JUMBO SHRIMP SWEEP DOUBLEHEADER

Jacksonville swept Saturday's doubleheader from Charlotte 4-3 and 3-1. In the opener, Connor Norby lashed three hits, including a home run. Agustín Ramírez's fourth-inning home run gave the Jumbo Shrimp the lead in the opening contest. In the finale, Brian Navarreto drove in a pair of runs and also went yard for Jacksonville. Over the doubleheader, the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen collectively worked 7.0 innings, yielding only one run on three hits. Valente Bellozo started the finale and tossed 4.0 shutout innings with six strikeouts.

THREE IS A MAGIC NUMBER

After winning two of three in Nashville, the Jumbo Shrimp took four of six contests against Worcester before claiming each of the first five games of this current set from Charlotte. Thus, this marks just the second time since 2005 that the club started a season with three consecutive series victories. Only the 2021 Jumbo Shrimp won each of their first three sets of the season, starting 13-5 (.722). A win Sunday would net Jacksonville its first sweep since a fourgame brooming of Chattanooga from July 18-21, 2019.

'PFN PAIS

Jacksonville starting pitchers have gone at least 5.0 innings just five times in 14 games. The club's bullpen, however, has responded to the added responsibility in a huge way. Jumbo Shrimp relief pitching has combined for a 1.99 ERA, the second-best such mark in Triple-A. The club's bullpen also ranks second in the level in batting average against (.172), fourth in strikeouts (86) and seventh in fewest hits allowed (37). Jumbo Shrimp relievers have combined to toss 68.0 innings through 14 games (4.9 per game), sixth-most in Triple-A and the second-most in the International League.

MAXIMO OVERDRIVE

Jumbo Shrimp infielder Maximo Acosta is off to an absurd start to the 2025 season. In 14 games thus far, the native of Caracas, Venezuela has recorded five multi-hit contests and two multi-RBI affairs. Acosta is 16-for-50 in total at the plate, slashing .320/.443/.420/.863 with two doubles, one home run, six RBIs, 11 walks, nine runs scored and eight stolen bases. He is tied for second in the IL in steals (8), tied for fourth in both hits (16) and walks (11), 12th in OBP (.443), tied for 14th in runs (9) and 19th in average (.320)

SEVEN DEADLY WINS

Thanks to Saturday's doubleheader sweep over Charlotte, Jacksonville has won seven games in a row - their longest winning streak since an eight-game roll from August 4-12, 2023. Six of the seven victories during this current stretch have come by three runs or fewer, including three by just one tally. Since this winning roll began on April 5, the Jumbo Shrimp have outscored their opponents by a 33-18 margin. They rank second in the IL in OBP (.380), third in both walks (32) and OPS (.792), tied for third in runs scored (53) and fifth in hits (53). The club's 1.83 ERA and 78 strikeouts since April 5 are each tops in the league, with the club also ranking fourth in BAA (.196) and fifth in runs allowed.

MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the 2025 season opener, Jacksonville has recorded multiple stolen bases in 11 of their last 13 games. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp set a club record (2005-present) with seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte, and has also recorded two other games with five stolen bases (March 29 at Nashville, April 5 vs. Worcester, April 9 vs. Charlotte), a mark the club reached only twice in the prior three seasons. Jacksonville currently leads the minor leagues with 43 stolen bases; in Triple-A, second-place Nashville's 29 steals are as close to 12th place (Columbus, Durham; 15) as they are to the Jumbo Shrimp. Moreover, Jakob Marsee's 13 stolen bases are five more than the three players tied in second with eight steals. That 13-steal figure is also equal to or more than the totals for 13 Triple-A teams.

SHRIMP BITES

Jumbo Shrimp starters rank first in Triple-A in fewest walks (10), fourth in batting average against (.199), fourth in ERA (2.67), tied for fourth in fewest hits allowed (39) and seventh in strikeouts. Their 54.0 innings pitched places 16th at the level... Austin Roberts is slated to start Sunday's game as an opener. In 190 career appearances in the minor leagues, just eight have come in a starting role. Sunday will mark his first start since July 8, 2022, when he went 2.0 innings in the back-end of a doubleheader... Agustín Ramírez's 11 RBIs and eight extra-base hits are each tied for third in the league. He is also 16th in slugging (.553) and 23rd in OPS (.905)

ABOUT ADAM

-Mazur was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the second round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Iowa. He made his major league debut for the Padres on June 4, 2024, tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball at the Los Angeles Angels. Mazur was later included in the July 30 trade along with left-hander Robby Snelling and infielders Graham Pauley and Jay Beshears in exchange for left-hander Tanner Scott and right-hander Bryan Hoeing.

- -Mazur began his collegiate career at South Dakota State University before transferring to Iowa. He made 15 starts for the Hawkeyes in 2022, going 7-3 with a 3.07 ERA. Over 93.2 innings, he yielded only 60 hits and 30 walks while striking out 98 to earn Big Ten Pitcher of the Year honors. His 98 strikeouts ranks as the fourthmost in a single-season in program history, and he ranked eighth nationally in hits allowed per nine innings (5.8).
- -When he made his MLB debut on June 4, 2024, Mazur became the fourth former Hawkeye to pitch in a big league game since 2000, joining Wes Obermueller (2002), Matt Dermody (2016) and Nick Allgeyer (2021).
- -As a second-round pick (53rd overall), Mazur was the highest-drafted Hawkeye since Tim Costo was picked eighth overall by Cleveland in 1990.
- -Mazur is an alumnus of Woodbury High School in Woodbury, Minn, where he was a finalist for the Minnesota Mr. Baseball Award. He was high school teammates with former Jacksonville and current Miami Marlins right-hander Max Mever.

In addition to his baseball prowess growing up, Mazur earned four letters in basketball and two in football.

-The youngest of three boys, Adam's older brother Brandon played college baseball at Grand View.

2024 SEASON

-Mazur began the season with Double-A San Antonio before earning a promotion to Triple-A El Paso. He had his contract selected by San Diego on June 4 and made his major league debut that night against the Angels.

-Mazur was named the International League Pitcher of the Week for August 20-25 after tossing 6.0 scoreless innings with one hit and one walk against four strikeouts in a 5-0 victory over Nashville on August 21.

2023 SEASON

-In 174 plate appearances, Mazur held right-handed hitters to a .208/.236/.286/.522 line compared to a .298/.332/.418/.750 batting line in 220 plate appearances for left-handed hitters.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-As a senior at Woodbury High School, Mazur compiled a 0.58 ERA with 112 strikeouts and only 12 walks in 72.1 innings. He also played shortstop, batting .377 with five doubles, one home run and 40 RBIs.
