

ZILCH, ZERO, NADA: RHPs Kodai Senga (2.2 IP) and Kade Morris (6.1) combined on a four-hit shutout, as the Cyclones blanked the Renegades, 4-0, last Wednesday...A night before, RHPs Jonah Tong (5.0 IP), Ben Simon (3.0), and Jake Stevenson (1.0) combined on a two-hitter in a 7-0 triumph vs. Hudson Valley...Cyclones pitching threw 20.1 consecutive scoreless innings between OF Garrett Martin's solo home run in the eighth inning on July 1 and DH Omar Martínez's three-run blast in the first inning on July 4... Brooklyn's longest scoreless stretch of the year is 23.2 frames from June 1-5 at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen...Brooklyn has thrown consecutive shutouts three times this season...The Cyclones blanked the IronBirds, 2-0 and 4-0, on May 3 and 4 at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones then earned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen, respectively...Brooklyn now has 10 shutouts, the second most by a South Atlantic League pitching staff in 2024 trailing only Rome (13)...It is also tied for fourth most throughout Minor League Baseball...The Cyclones' single-season shutout record is 11 set during the 2023 campaign.

LOCATION, LOCATION: The Cyclones have several players with intriguing home and road splits in 2024...OF Nick Morabito loves his time on the road... He is hitting .313/.400/.420 with a .820 OPS, adding two home runs, eight RBI, and 23 stolen bases in 31 road contests...He is fourth in the circuit in road batting average (.313) and, since his SAL debut, the 21-year-old has had the most road hits (41) and stolen bases (23) in the circuit...In Brooklyn, Morabito has collected a .224/.289/.250 line with a .539 OPS, two extra-base hits, two RBI, and two stolen bases over 18 games...INF Junior Tilien has thrived at Maimonides Park, posting a .309/.366/.455 mark with a .821 OPS, three home runs, and 14 RBI in 31 games...On the road, Tilien is hitting .175/.269/.254 with a .523 OPS, a home run, and seven runs batted in over 35 contests...C Chris Suero is hitting .250/.418/.442 with a .860 OPS, three home runs, and 11 RBI in 16 games on Coney Island...The 20-year-old is batting .168/.289/.238 with a .527 OPS, a home run, and 12 RBI in 28 affairs in visiting ballparks.

LARRUPIN' LORUSSO: INF **Nick Lorusso** was transferred to Double-A Binghamton on Wednesday...During his time in the South Atlantic League, the 23-year-old was tied for eighth in total bases (123), ninth in walks (40), and 10th in OPS (.834)...Lorusso also dominated at Maimonides Park...The former Maryland Terrapin hit .367/.444/.661 with a 1.105 OPS in 30 contests on Coney Island...Lorusso led the SAL in home batting average (.367) and on-base percentage (.444) while trailing only Greenville OF **Brayan González** in slugging (.661) and OPS (1.105)...The Connecticut native is the 12th Cyclone to join the Rumble Ponies in 2024.


AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to Baseball America and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have five of the Top 30 per BA: INF Jesús Báez (9), RHP Jonah Tong (15), RHP Kade Morris (23), RHP Jack Wenninger (26), and Calvin Ziegler (29)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season injured list... Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Báez (22), Ziegler (23), Wilfredo Lara (24), and OF Nick Morabito (26).
