JUMBO SHRIMP SWEEP CHARLOTTE

An RBI single from **Maximo Acosta** secured a Sunday win and series sweep against Charlotte. Trailing 3-1 in the ninth, **Jakob Marsee** and **Ronny Simon** singled to start the frame. **Albert Almora Jr.** followed with a single, plating Marsee making it a one-run game. **Jack Winkler** knocked a base hit to load the bases and **Jacob Berry** grounded out to score Simon, tying the game at three. With runners at first and second, Acosta's single brought in Almora as the winning run, capping a three-run ninth inning and sealing Jacksonville's first sweep since 2019.

THREE IS A MAGIC NUMBER

After winning two of three in Nashville, the Jumbo Shrimp took four of six contests against Worcester before sweeping the Charlotte Knights in a six-game set last week. Thus, this marks just the second time since 2005 that the club started a season with three consecutive series victories. Only the 2021 Jumbo Shrimp won each of their first three sets of the season, starting 13-5 (.722). Sunday's brooming is Jacksonville's first sweep since a four-game sweep of Chattanooga from July 18-21, 2019.

'PEN PALS

Jacksonville starting pitchers have gone at least 5.0 innings just five times in 15 games. The club's bullpen, however, has responded to the added responsibility in a huge way. Jumbo Shrimp relief pitching has combined for a 2.04 ERA, the second-best such mark in Triple-A. The club's bullpen also ranks third in the level in batting average against (.174), third in strikeouts (94) and sixth in fewest hits allowed (46). Jumbo Shrimp relievers have combined to toss 75.0 innings through 15 games (5.0 per game), sixth-most in Triple-A and the second-most in the International League.

MAXIMO OVERDRIVE

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Maximo Acosta** is off to an absurd start to the 2025 season. In 15 games thus far, the native of Caracas, Venezuela has recorded five multi-hit contests and two multi-RBI affairs. Acosta is 17-for-54 in total at the plate, slashing .315/.439/.407/.846 with two doubles, one home run, seven RBIs, 12 walks, nine runs scored and eight stolen bases. He is tied for second in the IL in steals (8), tied for fourth in walks (12) and tied for 12th in OBP (.439).

A GR8 START

Thanks to Sunday's win over Charlotte, Jacksonville has won eight games in a row - their longest winning streak since a 10-game roll from August 22-Sept. 1, 2014. seven of the eight victories during this current stretch have come by three runs or fewer, including four by just one tally. Since this winning roll began on April 5, the Jumbo Shrimp have outscored their opponents by a 37-21 margin. They rank first in the IL in OBP (.391), third in both walks (41) and OPS (.811), second in batting average (.277) and ninth in hits (62). The club's 1.85 ERA and 89 strikeouts since April 5 are each second in the league, with the club also ranking third in BAA (.192) and third in runs allowed.

MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the 2025 season opener, Jacksonville has recorded multiple stolen bases in 11 of their last 14 games. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp set a club record (2005-present) with seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte, and has also recorded two other games with five stolen bases (March 29 at Nashville, April 5 vs. Worcester, April 9 vs. Charlotte), a mark the club reached only twice in the prior three seasons. Jacksonville currently leads the minor leagues with 44 stolen bases; in Triple-A, second-place Omaha's 30 steals are as close to 11th place (Durham; 16) as they are to the Jumbo Shrimp. Moreover, **Jakob Marsee's** 13 stolen bases are five more than the three players tied in second with eight steals. That 13-steal figure is also equal to or more than the totals for 11 Triple-A teams.

SHRIMP BITES

Jumbo Shrimp starters rank first in Triple-A in fewest walks (13), second in batting average against (.195), second in ERA (2.57), third in fewest hits allowed (39) and tied for seventh in strikeouts (69). Their 56.0 innings pitched places 21st at the level... **Janson Junk** is slated to start Tuesday's contest against Memphis. He is coming off a 10-punchout start (career-high) against Charlotte. He has previously pitched against Memphis eight times (four starts). He has totaled 28.2 innings, going 3-2 with a 1.88 ERA against Memphis. His 20 strikeouts are tied for fifth in the IL. **Agustin Ramirez's** 11 RBIs are tied for 11th in the circuit and his eight extra-base hits rank eighth.

ABOUT JANSON

-Junk was originally selected by the New York Yankees in the 22nd round of the 2017 draft out of Seattle University.

-Junk began his career at Seattle University as a walk-on. He worked with Redhawks pitching coach Elliott Cribby, and during his three years, had improved his fastball velocity by more than 10 miles per hour.
