SHRIMP RALLY IN HISTORIC COMEBACK WIN

Austin Allen's bases-clearing walk-off double capped the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp's second six-run comeback of the season in a 9-8 win against the Durham Bulls Wednesday night at 121 Financial Ballpark, Jacksonville's (33-42, 1-0) six-run rally was the club's biggest at home since also overcoming a six-run deficit on September 1, 2011, in a 7-6 victory over the Jackson Generals. Trailing 8-2 in the eighth, the Jumbo Shrimp got back-to-back homers from Jordan Groshans and Jerar Encarnacion, plating six runs to make

A NIGHT TO REMEMBER

Between 2014-2022 Jacksonville had not notched a comeback of at least six runs. Last night's 9-8 comeback win marks the second time in 2023 that the Jumbo Shrimp have rallied from six runs down to win a game. Jacksonville's six-run rally to beat the Bulls on Wednesday was the club's biggest come-from-behind win at home since also overcoming a six-run deficit on September 1, 2011 in a 7-6 victory over the Jackson Generals.

BULL****

Since returning to the International League in 2021, Jacksonville has failed to find an answer on beating the Durham Bulls. Since 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp own a .384 winning percentage against the Bulls, the lowest winning percentage against a team they've faced in multiple series'. Last year, Jacksonville matched up against Durham 24 times, winning just nine contests. This year, the Jumbo Shrimp pitching staff owns a 6.28 ERA against Durham while the Bulls have posted a 3.27 ERA, allowing just 54 runs in 110.1 innings. The Jumbo Shrimp are being outscored 81-54, an average of 6.2 runs/game to 4.2 runs/game.

CHICKS ARE DIGGING IT

In the 11 games from May 14-26, the Jumbo Shrimp launched just nine homes, tied for the fifth-fewest in Triple-A. However, over the last 28 contests, Jacksonville has blasted 36 dingers, including a season-high six on May 27 against Charlotte, their most at notoriously pitcher-friendly 121 Financial Ballpark since hitting seven against the Carolina Mudcats on June 4, 2010. Those 36 homers are tied for 17th-most in Triple-A over the last 28 games.

YOU CAN ONLY PLAY WHO'S IN FRONT OF YOU

Jacksonville's 33-42 record is 20th in the International League, but the Jumbo Shrimp have played arguably the most difficult schedule in the circuit. Fifty-four of the club's 75 games, or 71.1 percent, have come against teams with a record of at least .500. That figure is by far the most in the league. On the flip side, Durham has had a relatively easy schedule. The reigning Triple-A Champs are 10-18 vs. teams with a record above .500, they are 30-18 vs. teams helow 500

APRIL SHOWERS HAVEN'T BROUGHT FLOWERS

Jacksonville finds themselves in the cellar of the International League. After finishing the first month of the season with a 13-12 record, the Jumbo Shrimp haven't found a spark, going 18-29 since May 1. The club posted the sixth-best ERA through the first month of the season at 4.47 in 227.1 innings. Since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 279 earned runs in 420.0 innings for a 5.64 ERA that ranks 15th in the IL. Through those 50 games, opponents have posted a .269 batting average against Jacksonville pitching which ranks as the sixth-highest batting average against in the league. Through 72 games in 2022, Jacksonville owned a 38-34 record with a posted 4.49 ERA.

FOUR SCORE AND ONE MONTH AGO

The Jumbo Shrimp have scored at least four runs in 14 of their last 19 games, going 9-10 in that span. The Jumbo Shrimp are being outscored 102 to 96 during this run. After going 0-6 to close out May and open the month of June, Jacksonville has won seven of their last 13. The Jumbo Shrimp's longest stretch of scoring at least four runs stands at 10 (April 27-May 7). During that run, Jacksonville went 7-3 and outscored their opponents 65 to 49.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville split their previous two series against Nashville and Memphis at home...The club hasn't won a series since May 2-7 on the road against the Redbirds. Since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have gone 0-4-3 including a series loss to Gwinnett last week. Jacksonville pitching struggled at Gwinnett, posting a 6.13 ERA in 47.0 innings, which was the sixth-worst ERA among IL teams last week. The Jumbo Shrimp were outscored 35 to 26, allowing a .291 BAA.

ABOUT DEVIN

-In the summer of 2015, Smeltzer played collegiate summer baseball for the Hyannis Harbor Hawks of the Cape Cod Baseball League, where he was co-MVP of the league's all-star game, and tossed a nine-inning no-hitter in which he missed a perfect game by a single walk.

-The San Diego Padres selected him in the 33rd round of the 2014 MLB draft, but he chose to enroll at Florida Gulf Coast University to play college baseball for the Florida Gulf Coast Eagles rather than sign with the Padres.

-After one year with the Eagles, Smeltzer transferred to San Jacinto College, so that he would become eligible in the 2016 MLB draft. Smeltzer had a 9–3 record and a 1.18 ERA with 128 strikeouts in 91.2 innings pitched for San Jacinto's baseball team.

-Smeltzer committed to transfering to Texas Tech after his sophomore year, but the Los Angeles Dodgers selected Smeltzer in the fifth round of the 2016 MLB draft. He signed with the Dodgers rather than transferring to Texas Tech, and received a \$500,000 signing bonus.

2022 SEASON

-The Twins promoted Smeltzer back to the major leagues on May 14, 2022.[18] On October 11, Smeltzer was sent outright to Triple-A and chose to elect free agency and landed in lacksonville.

2021 SEASON

-On July 17, 2021, Smeltzer was placed on the 60-day injured list with left elbow inflammation. Smeltzer made one appearance for the Twins in 2021 and was outrighted off of the 40-man roster on November 19, 2021.

2020 SEASON

-Smeltxer made Twins Opening Day roster, the first of his career.

-Four of six relief appearances were of 2.0 innings-or-more. Went 0-0, 4.15 ERA (4.1 IP, 2 ER) in one start and 2-0, 7.71 ERA (11.2 IP, 10 ER) in six relief appearances. Held right-handed batters to a .269 average and left-handed batters to a .385 (5-for-13) average.

-Smeltzer ttended Bishop Eustace Preparatory School in Pennsauken, NJ before pitching two seasons at San Jacinto College in Houston, TX.

-Smeltzer had his picture posted on the school's Wall of Legends.
